<u>Itinerary</u>

Day 1: Arrival to Cairo - Check In

Our representative will meet you at the <u>Cairo International Airport</u> and drive you to the hotel so you can check-in. The Luxury Tours to Cairo, Alexandria, Aswan, and Luxor itinerary will be revised after you've had a welcome drink so that you can enjoy learning more about the history of Egypt. Any optional tours in Cairo or any other city during your Egypt tours will also be double-checked.

Day 2: Giza Pyramids, Egyptian Museum, Coptic and Islamic Cairo Tour

Make the most of your first morning in Cairo and enjoy a guided tour of the Giza Necropolis. Your certified English-speaking guide will meet you at the hotel lobby and take you on a fascinating journey to see the incredible 4500-year-old pyramids of the Pharaohs.

The Great Pyramid of Cheops is a stunning 146-metre-high monument made from over 2.3 million blocks of limestone. It's a testament to the engineering and construction abilities of the ancient Egyptians and speaks to their great level of sophistication and advancement.

We'll take you on a beautiful tour of the majestic pyramids of Chephren and Mycerinus, along with the option to enjoy a <u>camel ride in the Giza Pyramids</u>. Your tour guide will show you some beautiful views that will help you capture the best memories of your trip to Egypt.

You will be transferred to the pyramid complex of King Chephren, where the Valley Temple is located.

We'll be moving to Cairo's downtown, El Tahrir Square, to start the Egyptian Museum Tour. The tour is almost two hours long, and it will take you through the pharaonic-era artefacts on the two-story building. The golden collection of King Tutankhamun will amaze you, along with the funeral collection of Yuya and Tuya, the grandfathers of King Akhenaten.

Would you like to enjoy a delicious lunch in a top-quality restaurant before continuing your

sightseeing in Cairo? Then we recommend our Coptic Cairo tour, which will introduce you to some of the city's most interesting sights.

If you're visiting the ruins of Babylon, be sure to stop by the Hanging Church of the Holy Virgin Mary. This ancient church dates back to the 7th century, and some of its icons commemorate the earliest days of Christianity in Egypt. Continuing on your tour, you'll see the Cavern Church of Abu Serga, built in honour of two Christian martyrs who were tortured for their beliefs. Finally, don't forget the Synagogue of Ben Ezra, which used to be a Christian church and is now one of the few Jewish synagogues in Egypt.

What a marvellous place to explore—the <u>Khan El Khalili</u> market in Cairo is truly unique and one of the <u>best tours in Egypt</u>! There's so much to see and do in this fascinating city, so take your time exploring the sights and enjoying a cup of tea at a local cafe.

After spending the night in a hotel, it's time to get some rest for tomorrow's <u>tour to Alexandria. From</u> Cairo, enjoy the trip.

Day 3: Alexandria Tour from Cairo

After breakfast, you will leave for an afternoon trip to Alexandria from Cairo during our luxury Egypt tours. You will be transferred to Alexandria by air-conditioned vehicle. The trip by car takes around three hours, including a stop for a break.

Finally, you will arrive in Alexandria, the bride of the Mediterranean.

We would like to begin our tour at Pompey's Pillar, which celebrates the victory of the Roman Emperor Diocletian. Afterwards, we will be transported to the Catacombs of Kom El Shoqafa, which were discovered just a few decades ago and are considered one of the largest Roman burial places. Afterwards, we will drive by the seaside to reach the Citadel of Qaitbay, which was built on the ruins of the ancient Pharos Lighthouse in Alexandria. It enjoys an excellent position, at the end of a narrow strip of land extending into the Eastern Port.

The Modern Library of Alexandria is one of the oldest and most respected centres of scientific research in history.

At the restaurant overlooking the harbour, you'll enjoy a seafood lunch that will be perfect for a relaxing break after your trip to Cairo. Finally, you will be transferred back to your hotel in a comfortable and relaxing manner.

Day 04: Fly to Aswan, Aswan Nile Cruise Tours

You will be transferred to Cairo International Airport to board your flight to Aswan.

At the airport in Aswan, you'll be met by your tour guide, who will accompany you to begin your 5-star Nile cruise boat before lunch. After lunch, you will be transported to see one of the largest projects in the modern history of Egypt, the Aswan High Dam, This was constructed in the 1960s to save Egypt from the critical floods that took place every year.

If you visit these attractions, you'll be able to marvel at the beautiful <u>Philae Temple</u>, admire the impressive granite quarries where ancient pharaohs worked, and explore some of the most famous religious sites in Egypt. All of this will make for a truly memorable experience.

Take a trip back to ancient times aboard the Nile cruise and enjoy a show and dinner while sailing to Kom Ombo.

Overnight in Aswan

Day 05: Kom Ombo Temple

Your breakfast will be served before you set off on your Kom Ombo tour. This unique trip will take you to see the great temple of <u>Kom Ombo</u> dedicated to the crocodile god Sobek. The Nile cruise ship will sail to <u>Edfu</u> while lunch and dinner are served and you will spend the night on board.
