What you will see in Luxor and Aswan is unmatched by what you will see here! During your Aswan Excursions, you'll visit massive temples with enormous pylons that were constructed by the kings and rulers of the New Kingdom in ancient Egypt through our <u>Egypt Tour packages</u>. These structures are designed to astound you and make you think about how great and advanced these people were.

The area known as the granite quarries is the same place where the pharaohs used to cut and transport enormous stone blocks for building enormous pyramids like the Giza Pyramids, which you will see during your <u>Egypt Day Tours</u> Giza Pyramids tour. You will see the Greco-Roman Temple of Philae and the Unfinished Obelisk that has not been erected due to the sudden death of Queen Hatshepsut. Additionally, the enormous temples were built to honor the Egyptian deities.

Itinerary

Day 1: Arrive in Cairo - Giza Pyramids - Egyptian Museum

Our representative will meet you at <u>Cairo International Airport</u> and will be waiting with a sign that has your name written on it. They will then transfer you to the Mena House Hotel Cairo, where you will be assisted with a smooth check-in. You will then commence your <u>Cairo Day Tours</u> to the <u>Giza Pyramids</u>.

Start your trip at the Giza Necropolis area and visit the Great Pyramid <u>Cheops</u>, which has taken more than 20 years to be built, then proceed to the pyramids of the kings Chephren and Mycerinus to learn all about the <u>Egyptian Pharaohs</u>. Then you will be visiting the famous <u>Sphinx</u>, the guardian of the Necropolis, and the Valley Temple of King Chephren, dedicated to the mummification of the Pharaoh, which is made out of Aswan granite and is paved with alabaster.

Then we will proceed to the <u>Egyptian Museum</u> in Cairo, which exhibits the largest and most precious collection of Egyptian antiquities in the world and the only royal treasure that was found intact: the Treasures of the Golden Pharaoh Tutankhamen.

Overnight in a Cairo hotel

Day 2: Old Cairo - Coptic Cairo

After breakfast at the hotel, you will start your tour to <u>Coptic Cairo</u>, Where you will see the ancient Roman fortress of Babylon and <u>The Hanging Church</u> built by the early Christians atop the towers of the Roman fortress. Then to <u>the Church of St Sergius</u>, A.K.A the Cavern church, or the Church of the Holy Family, built above the crypt where the Holy Family resided for nearly three months, Visit the well from which the Holy Family got their water supplies. Then you will be visiting Ben Ezra Synagogue it is said that the basket of Moses was picked up from the Nile by the Pharaoh's daughter.

Continuing your day with <u>Islamic Cairo trips</u> to explore the walls and gates of the medieval city founded by the Fatimids in the 10th century, then you will enjoy your tea at El-Fishawy (the oldest cafe in <u>Khan El Khalili</u> bazaar) to enjoy your evening after a long adventurous day.

Day 3: Fly to Aswan - Aswan Tour

After having your breakfast, our representative will escort you to the airport to start your Aswan Attractions trip. When you arrive at <u>Aswan Airport</u>, our representative will transfer you and help you through your check-in procedures at the Aswan Hotel.

Start your sightseeing in Aswan by visiting the famous <u>High Dam</u>, built to increase the water resource of Egypt, control floods, and produce electric power. an important part of the country's economic development. Visit the awesome <u>Temple of Philae</u>, beautifully situated on an island dedicated to Goddess Isis. We will reach the temple by an enjoyable motorboat ride. Then proceed to the <u>Unfinished Obelisk</u>, the largest known Obelisk ever built within the granite quarries at Aswan.

Back to your hotel in Aswan for overnight after you finish your Aswan day tours.

Day 4: Aswan to Luxor - Luxor Tour

After breakfast, check out of your hotel in Aswan and drive to Luxor for approximately 3 hours.

After checking into your hotel in Luxor, you will start your <u>Luxor day tours</u> to visit the <u>Karnak Temple</u> and <u>Luxor Temple</u> ruins, two of the largest archaeological sites in the <u>Luxor East Bank Tours</u> area. The ruins testify to the great power and sophistication of the ancient Egyptians, who were able to build such enormous structures.

Day 5: Fly to Cairo - Optional Tour to Alexandria

After enjoying a delicious breakfast, your tour leader will take you to <u>Luxor Airport</u> and drive you to Cairo International Airport. At Cairo International Airport, our representative will be waiting to assist you and transfer you to your hotel in Cairo.

If we have the time, we can arrange for a day tour from Cairo to Alexandria. Here you will explore a variety of ancient monuments from the Greco-Roman, Pharaonic, and Medieval periods in Alexandria, the second capital of Egypt.
