Itinerary

Day 1: Arrive Cairo, Check-In

Upon arrival at <u>Cairo International Airport</u>, our representative will meet you and take you to your hotel in Cairo or Giza.

At the hotel, the staff will help get you checked in and give you a tour of the hotel. After resting, you'll be ready to go on your trip the next day.

You will be served a welcome drink upon arrival at the hotel.

Overnight at Cairo.

Day 2: Siwa Sightseeing Sightseeing

Enjoy a delicious breakfast before beginning your Siwa Oasis excursions.

Take time to see the remnants of the Shali Fortress, where the ancient Siwan people sought safety from the threat of raids by outsiders. After that, you will be taken to see the 26th-dynasty-era <u>Temple of The Oracle</u> in Aghurmi Village, as well as the Temple of Um Ubeyda and another temple honouring Amun Ra. You will also learn about the priceless Siwan heritage during your visit to the Siwa House Museum, and lunch will be served at one of the Oasis's lovely restaurants.

After exploring the beautiful Shali Fort and spending some time shopping, take a short drive to see the impressive Mountain of the Dead. Located just over a kilometer north of Shali, this stunning landmark features four tombs from different periods of history. Ptolemaic, Roman and 26th Dynasty monuments are all carved into the rock, making it an interesting place to visit.

You will spend a leisurely afternoon at <u>Cleopatra Spring</u>, one of the most well-known hot springs in Siwa Oasis. You will enjoy swimming and dipping into the sparkling water, and then you will be taken to Fitnas Island to take in the picturesque sunset.

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch

Day 3: A safari over the Egyptian desert to the Great Sand Sea

Before starting your Siwa Oasis Desert Safari, you will have a hearty breakfast at the hotel. Then, your licenced Egyptologist will take you on a 4x4 tour of the Great Sand Sea. Before moving on to the lovely sand dunes and the fossilised corals from the Cambrian era, we will start our Egypt Desert Safari journey by seeing the Mountain of the Dead and many of the tombs of the oasis' kings. Then, we'll drive you to one of the amazing locations in the Great Sand Sea, a stunning lake in the middle of the desert, where you could be lucky enough to watch flamingo birds relishing the tranquilly of the desert and bathing in a very calming attitude.

After passing by Dakrour Mountain, we will now enjoy sandboarding, which gives us the thrill of gliding down sand dunes rather than snow. After snowboarding, it is time to wash up in the hot spring known as <u>Bir Wahid</u> to relax our muscles. We will then take in another breathtaking sunset at the end of the Great Sand Sea Tour while drinking Bedouin tea in the middle of the dunes.

After being taken back to the eco-lodge, spend the night in Siwa.

Day4: Back to Cairo

Early in the morning, before departing from Siwa Oasis through Marsa Matrouh for Cairo, you will eat your breakfast box. You will be taken to your hotel for the night in Cairo after arrival. If you're fortunate and we arrive back in Cairo earlier than expected, you may reserve one of the things to do in Cairo by night, such as a belly dancing and Tanoura dance performance while dining on an optionally fascinating Nile cruise while on a sailing boat on the Nile River.

Day 5: Giza Pyramids Tour, Egyption museum

Visit the Great Pyramid of Cheops, who was inspired by his father's difficult attempts to build expansive burial tombs, and King Snefru, the founder of the 4th dynasty and owner of two great pyramids in Dahshur. Then, make your way to the high plateau for a spectacular view of the three pyramids, including the pyramids of Chephren, who was the son of Cheops and the successor of King Djedefre. His pyramid was somewhat smaller than his

The Great Sphinx in Giza, a statue of a man with a lion's body thought to have been made for King Chephren himself because it is located within his funerary complex, is now visible after having the option to ride a camel on the plateau surrounding the Giza Pyramids. Next, enter the Valley Temple, where the king was mummified as part of the burial process.

continue your tour in Cairo by the <u>Egyptian Museum</u> tour to see the biggest collection of Egyptian antiquities in the whole world, after your 2 hours tour is finished,

Before being taken to the Islamic Khan El Khalili area for the greatest walking tours in Cairo and a close-up look at the Egyptian locals, have your lunch in a high-quality restaurant. After your Cairo City Tour is finished, you will be driven back to the hotel for the night.
