Day 1 Thursday: Arrive Luxor - Luxor East Bank Tours

Day 2 Friday: Luxor West Bank Tours - Sail to Edfu

After breakfast on board an Egyptian Nile cruise, start your <u>Luxor day tours</u> and visit the highlights of Luxor's West Bank tour, such as the Valley of the Kings, where most of the tombs of the New Kingdom pharaohs are located. You will be thrilled by the well-preserved colorful frescoes, especially the trial scene, where you will see countless gods such as the god Osiris in the afterlife, the goddess Maat, the goddess of justice, and Anubis, the god of the necropolis in ancient Egypt in history.

Visit the Hatshepsut Temple or <u>El Deir El Bahari Temple</u>, which was the fifth Pharaoh of the 18th Dynasty and the second female Pharaoh to rule Egypt. It is a group of Pharaonic temples and tombs located in the West Bank from the Nile opposite the city of Luxor, Egypt. The monastery Queen Hatchepsut was constructed to perform the rituals that benefit her in the other world. The name of the monastery is a modern Arab name, which was given to this area in the 7th century AD after the Copts used this temple as their monastery. At the end of your Luxor excursions, you will tour the Colossi of Memnon, which are two gigantic seated stone statues representing the pharaoh Amenhotep III.

Enjoy your tasty open-buffet lunch and dinner aboard your Nile cruise boat while sailing to Edfu. Overnight aboard your Nile cruise.

Day 3 Saturday: Edfu and Kom Ombo Temples

After having your breakfast aboard the Nile cruise, we will start the Kom Ombo and Edfu tour to visit Horus Temple known also as Edfu Temple, God Horus was the Egyptian god of the sky and was the son of Isis and Osiris, identified with a man's body with a head of a hawk. After that sail to Kom Ombo to visit Kom Ombo Temple which was built for God Sobek the crocodile-shaped God from one entrance, the other entrance was dedicated to Haroeris with its falcon head, it was constructed during the Ptolemaic dynasty. Sail to Aswan while enjoying the beautiful scenery of the Nile River.

Day 4 Sunday: Aswan Sightseeing Tours

Aswan High Dam:

It was established in the 60s of the last century by President Nasser to save Egypt from the floods happening every year and is among the top Excursions in Aswan.

Philae Temple in Aswan:

Then you will continue Aswan tours to visit <u>Philae Temple</u>, one of the most impressive temples of ancient Egypt, and its amazing stones and engravings which have been saved for thousands of years to tell us about the grandeur of our ancestors. We will transfer you back to the Luxor to Aswan Nile Cruise and you will enjoy your lunch and dinner on board.
