Day 1 :(Arrive Cairo / Check-in / Overnight)

you will meet your Cairo top tours tour leader will meet you at your Cairo international airport where you will start your journey, then you will be transferred to your hotel in Cairo.

Day 2: (Giza Pyramids Tour / Egyptian Museum Tour / Old Cairo Tour)

the Giza Pyramids;

the Egyptian museum:

Day 3:(Alexandria / Pompey's Pillar / Citadel of Qaitbay /Kom El Shoqafa / Bibliotheca of Alexandria)

when you reach there the day will begin with a visit to:

Pompey's Pillar:

the only surviving Roman temple pillar, which stands on a rocky plateau in the surrounding ruins of

the Serapeum

Citadel of Qaitbay:

The main tower in the inner courtyard takes the form of a large square-shaped castle, the length of its sides is 30 meters and its height is 17 meters. on two levels.

Catacombs of Kom El Shoqafa:

The excavation began in the Kom El Shoqafa area in 1892, but a hole was discovered in the ceiling of the cemetery by chance in 1900 AD.

The Bibliotheca of Alexandria:

In addition to the main library, the Bibliotheca Alexandrina contains six specialized libraries: the Arts and Multimedia Library, the Taha Hussein Library for the Visually Impaired, the Children's Library, the Young People's Library, the Exchange and Archives Department, and the Rare Books Department. The Francophone Library was also established as a result of the huge donation that the Bibliotheca Alexandrina received from the National Library of France.

Day 5: (check-in Luxor East Bank tour)

start your day by transferring to the airport to fly to Luxor. then when you reach Luxor international airport you will start your visits.

Luxor temple:

The temple is located about three kilometers south of the Karnak Temple, which was once connected by a walking road lined on both sides by statues of the Great Sphinx and the ram's-headed Sphinx.

Valley of kings:

the tombs of the kings in the past got robbed so they decided to hide their treasures and bodies under the ground.

Tutankhamen:

Tutankhamun was nine years old when he became pharaoh of Egypt and his name in ancient Egyptian means "the living image of the god Amun", the great ancient Egyptian deity.

Day 6: (West Bank of Luxor/ Edfu)

from the morning of the day, of your 13 days Luxury package you will be taken to visit Luxo sights and you will start with.

Colossi of Memnon:

The statue of Memnon belongs to King Amenhotep III, as it was supervised by the famous architect Amenhotep Ibn Habu, and in the past, there was an ancient funerary temple of King Amenhotep III, and nothing remains of it except the two statues, each of which is about 21.90 meters high.

Hatshepsut temple:

The Temple of Hatshepsut is distinguished by its unique architectural design compared to the Egyptian temples that were built on the eastern bank of the Nile in Thebes. The temple consists of three successive floors on open terraces.

Karnak temple:

The Karnak Temple is distinguished by the fact that it includes a group of diverse and numerous temples that were built starting from the 11th Dynasty around the year 2134 BC. All temples inside Karnak are surrounded by brick walls, linked to each other by corridors guarded by statues stacked on two rows of sphinxes, known as the way of rams.

the temple of EDFU:

This temple was built and dedicated to the worship of the god Horus, and it is the only temple that has remained in its good condition, as Horus had a distinguished place in Egyptian mythology.

the temple of Kom Ombo:

The origin of the name Kom Ombo goes back to the legend of the king of "Emboa" who named the city after him today, and the name consists of two syllables, the first is (Kom), which means what is above the earth, and the second (Ombo), which is the name of the king or ruler of the valley.

Philae temple:

Philae Temple This temple dedicated to the goddess Isis, which was flooded by the Nile, was divided and reassembled in a new location on the island of Agilika, about 500 m from its original place on the island of Philae.

Abu Simbel:

The Great Temple of Abu Simbel, located in Nubia near the southern border of Egypt, is among the most splendid monuments in Egypt. It was built by King Ramses II of the Nineteenth Dynasty and was completely cut down on the mountain, around 1264 BC.

enjoy your delicious breakfast, then you will check out from the cruise ship, and our representative will transfer you to Aswan Airport to take your return flight back to Cairo. Upon arrival, you will be taken to catch your flight from Cairo Airport to Amman.

Day 10: (Nebo Mount / Dead Sea)

Nebo Mount:

The reason for the name goes back to "Naba", the god of the trade from the Babylonians, and the city of Nebo was established there, which fought many wars and battles that were inscribed on the obelisk of King "Mesha" King of Moab, and that was the reason for the abandonment of the city and the flight of its people and remained so until the fourth century AD, where it inhabited One of the Christian Bedouin tribes built a church there and resided there.

the Dead Sea:

The Dead Sea is a closed salt lake located in the gorge of the Jordan Valley within the Syrian-African fissure, on the borderline separating Jordan and historical Palestine (the West Bank and Palestine). The Dead Sea is famous for being the lowest point on the surface of the globe, as its beach level is about 400 meters below sea level.

Day 11: (Petra tour)

Travel to Petra and do your check-in at the Tetra Tree hotel.

then Visit Petra:

The Nabateans are credited with building Petra, but before the Nabataeans lived in this area a people called the Edomites, were in a state of constant hostility with their neighboring countries. The hills around Petra were inhabited by humans from 1200-539 BC.
