Itinerary

Day 1: Arrival in Cairo

When you arrive at <u>Cairo International Airport</u>, a representative from Cairo Top Tours will greet you and take you to your hotel for the night. We'll go through your itinerary for your 9 days of travel to Cairo, Luxor, Aswan, and Abu Simbel to make sure all of the excursions in Egypt are scheduled correctly.

At the hotel our representative will help you with check in procedures, and you will be served welcome drink upon arrival.

Day 2: Excursions in Cairo (Giza Pyramids - Saqqara - Memphis)

After breakfast at the hotel, meet your private tour guide to start your first stop in your itinerary, The Pyramids of Giza (Cheops, Chephren, and Mycerinus) and the Great Sphinx are two of the most amazing places on earth. You can see all the magic that the Pharaohs of Egypt did in this monumental collection from all over the world. Ride a camel through the Pyramids of Giza (Optional Activity), and visit he Valley Temple of the Kafra Valley.

After lunch, visit another spectacular place, Memphis, the capital of the ancient Egyptian empire during the Old Kingdom. It is located south of the Nile Delta. Before continuing on to the Step Pyramid of King Djoser in Saqqara, a great monument with some magnificent tombs of nobles such as the one facing the Pyramid of King Teti of the Sixth Dynasty, the tomb of Kagemni can be seen some An impressive scene of ancient Egyptian art, you'll see the colossal statue of Ramses here as well as other interesting artifacts.

After the tour of the Giza Pyramids, return to the hotel to rest.

Day 3: Excursion in Cairo - (The Egyptian Museum - Cairo Citadel - Old Cairo)

Hotel breakfast is available. You will be greeted by our English-speaking Egyptologist guide, who will then drive you to the Egyptian Museum in a private vehicle. The Egyptian Museum is a historic site with a wealth of stunning monuments and historical artifacts. Enjoy your lunch at a neighborhood eatery. When you visit the Saladin Citadel, which Salah El Din Al-Ayoubi erected, and the Mohamed Ali Mosque, which was constructed in 1805 AD in the Turkish style of architecture and is quite similar to the Blue Mosque of Turkey, you will learn about Islamic Cairo Trips. The Holy Virgin Mary Church, also known as the Hanging Church, the Ben Ezra Synagogue, and the cave church of St. Sergius are the next stops on your tour of Old Cairo, which also includes the Coptic area.

You will be transferred to your Cairo hotel at the conclusion of your Cairo day excursions.

Day 4: Arrive Luxor (The East Bank Tours)

After breakfast, check out of your hotel in Cairo, where you'll be met by one of our representatives, and be taken to the airport in Cairo to catch your flight to Luxor. When you arrive in Luxor, our guide will take you to your hotel and help you check-in. Afternoon excursions of the Luxor East Bank of the Nile will begin, taking you to the Temples of Karnak and Luxor temple, which are connected by a sphinx avenue. Lunch at a neighborhood eatery. After returning to the hotel, you will spend the night in Luxor.

Day 5: (The west Bank Tours)

After breakfast, a representative will pick you up from your Luxor hotel to take you on the Wes Bank of Luxor Tours, which will take you to some amazing locations like <u>the Colossi of Memnon</u> and the Temple of Hatshepsut. Hatshepsut was one of the female pharaohs who ruled ancient Egypt during the 18th dynasty of the New Kingdom. Next, you will visit the Valley of the Kings,

Lunch at a neighborhood restaurant. After returning to the hotel, you will spend the night in Luxor.

Day 6: Aswan Excursions (The High Dam - Unfinished Obelisk)

After breakfast, we will travel to Aswan in an air-conditioned car. When we arrive, a guide will take you to your accommodation. The High Dam, a crucial project for Egypt to manage floods on the banks of the Nile, will be seen in the afternoon, along with the Unfinished Obelisk, by you and our tour guide. a lunch break at a neighborhood eatery. After that, you'll head back to your Aswan hotel.

Day 7: Aswan Excursions (Philae Temple Sound and Light Show)

After breakfast, continue your Aswan sightseeing and go to the Philae Temple, one of the four locations where the myth of Isis, Osiris, and Horus occurred. This temple was constructed and devoted to the worship of the goddess Isis.

. Lunch at a nearby restaurant for lunch. Then. You will go back to your hotel room in Aswan. The Philae Temple Sound and Light Show is one of the most amazing things to do in Aswan at night. You will be taken to the dock to board a motorboat on the River Nile to travel to the island where the show will be held. The show will take you on a thorough journey through ancient Egyptian history and the legend of Goddess Isis and God Osiris, as well as their son, the protector of ki.

The regular flooding of the Nile endangered the Philae Temple location, which was nearly flooded for six months every year. The temple was moved to the higher ground level Agilika Island, where it is now, after a

significant and crucial campaign to attempt to save it from disappearing due to the heavy flooding water took place in the middle of the 20th century. Walk around the majestic monuments of the island as its history is described as you take in the beautiful laser projections that highlight the splendour and majesty of the ancient location.

Following the performance, you'll board a boat to return to the port, where a shuttle will take you back to your Aswan hotel.

Day 8: Tour to Abu Simbel Temples - Back to Cairo

Breakfast at the hotel. Travel to <u>Abu Simbel</u> with our representative in a private air-conditioned vehicle. You will visit the Temples of Ramses II at Abu Simbel. You will return to Aswan and transfer to the Aswan aswan airport to catch your flight to return back to Cairo., check in and overnight in your cairo hotel

Day 9: Final Departure
