Day 1: Arrive Cairo, Egypt

Within <u>Cairo International Airport</u>, our tour leader will greet you with a sign bearing your name, ready to assist you with all procedures as you begin your journey. From the airport, you will move to your hotel by your private nonsmoking air-conditioned deluxe vehicle. When you reach the hotel our tour manager will assist with a smooth check-in and he will review your Egypt Travel Packages itinerary with you to confirm pick-up times for each tour.

Day 2: Giza Pyramids / Saqqara / Memphis

Your tour guide will meet you at the hotel lobby, to enjoy our Day Tour to <u>Giza Pyramids</u>, Memphis, and <u>Sakkara</u>,

Your tour guide and personal driver will transfer you first to enjoy the tour to Giza Pyramids and see The Great Pyramid of Cheops, and the pyramids of Chephren and Mycerinus. Then continue to visit the Great Sphinx, the head of the Pharaoh, the body of a lion, and the valley temple of king Chephren.

Then they will take you to the high Panorama to enjoy the camel riding at Giza Pyramids for 15 minutes and take the most unforgettable photos with the Bedouins. You will stop to take your lunch which will be served in a good quality restaurant then you will be transferred to continue your <u>Cairo day tours</u> to visit the <u>Step Pyramid</u> Complex of King Zoser in Saqqara, which is considered to be the oldest man-made building entirely made out of stone all over the world (Djoser Pyramid). you will also have the option to enter the <u>pyramid of Teti</u> which has the most spectacular interior amongst all the accessible pyramids (no extra ticket) and the <u>tombs of the nobles</u> at Saqqara to enjoy the daily life scenes in ancient Egypt with all its activities inscribed and painted on the walls and corridors of the tombs. You will enjoy your tasty lunch in a good quality

restaurant then move to <u>Memphis</u> to visit the open-air museum, which is only 20 minutes far from Saqqara, the museum has an exhibition of statues and artifacts that remains from the ancient capital of the pharaohs including <u>the alabaster sphinx</u> made out of an eighty tons block of marble and the gigantic fallen statue of Ramses II.

Back to your hotel after your tour is finished and overnight

Day 3: Tour to The Egyptian Museum, Coptic and Islamic Cairo

Cairo Top Tours knowledgeable guide will pick you up from your hotel to begin the Tour to the Egyptian Museum and Coptic Cairo. You will be transferred to The Egyptian Museum tour. to enjoy a journey through the rich history of ancient Egypt by watching the largest collection of ancient Egyptian artifacts more than 160,000 masterpieces are displayed, the highlights will be fully explained by your expert tour guide including the treasures of King Tutankhamen, the only royal treasure discovered intact and consists of a huge collection of gold and jewelry were hidden under the sand more than three thousand years until the tomb was excavated in 1922 then it was entirely moved to Cairo and The Egyptian Museum.

Then your tour guide will take you to continue your trip and proceed to visit the <u>Citadel of Salah El Din</u> and the Alabaster Mosque of Mohamed Ali inside, which represents a unique example of Ottoman architecture in Cairo since the design is copied from the famous Blue Mosque of Istanbul, The Citadel is considered the center of the Egyptian government since it was established by Salah El din until the reign of King Farouk during the first half of the past century.

You will stop to take your local lunch meal in a good quality restaurant then start your Coptic Cairo tour to the ancient Roman fortress of Babylon and get amazed by The <u>Hanging Church</u> one of the highlights of old Cairo, you will also visit the church of St Sergius which is also known as the <u>Cavern Church</u>, it was built above the crypt inside which the holy family stayed nearly three months and the well from which the holy family members were drinking water, finally, you will visit <u>Ben Ezra Synagogue</u>, according to tradition, this is maybe the site of the pharaoh's palace where the basket of Moses was picked up from the Nile.

Continue our Cairo Sightseeing tours to cover Islamic Cairo, and explore the various relics of medieval Cairo to see the old walls and mosques. Madrasa, the Sails, and gates of the city during the middle ages and its old stone-paved streets date back to the 10th century. The walk ends by having tea at Fishawy oldest cafe in Khan El Khalili, Cairo's old bazaar.

Day 4: Cairo to Luxor/ East Bank of Luxor Tour
