#### Day 01: arrival in Cairo

## Day 02: Visiting the Giza pyramids and Memphis

After having your delicious breakfast at your hotel in Cairo, you will meet your tour guide to start your day.

Start with your tour to Giza Pyramids to see the huge structures that were built by the great pharaohs of Egypt during the 4th dynasty, Cheops, Chephren, and Mycerinus. The three pyramids are believed to be built according to a group of stars with the main entrance locates to the north to serve as burial tombs for the semi-god kings. The biggest one belongs to King Cheops and your tour guide will get into details about why and how the great pyramids were built.

The site of the capital of ancient Egypt was the King's residence and the political-administrative center for one thousand years and a very important center of cult and culture during the three thousand years of the ancient Egyptian civilization after the unification of Upper and Lower Egypt. you are going to see the colossal statue of Ramesses II, one of the greatest and most powerful kings in Egyptian history. also, the open-air museum displays many of the city's remaining statues and other artifacts. following that you will have a delightful lunch before heading back to your hotel.

Have your delightful lunch meal in one of the good quality restaurants and transfer to <u>Memphis</u>, now known as Mit Rahina to see the open-air museum with its amazing artifacts, especially <u>the alabaster sphinx</u> of Memphis, and the colossal statue of Ramses II, the new kingdom pharaoh who is the owner of the impressive Abu Simbel Temples in Aswan.

# Day 03: The National Museum of Egyptian Civilization and Suez canal

After your morning meal, a proficient guide will meet you at your Cairo accommodation and lead you on an amazing journey to the National Museum of Egyptian Civilization (NMEC). This museum displays a vast collection of ancient artifacts, including sculptures, paintings, pottery, and jewelry, dating back from prehistoric times to the present era. One of the museum's main attractions is the Royal Mummies Hall, which exhibits the preserved remains of several pharaohs and queens from the New Kingdom period, including Ramses II and Hatshepsut.

Furthermore, the NMEC offers interactive exhibits, multimedia displays, and educational programs, providing visitors with an opportunity to explore Egyptian history and culture in a vibrant and fascinating way. Additionally, it provides modern amenities such as a gift shop, a restaurant, and a conference center.

Hence, even if you're not a history enthusiast, it is still an ideal destination to unwind and appreciate the Mediterranean coast. However, for those interested in history, especially World War II, El Alamein is an enthralling place to visit.
