Itinerary

Day 1: Arrive Cairo, Egypt

Welcome to Cairo, Egypt

Cairo Top Tours tour leader will be waiting for you upon arrival at <u>Cairo International Airport</u> with a sign holding your name to transfer you to your hotel in Cairo, you will be assisted with a smooth check-in and your 10 Days Package to Egypt itinerary, pick-up times and optional activities will be revised.

Overnight in Cairo hotel. Welcome Drink

Day 2: Pyramids and Cairo Tours

After having your first delicious breakfast at your hotel, your special tour guide will meet you at the hotel lobby to start your tour in Egypt by visiting the most adrenaline rush site in Egypt, Giza Pyramids, you will get to see the Great Pyramid of Cheops, the only remaining wonder of the old seven wonders of the ancient world, the middle pyramid of King Chephren and the smallest pyramid which was built for the King Mycerinus. Amble around the area of Giza Necropolis to explore the most huge yet not the only, The <u>Great Sphinx of Giza</u>, which is sculpted in the shape of a lion body with a human's head to symbolize both power and intelligence.

You will have enough time to ride a camel and take photos to reminisce about these adorable tours in Cairo. After finishing your tour to Giza Pyramids, you will continue your Egyptian Museum tour by visiting the <u>Museum of Egyptian Antiquities</u> which was established in 1902 to display the most ancient artifacts in the history of the whole world, more than 120,000 of the daily life tools and accessories used by ancient Egyptians, in addition to huge coffins, huge statues, and King Tutankhamun's golden collection. You will then have lunch in a local good quality restaurant and continue your Egypt Day Tours to have an informative <u>Coptic Cairo tour</u> to the area which witnessed the oldest churches in Coptic history in the Middle East, Coptic Cairo. It is believed that the Holy Family took refuge in this area along with other areas in Egypt while escaping from the persecution. Visit the Hanging Church of the Holy Virgin Mary and the Church of St. Sergius known as Abu Serga Church, also you will visit the ancient Jewish Synagogue of Ben Ezra before being transferred to your hotel for overnight.

Overnight in Cairo hotel. Meals: Breakfast, Lunch

Day 3: Alexandria Trip

After having breakfast, you will meet your tour guide to begin your <u>tour to Alexandria from Cairo</u>, the pride of the Mediterranean sea with its popular Citadel of Qaitbay which dates back to the 15th Century. Alexandria was built by <u>Alexander the Great</u> to compete with the most beautiful Roman and Greek cities at that time. You will visit the Roman <u>Catacombs of Kom El-Shoqafa</u> which are underground tunnels, Pompey's Pillar and Roman ruins at the site, and the Alexandria Bibliotheca. You will have lunch and overnight in the Alexandria hotel. Meals: Breakfast, Lunch

Day 4: Alamein World War II Cemetery and Military Museum

Enjoy your tasty breakfast at the hotel then you will get ready for the El Alamein day tour from Cairo

Be ready to see the Commonwealth Cemetery of World War II and the Military Museum where you will see details about the World War and learn about the battles that took place in the area of El-Alamein. Visit the Italian, the German, and the Australian Cemeteries before being transferred back to Cairo overnight.

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch

Day 5: Fly to Luxor - East Bank Tours

After breakfast, you will be transferred to Cairo International Airport to take your flight to Luxor, (Thebes) capital of Egypt during the New Kingdom which has 1/3 of the monuments in the world. you will visit Luxor Temple at the beginning of your <u>East Bank of Luxor tour</u> and your Egyptologist guide will show you the most important highlights of the temple that was built in the year 1400 B.C to be the center for worshipping <u>Amun-Ra</u>, God of the Sun disk and the chief deity according to the ancient Egyptian religion. Visit Karnak Temple complex built by King Amenhotep IV and was known as Ipet Isu or the most select of places. Then you will be transferred to your hotel in Luxor for check-in and overnight.

Day 6: Luxor West Bank Tours

You will enjoy your breakfast at the hotel then begin your <u>west bank of Luxor tour</u> by visiting the <u>Valley of the Kings</u> where kings and pharaohs of the New Kingdom rest in Peace, move then to visit the Temple of Ramses III at Medinet Habu which is the best-preserved temple in Luxor and it was believed that this is where God Amun first appeared. Continue to see the Colossal Statue of Amenhotep III known as Colossi of Memnon, gigantic statues for the King rising about 18 meters high. Transfer back to your hotel in Luxor after you finish the amazing <u>Luxor day tours</u>. Meals: Breakfast, Lunch

Day 7: Kom Ombo and Edfu Temples

Your breakfast will be served at the hotel, and then you will check-out to start your visit to the Temple of Edfu dedicated to the worship of the falcon God Horus, Then a visit to Kom Ombo temples which was built to honor two gods, the crocodile <u>god Sobek</u> and one of the forms of God Horus which was worshipped in Kom Ombo. Transfer to your hotel in Aswan for check-in and overnight.

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch

Day 8: Aswan Sighteeing Tours

Enjoy your breakfast at the hotel, and get ready to enjoy <u>Aswan day tours</u>, You will be transferred to visit the magnificent High Dam of Aswan, after that, visit the <u>Unfinished Obelisk</u> in Egypt built by Queen Hatshepsut, then you will visit the Temple of Philae which was built by Ptolemy II and completed by the Roman Emperors and dedicated to Goddess <u>Isis</u> mother of Horus and goddess of magic according to the ancient Egyptian religion. Overnight in Aswan.

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch

Day 9: Abu Simbel Temples

After breakfast you will check-out from your Aswan hotel and start your visit to the magnificent Abu Simbel Temples, the two temples of Abu Simbel are hewn into the mountain by <u>Ramses II</u>, the temples of Abu Simbel are the masterpieces of ancient Egyptian art and architecture, they show the luxury of the Egyptian empire caused by the military campaigns to Asia and Africa. The Temple of Ramses II is dedicated to the four universal gods Ptah, Re-Her-Akhtey, Amun-Re, and to Ramses II himself. The great Abu Simbel temple is also called The Sun Temple of Ramses II.the smaller temple is built for his favorite wife, the Nubian Queen <u>Nefertari</u>, the temple is dedicated to the cow Goddess of love and music, Hathor. You will be transferred to Aswan Airport to take your flight back to Cairo and overnight in Cairo hotel. Meals: Breakfast, Lunch

Day 10: Final Departure

After breakfast at your hotel, you will be transferred to Cairo International Airport for your final departure. Meals: Breakfast
