<u>Itinerary</u>

Day 1: arrival day.

On your first day in Egypt, you'll be met by an experienced tour guide from Cairo International Airport. After changing and settling in at your hotel, you'll be on your way the next day!

Day 2: Giza Pyramids Tour, Saqqara, Memphis.

After enjoying your morning meal, you'll be taken on a tour of your first stop of the day.

<u>Giza pyramids</u> are some of the most distinguished monuments on Earth, with a distinctive geometric shape that makes them stand out from the crowd. Each side of these pyramids constitutes a pyramid, meaning that each edge, base and vertex of a triangle is part of the structure. This design allows the weight of the pyramid to be evenly distributed, which makes the pyramids incredibly sturdy. In all, there are 138 pyramids located in Giza and the largest of these is the pyramid of Khufu.

The Saqqara Tomb of King Hetepe Sekhemwi or Ra Neb Neb Tomb of King Ni Natjar Buried Pyramid, Funeral Complex of King Sekhemkhet, Director Bridge, and Funeral Complex of King Khasekhemwy are all incredible examples of ancient Egyptian architecture and engineering at their finest.

The city of <u>Memphis</u> is named after the pyramid of Pepi, the second pharaoh of the Old Kingdom. It has been in use by the Coptic people for centuries. The first ruling family, the Narmer Dynasty, was founded here by a strong army and the city's important work of protecting the country. Today, Memphis is a thriving metropolis with a rich history.

After your tour is done you will be transferred to your hotel to overnight.

Day meals: Breakfast, Lunch.

Day 3: Egyptian Museum, old cairo, Khan El-Khaliki

On the third day of your tour 9 days Alexandria and Siwa oasis tours from Cairo you will meet your tour guide who will take you on the day visits starting with:

Egyptian museum:

Among the museum's unparalleled collections are the funerary collection of Yuya and Thuya, Psusennes I and the Treasures of Tanis, and the Narmer Stela which commemorates the unification of Upper and Lower Egypt under one king, and is among the priceless artifacts in the Museum. The museum also houses impressive statues of the great kings, Khufu, Khafre, and Menkaure, the builders of the pyramids on the Giza plateau.

Old Cairo:

you will be visiting the Coptic Cairo and the Islamic Cairo of Egypt.

Khan el khalili bazaar:

in this Bazar, you will find all that you need to buy from Egypt traditional things and the most beautiful souvenirs.

then have a transfer back to your hotel and have an overnight.

Day meals: breakfast, lunch.

Day 4: Cairo to Alexandria Day Trip

In the morning after taking your breakfast you will be taken to travel by AC wheels to Alexandria, with an expert tour guide that will accompany you your whole 9 days Alexandria and Siwa oasis tours from Cairo, then start your visits when you are there:

Pompey's pillar:

As for its current name, "the pillar of the masts", it dates back to the Arab era, as it is believed that it came as a result of its towering height among 400 other pillars, which resemble the masts of ships, and that is why the Arabs called it "the pillar of the masts", and later became "the masts", according to the Governorate website. Alexandria. Sep 26, 2020

kom el shougafa:

The area was named by this name due to a large number of pottery remains and quarries left by visitors during their visit. Excavations began in this area since 1892, and the cemetery was only found by chance on September 28, 1900.

Qaitbay citadel:

The construction of the <u>Qaitbay Citadel</u> dates back to AH 882 / AD 1477, when Sultan al-Ashraf Abu al-Nasr Qaytbay ordered the construction of a great tower at the site of the ancient Lighthouse of Alexandria, at the eastern edge of Pharos Island, according to the website of the Egyptian Ministry of Planning, Follow-up and Administrative Reform.

bibliotheca of Alexandria:

the old one got on fire in 48 BC. AD Julius Caesar burned 101 ships that were on the shore of the Mediterranean in front of the <u>Library of Alexandria</u> after Ptolemy the Younger, Cleopatra's brother, besieged him after he felt that Julius Caesar was supporting Cleopatra against him.

When you are done you will be taken to a good quality hotel to have your overnight there and get a nice sleep.

Day 5: Alexandria to Alamein, Siwa Oasis

this day will be full of adventure as you will be taken from the morning to travel to <u>Siwa oasis</u> but on the way, you will be visiting the beautiful places starting with stopping at:

Al-Alamin military museum:

The El Alamein Military Museum is a museum that commemorates the decisive battles of El Alamein that took place during World War II on and around the Egyptian land of El Alamein and around it.

Then have your tasty lunch at Marsa Matrouh.

and then reach Siwao asis safely, and check-in in Eco-lodge.

Day meals: breakfast, lunch, dinner.

Day 6: Siwa Sightseeing.

on day 6 you will have your breakfast when you wake up then start the day tour:

ruins of Shali fortress:

The ancient city and fortress in the heart of Siwa Oasis in the Libyan desert in Egypt was named Shali in the local Siwanese dialect and was built by the Syrians. Near the next of kin.

temple of Oracle:

Located 4 km east of the present town of Siwa, the Temple of the Oracle is believed to have housed the famous Greek oracle of Jupiter Amun, to which Alexander the Great headed directly when he came to Egypt for the first time in 331 BC.

then get back again to have an overnight,

Day deals: breakfast, lunch.

Day 7: Egypt Desert Safari Tour to the Great Sand Sea

from the early morning before sunrise have a <u>Egypt desert safari tours</u> in the desert, and visit the grand sand sea then also you will visit on your way by the quad bike and visit:

the mountain of the dead:

Located about 560 kilometers northwest of Cairo, Siwa Oasis is home to one of the most important burial sites dating to Dynasty 26, 'The Mountain of the Dead.' 'The Mountain of the Dead' contains thousands of graves cut in the bedrock, where inscriptions helped to date the oldest graves to researchers and scholars.

on the way you will see the beautiful lake and more of the natural sightseeing. and then you will be transferred backto the Eco-lodge.

Day meals: breakfast, lunch.

Day 8: Back to Cairo

on this day before the last day end, you will do your check-out from the Eco-lodge and transfer to the capital of Egypt Cairo and on your way have your lunch, at the Marsa Matrouh city then move by your AC wheels to Cairo and have an overnight at your hotel, and you can have the rest of the day as a free tour.
