Day 1: Arrival in Egypt

After arriving at <u>Cairo International Airport</u>, our knowledgeable tour guide will help you handle all of your customs procedures. You will then be transferred to your hotel in a comfortable private vehicle. After your arrival, you will enjoy a welcome drink. Day 2: Giza Pyramids and the Egyptian Museum, Optional Cairo Nile Cruise Dinner

After breakfast, you will meet our representative, who will take us to the hotel to begin our Cairo trip. We will start our tour of the <u>Giza Pyramids</u> by visiting the archaeological complex famous for its three great pyramids (Cheops, Chephren, and Mycerinus) and the Great Sphinx. We're going to take a lunch break before continuing our tour of <u>the Egyptian Museum</u>, Besides the amazing archaeological finds, you can see the valuable collection of King <u>Tutankhamen</u>, as well as a unique ivory statue of the great King Cheops, only 7 cm long. There's also a granite statue of Queen Hatshepsut and other 120,000 archaeological finds from ancient Egyptian history, from the Paleolithic to the Greco-Roman era.

After your day trips in Cairo are completed, you will have the opportunity to enjoy a pleasant dinner on a Nile cruise while watching the Tanura oriental dance show.

Day 3: Fly to Luxor, West Bank Tours

We will have breakfast at the hotel before our representative assists you through the check-out procedures. Then, you will transfer to Cairo airport, according to the departure of the flight to Luxor. Upon arrival at Luxor airport, you will have a meeting and assistance to start your Luxor West Bank tours, which are located

in the Valley of the Kings, A necropolis, but for the kings and rulers of ancient Egypt during the new kingdom, here between silence, desert, and sky, you will live a charming experience by visiting three of the royal tombs. Then, you will continue your Luxor excursions to the Temple of Hatshepsut, which was built by Senmout, her loyal architect, and the Colossi of Memnon, where our guide will explain to you how these immense statues used to be inside the Temple of Amenhotep III. Finally, you will have lunch during an excursion in a good-quality restaurant. After lunch, you will transfer to your hotel in Luxor and stay overnight.

Day 4: Luxor East Bank Tours

After breakfast, you will visit the Karnak Temple, a complex of temples, sacred lakes, obelisks, chapels, and avenues. It is said that its greatness made it the center of religious worship in ancient Egypt during the new kingdom. Afterward, you will have lunch in a restaurant during your sightseeing tours in Luxor. You will then continue to visit the Luxor Temple, dedicated to the god Amun, the father of gods in ancient Egypt. This building is located on the east bank of the Nile and was built by Amenhotep III during the eighteenth dynasty. It was completed by the famous King Ramses II. At the same time, the construction of the Temple of Karnak was connected by an avenue of sphinxes to the Temple of Karnak. You will then transfer to Luxor Airport for the flight back to Cairo. Once you have landed, you will meet our representative at Cairo Airport and be transferred to the hotel overnight.
