Itinerary

Day1- arrive cairo, pyramids,old cairo and papyrus institute

our tour leader will pick you up from <u>Cairo airport</u> where our licensed tour guide will be waiting for you in an air-conditioned vehicle. To transfer you directly to <u>the Giza Pyramids</u> in the Necropolis of Giza, to see the Khufu, Khafra, and Mankaura Great Pyramids, and to enjoy a camel ride tour of the region to discover the mesmerizing Giza Plateau.

then we will visit The Papyrus Institute where we will learn about the ancient Egyptian craft of manufacturing papyrus after that. After learning about the production of papyrus, we'll get the chance to create our own papyrus scrolls.

Then, it will be time for lunch in a nearby neighborhood restaurant in the heart of Cairo. After this brief rest, we'll head to the old Cairo to explore its incredible architecture, <u>Coptic Cairo, Islamic Cairo</u> and <u>Al-Azhar</u>, and <u>Khan El Khalili</u> to cap off our exhausting day.

then we will return you to your Cairo hotel check-in and overnight.

Day 2 - fly to luxor- Luxor Museum & Mummification Museum Tour

after breakfast, our tour leader will pick you up from your hotel, check out and transfer you to <u>Cairo</u> <u>airport</u> to catch your flight to Luxor, when we arrive here, your tour guide will transfer you to your Luxor hotel and relax, then we will start our journey the first stop You'll go there It's astonishing how entertaining <u>Luxor Museum</u> is. The Brooklyn Museum of New York built displays of ceramics, jewellery, furniture, statues, and stelae. They contain a carefully chosen mix of artefacts from the Necropolis and Theban temples. There are other Tutankhamun artefacts on display, including a cow-goddess head from his tomb.

The Mummification Museum is the ideal site to learn about the most potent pharaohs' secrets after that. A fascinating collection of creatures that have been mummified exists. The museum houses a number of mummies of people and animals in addition to the instruments and canopic jars used for the procedure.

then we will have a lunch at local restaurant, and return you back to your Luxor hotel and overnight.

Day 3- Day Tour to East bank of luxor

after breakfast, our tour leader will pick you up from your hotel to visit The architectural splendor of <u>the Valley of the Kings</u>, where many kings are interred, was used as a place of burial. The tombs of King Tutmosis I, King Tutmosis III, Tut-Ankh-Amon, King Ramses VI, King Mrenptah, and Amonhotep II are the ones that are well known.

then transfer to visit The only pharaonic woman to rule ancient Egypt, <u>Queen Hatshepsut</u>, the daughter of Thutmosis I, who constructed the Temple of Queen Hatshepsut, also known as El Dir El Bahari. She ruled Egypt for nearly 20 years during the 18th Dynasty (about 1490–1469 B.C.), during which time she erected the temple.

then we will visit <u>The Colossi of Memnon</u>, which are the remains of Amenhotep III's mortuary temple.

after that, we will have a lunch at local restaurant and return you back to your hotel overnight.

Day4- Day Trip to Edfu and Kom Ombo from Luxor

after breakfast, check out, and our tour leader pick you up from your hotel to visit <u>The Temple of</u> <u>Horus</u>, one of Egypt's most exquisite and well-preserved Temples, which is the most significant structure in Edfu.

then transfer to visit <u>The Kom Ombo</u> Pylon once had two entrances, but the left side has totally vanished, leaving just the lowest portions of the right-wing and the center pillar standing. The gods Sobek, Hathor, and Khons, 52-line hieroglyphic writing, and a relief of the Roman Emperor Domitian wearing the crowns of Upper Egypt may all be seen on the front wall to the right as you approach.

after that, we will have lunch at a local restaurant and transfer you to your Aswan hotel and overnight.

Day5- Aswan high dam and the Abu simbel temble

Start your day tour in Aswan by getting picked up from your hotel or by our tour leader then Drive to <u>the High Dam</u> of Aswan, which was constructed in the 1960s and was a feat of engineering. You can see the Kalabsha temple in the south and the enormous power plant in the north from the top of the High Dam as you look across Lake Nasser.

To enjoy an Abu Simbel day trip from Aswan, take a 3-hour journey to the south in an air-conditioned vehicle. The two temples at <u>Abu Simbel</u> are regarded as the pinnacles of ancient Egypt because of their distinctive architecture. They display the splendor and majesty of the future Kingdom. In order to safeguard these temples from flood, the Egyptian government and UNESCO made the decision to work together. The four global gods Ptah, Re-Her-Akhtey, Amun-Re, and Ramesses II were honored at the temple that bears their names. The Sun Temple of Ramses II is another name for the enormous Abu Simbel temple.

At a symbolic fashion, Ramesses II, Nefertari, Hathor, and the Sun God are united as one in the Temple of Queen Nefertari, which is also known as the Temple of Hathor because she was the Sun God's wife. Spend about three hours there before returning to Aswan.

then return you back to your hotel, have lunch, and overnight

Day6- Visit Philae Temple and fly to cairo

after breakfast, check out , and our tour leader pick you up from your hotel to visit The final and best of the three well-known Aswan sites that you will see.

When the construction of the High Dam caused the surrounding Nile levels to rise, Philae Temple was carefully transferred to its current location (about 500 metres from the original site).

After a brief motorboat journey, you arrive at the island where your tour guide will lead you on a walki ng tour of the temple before giving you some free time to continue your independent exploration.

<u>The Philae Temple</u>, which honors the goddess Isis, is located in a stunning setting on an island in the r iver that has been landscaped to resemble its original location.

After finishing your tour, you'll be dropped off at <u>Aswan airport</u> to catch your flight to Cairo. when you arrive Cairo transfer to your Cairo hotel,check-in and overnight

Day7- White Desert and Bahariya Oasis Tour

In the morning at 6:00, our tour guide and driver will pick you up from your hotel in Cairo and drive yo u in a private, air-

conditioned vehicle to the <u>Bahariya Oasis</u>, which is 350 kilometres west of Giza. The trip takes about 4 hours. Once you arrive in Baharaia, switch to a 44 and travel 40 kilometres through the desert to see the Black Desert.

After that, lunch will be given at a well-known, local restaurant , where you can swim and relax before or after.

Then, go 90 km to the Agbatat and Crystal deserts, as well as various mountains and sand dunes, before continuing on to the White Desert, one of the nicest deserts in the entire world. Its white, magnificent rocks have many diverse shapes, including mushrooms, chickens, and rabbits. Return to your Cairo hotel by car

Day8- arrive Alexandria

in the morning after breakfast, check out, and our tour leader transfer you to Alexandria in a modern and air-conditioned car ,a day trip that begins with a stop at <u>Kom el Shoqafa's catacombs</u>, which are regarded as one of the wonders of the Middle Ages. With three floors of graves that can hold up to 300 bodies, it is the biggest known Roman burial site in Egypt. The cemetery was initially created as a private burial ground for a single-family before being transformed into a public one. The tombs' architecture is reminiscent of Greco-Roman designs. This is evident in the wall artwork, which displays an original fusion of creative traditions from Egypt, Greece, and Rome. People are interred here in urns for their cremated remains, shelves, and sarcophagi.

Then, you'll proceed to (<u>Qaitbey's Citadel</u>), which is regarded as one of the most significant defensive strongholds not only in Egypt but also along the Mediterranean Sea coast, for a photo stop. The Citadel is located at the eastern point of Pharos Island, near the entrance to the eastern harbour, and it formed a significant portion of Alexandria's fortification system in the 15th century A.D. It was built exactly where the renowned Lighthouse of Alexandria, one of the Seven Wonders of the Ancient World, formerly stood.

After that, you'll experience the expansive <u>Montazah Royal Palaces and Gardens</u>, which belonged to Mohamed Ali Pasha's royal dynasty from Khedive Abbas Helmy II to King Farouk I

<u>The Modern Alexandria Library</u>, which replaced the Old Library, which was known for its enormous collection of books on many sciences and literary genres, will serve as the final stop on our magnificent journey. You will be picked up and driven back to your accommodation in Alexandria after this fantastic tour of the city.

Day 9 - Alexandria tour - back cairo

After breakfast, check out and you will be picked up by our Tour Guide in an air-conditioned car to proceed to <u>Pompei's Pillar</u>, which is located on the site of the temple of Serapis, "the supreme god of Alexandria during the Ptolemaic era," and which was built in the first century BC.

The largest mosque in Alexandria is (<u>Abu Al-Abbas Al-Mursi</u>), which has a cream-colored façade, four enormous domes, arabesque carvings, and a tall minaret.

<u>The Roman Amphitheatre</u>, also known as Kom el-Dikka, is the penultimate stop on our tour of Alexandria. It is a sizable Roman theatrical and residential complex that is situated right in the middle of Alexandria.

Take a stroll through Alexandria's historic downtown before being transferred to your hotel in Cairo by one of our tour guides. register and stay the night

Day 10- Final Departure

After breakfast, a representative from our company will drive you to <u>Cairo International Airport</u> where they will help you with your flight out after your 10-day Egypt vacation, which we hope you loved and will make you want to experience more tours in Egypt.
