Day 1: Arrival to Cairo

Next, get ready to be mesmerized by the magnificent temple honoring the goddess lsis, the <u>Philae</u> <u>Temple</u>. The temple, which was originally built on an island in the Nile River, was moved and rebuilt when the High Dam was built.
