Day 1: Arrive Cairo / Check-in

Your day will start with a private car ride to the airport to fly to Luxor. Once you're there, you'll start your visits by visiting the stunning ruins at Luxor International Airport.

The <u>Luxor Temple</u> is a significant site in ancient Egypt, and it is located just south of the Karnak Temple. The Egyptians called it "Ebit Rasit," meaning "the southern sanctuary." This site is popular

with tourists, and it is also home to some of the most iconic and historically significant statues in all of Egypt.

The <u>Valley of the Kings</u> is a beautiful, narrow valley that's located on the western bank of the Nile. The <u>Karnak temples</u> are visible from there, and they're about three kilometers away.

Tutankhamun was nine years old when he became the pharaoh of Egypt. His name translates from ancient Egyptian and means "a living image of the god Amun," the great god of ancient Egypt. Tutankhamun lived in a transitional period in the history of ancient Egypt, and he came to Akhenaten, who attempted to unify the gods of ancient Egypt in the image of one god.

Day 6: (West Bank of Luxor/Edfu)

We will be traveling to the temple of Kom Ombo. This will be an interesting experience, and we will learn a lot about ancient Egyptian culture.

Ibrahim Suleiman, an archeology expert, has said that important discoveries were made in the city of Kom Ombo, including the discovery of the oldest workshop for making pottery from the Old Kingdom

period, which dates back to the period of the Egyptian Fourth Dynasty. This is an important discovery that sheds light on the origins of pyramid buildings.

Have a relaxing lunch while enjoying the scenery on the Nile cruise ship as it sails toward Aswan.

Dinner will be served aboard the ship while you enjoy a show starring the Nubian animals.
