Itinerary

Day 1: Arrival in Cairo

Upon your arrival at <u>Cairo International Airport</u>, a professional tour leader will be waiting for you. After that, you will be transferred to your hotel in a private air-conditioned vehicle by your personal driver to ensure that your day goes smoothly.

Upon your arrival at the hotel, our representative will assist you in completing a quick check-in process. Additionally, they will review your itinerary for the Egypt Tour Packages and confirm the pickup times for each tour during your stay in Egypt.

You spend the night at your hotel.

Day 2: Pyramids Tour

Firstly, you will start your day by enjoying your breakfast in the hotel within <u>Cairo Day Tours</u> in Egypt. You will meet an accredited tour guide who will lead you to see <u>the Great Pyramid</u> of Cheops, which stands 146 meters high. Additionally, you will visit the pyramids of Chephren and Mycerinus, as well as the famous figures of <u>The Great Sphinx</u> and the <u>Valley Temple</u> on the Giza Plateau - a well-known tourist destination for pyramid tours. During our visit to the plateau, we will take a panoramic tour of the Giza pyramids and capture some unforgettable photos as part of the Cairo day tours itinerary.

Once you have finished your lunch, you will proceed to <u>Saqqara</u> to witness <u>the Step Pyramid Complex</u> and the Djoser Step Pyramid, which is the first building made entirely of stone worldwide. The tour encompasses access to the pyramid of Teti, renowned for its remarkable interior. Furthermore, we have the opportunity to explore one of the <u>tombs of the nobles at Saqqara</u>, providing insight into daily life in ancient Egypt with depictions of its activities inscribed and painted on the walls and corridors.

Your Cairo Day Tours will begin in <u>Memphis</u>, the former capital of the pharaohs. It is situated around 30 minutes south of Giza and is now known as the modern village of Mit Rahina. Memphis was an important center for religion and culture for almost a millennium during the course of ancient

Egyptian history. You will have the opportunity to explore the open-air museum, which is famous for its alabaster sphinx. This sphinx is the second-largest among all the sphinxes that were made in ancient Egypt and it was created using an 80-ton block of marble. You will also see the colossal statue of King Ramses II during the tour. Finally, you will return to your hotel for an overnight stay in Cairo.

A tour of the Sound and Light Show in Giza is optional.

Day 3: Cairo Tours

On the This day of your Cairo day trip, following breakfast, a professional tour guide will accompany you to <u>The Egyptian Museum</u> in Cairo. This museum showcases the largest and most valuable collection of Egyptian artifacts globally. Amongst the collection, the most captivating items are those that belonged to the golden pharaoh Tutankhamun. Howard Carter, a renowned British archaeologist, discovered his tomb in the <u>Valley of the Kings</u> in 1922. The museum contains a large number of Egyptian artifacts, royal mummies, and royal possession

First, you will be escorted to <u>the Citadel of Saladin</u>. It was constructed during the 12th century to strengthen Cairo as the capital of the country. Next, you can enter the renowned alabaster mosque built by Mohamed Ali in 1805. Finally, enjoy a picturesque panorama of Islamic Cairo and behold centuries-old mosques, minarets, and domes, some of which are over 1000 years old.

Explore the ancient Roman fortress of Babylon, dating back to the 1st century, and also visit <u>The</u> <u>Hanging Church</u>, constructed without any supports above the fort's towers. Additionally, discover the <u>Church of St Sergius</u>, also known as the Cavern church, located above the crypt where Jesus Christ and his mother stayed for three months. The holy family's water supply well can also be found there. Your <u>Coptic Cairo tour</u> will also include a visit to the <u>Ben Ezra Synagogue</u>, believed to be the site where the Pharaoh's daughter found the basket of Prophet Moses in the Nile River.

Your tour manager will lead you on the <u>Islamic Cairo trips</u>, where you will be amazed by the walls and gates that were constructed during the Fatimid dynasty of Islamic Cairo, as well as the ancient streets and corners that date back to the late 10th century A.D.

Walk all the way to <u>Khan El Khalili</u> so you can savor the delicious mint tea at Al-Fishawy cafe and also have a wonderful shopping experience in Cairo, where you can purchase gifts.

Day 04: Cairo to Aswan

Following breakfast, you will be transported to Cairo International Airport where you will catch a domestic flight to Aswan. Once you arrive, your guide will greet you and assist you in embarking on your Nile cruise.

During your cruise, you will sail on a Felucca boat and tour Kitchener's Island

Afterward, we will return to the cruise ship where you can join us in afternoon tea on the upper deck. Later, you can savor a delightful dinner while watching a Nubian Folkloric show on your first night of the Nile cruise.
