<u>Itinerary</u>

Day 1 - Arrival Cairo- cairo day tour

Your professional tour guide will be waiting for you in an air-conditioned car at the Cairo airport when our tour leader picks you up there.

To immediately transfer you to the Necropolis of the Giza Pyramids, where you may visit the Khufu, K hafra, and Mankaura Great Pyramids and ride a camel to discover more about the fascinating Giza Pla teau.

We'll move on to the Papyrus Institute to learn more about the art of making papyrus in ancient Egypt .We'll have the opportunity to make our own papyrus scrolls after learning about papyrus production.

Lunch will then be served in a local neighbourhood restaurant in the centre of Cairo after that. Following a short break, we'll see Cairo's ancient area and marvel at its magnificent structures, including as those of Coptic Cairo, Islamic Cairo, and Al-Azhar, before wrapping up our day tour at Khan El Khalili.

We'll then take you back to your hotel in Cairo so you may check in and spend the night there.

Day 2 - fly to luxor- Luxor Museum & Mummification Museum Tour

After breakfast, you'll be picked up from your lodging by our tour guide, who will also help you check out before driving you to the Cairo airport, where your flight to Luxor will be leaving from. Your tour guide will drive you to your hotel in Luxor as soon as we arrive so you can unwind before we leave for our first stop. You'll make the trip. It's fun to explore the Luxor Museum. Displays of ceramics, jewellery, furniture, sculptures, and stelae were created by the Brooklyn Museum in New York. They have a thoughtfully picked assortment of items from both Theban temples and the Necropolis. On display are artefacts from Tutankhamun's tomb, including a cow goddess head.

Therefore, the best place to discover the mysteries of the most mysterious pharaohs is the Mummification Museum. There may be found an amazing variety of mummified animals. The museum houses a variety of human and animal mummies as well as the tools and canopic jars used in the technique.

After that, we'll stop for lunch at a nearby restaurant before dropping you off at your Luxor lodging for the evening.

Day3-Luxor West Bank

After breakfast, you'll be picked up by our tour guide and taken to one of the following: Numerous kings' graves can be found in the architectural wonder known as the Valley of the Kings, which functioned as a place of burial. The most well-known tombs are those of King Tutmosis I, King Tutmosis III, Tut-Ankh-Amon, King Ramses VI, King Mrenptah, and Amonhotep II.

then continue to watch The daughter of Thutmosis I and the only female pharaoh to lead ancient Egypt, Queen Hatshepsut built the <u>Temple of Queen Hatshepsut</u>, also known as El Dir El Bahari. During the 18th Dynasty (about 1490–1469 B.C.), she governed Egypt for around 20 years, during which time the temple was built.

<u>The Colossi of Memnon</u>, the remnants of Amenhotep III's funeral complex, will be the destination of our upcoming excursion.

After that, we'll eat lunch at a nearby restaurant before dropping you off at your hotel for the night.

Day4- Day Trip to Edfu and Kom Ombo from Luxor

The most notable building in Edfu and one of Egypt's most beautiful and wellpreserved Temples is the Temple of Horus.

Check out of your lodging after breakfast, and our tour guide will pick you up to visit it.then continue to watch

<u>The Kom Ombo</u> Pylon once had two entrances, but the left side has completely disappeared, leaving only the centre pillar and the lowest parts of the right wing to remain.

You could notice a relief of the Roman Emperor Domitian wearing the crowns of Upper Egypt, the god s Sobek, Hathor, and Khons, 52-

line hieroglyphic inscription, and more on the front wall to the right as you approach. We'll then have lunch at a nearby restaurant before driving you to your Aswan accommodation for the night.

Day5- Aswan high dam and the Abu simbel temble

<u>The High Dam of Aswan</u>, a 1960s technical marvel, is the first stop on your day tour of Aswan after being picked up at your hotel or by our tour guide. From the top of the High Dam, you can view over Lake Nasser to the massive power plant in the north and the Kalabsha temple in the south. To experience an Abu Simbel day tour, take a 3-hour drive from Aswan to the south in an air-conditioned vehicle.

Due to their exceptional architecture, the two temples of <u>Abu Simbel</u> are sometimes referred to as the best examples of ancient Egypt. They portray the majesty and grandeur of the impending Kingdom.

Together, the Egyptian government and UNESCO decided to protect these sites from flooding.

At the temple bearing their names, Ptah, Re-Her-Akhtey, Amun-Re, and Ramesses II were honoured.

The massive Abu Simbel temple is also known as the Sun Temple of Ramses II.

At the Temple of Queen Nefertari, also known as the Temple of Hathor because she was the Sun God's wife, Ramesses II, Hathor, and the Sun God are symbolically united. Before departing for Aswan, stay there for roughly three hours.

bring you back to your hotel, where you will spend the night and eat lunch.

Day6- Visit Philae Temple and fly to cairo

Check out of your accommodation after breakfast, and our tour guide will take you up to visit The third and largest of the well-known Aswan sights will be the last thing you see.

<u>The Philae Temple</u> was carefully moved to its current location as the surrounding Nile levels increased as a result of the construction of the High Dam (about 500 metres from the original site).

After you arrive at the island by speedboat, your tour guide will give you a walking tour of the temple before giving you some free time to complete your solo research. The beautiful Philae Temple, which honours the goddess Isis, is situated on an island in the river and has been scrupulously preserved to preserve its original design.

You will be driven off at the Aswan airport when your excursion is finished so you can board your aircraft to Cairo. Upon arrival, arrange for transportation to your hotel in Cairo, where you will spend the night.

Day7- Bahariya Oasis safari Tour

You will be picked up at 6:00 am from your hotel in Cairo by our tour guide and driver, who will then d rive you 350 kilometres west of Giza to the Bahariya Oasis.

It takes about four hours to travel.

Change to a 44 and go 40 kilometres into the desert after arriving at Baharaia to see the Black Desert .After that, lunch will be served at a well-known neighbourhood restaurant, where you can swim and unwind beforehand or after.

Turn left into one of the world's most beautiful deserts, the White Desert, then go another 90 km to reach <u>the Agbatat</u> and <u>Crystal deserts</u>, as well as a variety of mountains and sand dunes. Its stunning white stones come in a variety of shapes, including mushrooms, chickens, and bunnies. Drive back to your accommodation in Cairo.

Day 8- Alexandria Ancient Adventures

After breakfast and check-out in the morning, your tour guide will drive you to Alexandria in a contemporary, air-conditioned vehicle. The first stop on your day tour will be the <u>catacombs at Kom el Shoqafa</u>, which are regarded as one of the wonders of the Middle Ages. It is the largest Roman burial site in Egypt that is now known to exist, with three layers of tombs that can accommodate up to 300 bodies. Prior to being a public cemetery, the territory had been created as a private burial place for a single family. The architecture of the tombs is reminiscent of Greco-Roman styles. This can be seen in the wall artwork's inventive combination of Egyptian, Greek, and Roman aesthetic traditions.

After a brief photo break, you will continue to <u>Qaitbey's Citadel</u>, which is considered to be one of the most significant defensive strongholds not only in Egypt but also along the Mediterranean Sea coast. The Citadel was an important part of Alexandria's defence system in the 15th century A.D. It is situated at the easternmost tip of Pharos Island, not far from the eastern harbour's entrance. It was constructed on the exact site where the famed Lighthouse of Alexandria, one of the Seven Wonders of the Ancient World, formerly stood.

<u>The Montazah Royal Palaces and Gardens</u>, which belonged to Mohamed Ali Pasha's royal line from Khedive Abbas Helmy II to King Farouk I, will thereafter be visited.

<u>Library of Modern Alexandria</u>, Our amazing adventure will come to an end at the Modern Alexandria Library, which took the place of the Old Library and was renowned for its large collection of books on numerous fields and literary genres. After this wonderful city tour, you will be picked up and brought back to your lodging in Alexandria.

Day 9- Alexandria Modern Magic- Back cairo

We will go Pompei's Pillar after leaving the hotel and getting picked up by our tour guide in an air-conditioned vehicle. <u>Pompei's Pillar</u> is situated in the Serapis temple, which dates back to the first century BC and was known as "the supreme god of Alexandria during the Ptolemaic era."

In Alexandria, the biggest mosque is called <u>Abu Al-Abbas Al-Mursi</u>. It boasts an ornate minaret, carvings in the shape of arabesques, four large domes, and a cream-colored facade.

Our trip of Alexandria concludes in the <u>Roman Amphitheatre</u>, also known as Kom el-Dikka. Right in the centre of Alexandria is a massive Roman theatre and apartment complex. Take a stroll through Alexandria's historic area before being transported by one of our tour guides to your lodging in Cairo. Relax and sleep all night.

Day 10- Final Departure
