Itinerary

Day 1: Arrival in Cairo, Check-In

When you arrive at Cairo International Airport, our representative will pick you up and transfer you to your hotel in Cairo or Giza.

Upon arrival at the hotel you will be served welcome drink while our representative will review the itinerary of your Egypt at Easter 9 Days Tour to confirm that everything is going according to plan and assist you with a smooth check in.

Overnight in Cairo.

Day 2: Giza Pyramids, Saqqara Necropolis

After breakfast, you'll be taken on a fascinating tour of ancient Egyptian landmarks with an expert guide. You'll start your day by tour to Giza Pyramids! Upon arrival, you will visit the Giza Pyramids, including the Great Pyramid of <u>Cheops</u> - a magnificent structure made of 3.2 million blocks of stone. You'll also visit the Pyramid of Chephren, smaller but no less impressive, and the Pyramid of Mycerinus, the grandson of Cheops. Along with the Great Sphinx you'll see the Valley Temple of King Chephren, where his royal corpse was mummified.

All our Eqypt Day Tours are well-arranged with high quality programs and a private professional tour guide to help you know more about the monuments and to answer any guestions you may have sure to take good care of you during your trip.

We will visit Saqqara to see the Step Pyramid of King Djoser, the Step Pyramid, built with six steps built one on top of the other. The area was re-constructed by the efforts of a French archaeologist, and we will enter the Pyramid of Teti and the tomb of Kagemni his son-in-law to see the impressive daily life scenes carved in perfection.

After enjoying a delicious lunch at a top-notch restaurant, you'll enjoy the rest of the day exploring Cairo on one of our <u>Cairo day tours</u> or taking a break in the hotel.

Day 3: Fly to Aswan, Aswan Excursions

After checking out from the hotel, you will hurry up to catch your flight to Aswan. then you will Check in our 5-star Egypt Nile cruise from Aswan to Luxor. After some time to rest, we will start our Aswan

<u>excursions</u> on the Nile by visiting the Aswan High Dam, where the guide will explain how the construction of the dam and the subsequent creation of Lake Nasser required the transfer of the Nubian people and some important historical monuments, including Abu Simbel Temples, which you have the opportunity to visit tomorrow.

We will take a short boat ride to the Island of Agilkia to explore the <u>Temple of Philae</u>. Built during the Ptolemaic era (from 305 B.C. to 30 B.C.), the temple is dedicated to Goddess Isis, one of the oldest deities of ancient Egypt. We will continue to see the Unfinished Obelisk at the granite quarries to see the most impressive obelisk that is believed to be cut during the reign of the famous <u>Queen</u> <u>Hatshepsut</u>. Back again and overnight aboard the cruise in Aswan.

Day 4: Kom Ombo and Edfu Temples

you will start your day by joining our optional excursion to Abu Simbel temples from Aswan, the great two impressive temples in southern Egypt. A UNESCO World Heritage Site known as the "Nubian Monument", these iconic temples were carved out of the mountainside in the 18th dynasty of the new kingdom, during the reign of Pharaoh Ramses II. The tour then continues with a visit to the Kom Ombo Temple, a double temple dedicated to both the crocodile god Sobek and the falcon god Haroeris (Horus). After some time exploring the temple, we will head towards Edfu. Also dedicated to Horus who was the protector of kingship, this temple is over 2,000 years old but was covered in sand until it was rediscovered by the French expedition in 1798. Because it has been hidden for so long, it is the most well-preserved temple in Egypt. We will continue then sailing to Luxor, where we will spend the night aboard the 5-star cruise ship.

Day 5: Luxor West Bank Tours

The famous Valley of Kings will be our first destination, where you can enter some of the incredible tombs of the Pharaohs of the New Kingdom, such as King Tutankhamun. We will then have a fabulous tour of the Temple of Hatshepsut (El Deir El Bahary Temple), the mortuary temple of the 1st queen of <u>ancient Egypt history</u> who ruled Egypt during the new kingdom. The day will end with a visit to the great Colossi of Memnon, the last remains of the temple of Amenophis III. Back to the cruise ship and overnight.

Day 6: Luxor East Bank Tours

Today you will start your adventure by visiting the <u>East Bank of Luxor tours</u>. and see the complex of Karnak, part of the ancient city of Thebes. Dedicated to the powerful ram-headed god Amun, it offers a vast mix of temples, chapels, statues, and obelisks. We will then explore the temple of Luxor, a place of worship connected by the Karnak Temple by a long avenue of sphinxes, dedicated to the triad of Amun, his wife Mut, and his son Khonso. Together, these temples and deities played a major

role in the great Opet Festival which was held every year during the flood season. We will then take our private air-conditioned vehicle to Hurghada on the Red Sea coast, where we will stay in an allinclusive resort.

Day 7: Optional Snorkeling Trip in Hurghada

Today is your day, you can spend it in any way you love, such as swimming in the pool or lying on the sandy beach, with all-inclusive food and beverage. Total relaxation awaits you! But you can choose to take part in any of the water sports activities, including our impressive Hurghada snorkeling tours and scuba diving. The seas around Hurghada offer some of the best coral reef diving spots in the world, giving you the chance to see many species of colorful fish. Overnight at Hurghada resort.
