Itinerary

Day 1: Arrive Cairo, Egypt

Transferring you to <u>Cairo Airport</u> after breakfast today and bidding Egypt goodnight Our tour guide will meet you at the Cairo International Airport with a sign bearing your name to help you be recognised. You will then be driven to your hotel in Cairo in a luxury air-conditioned vehicle, where the tour guide will help you check in easily and go over the schedule for your 6 Days in Cairo and the White Desert Adventure. If you have enough time, you might reserve one of our trips in Cairo. Cairo's overnight stay

Welcome beverages

Cairo Day Tour to Saqqara and Dahshur

Our tour guide will pick you up from your hotel in the morning and drive you to <u>Saqqara</u>, where you will visit the first tomb that the ancient Egyptians built in the shape of a pyramid. The Step Pyramid was designed by the clever architect Imhotep and built during Egypt's third dynasty for King Djoser, who was the first King to have a step pyramid built for him.

The trip gives visitors access to the pyramids of King Teti, the first ruler of the sixth dynasty, and King Teti's pyramid, which was constructed during the ancient kingdom. King Unas' pyramid, which contains the most impressive burial chambers of any pyramid, is also included in the tour (no extra ticket is required).

You'll go to one of the Saqqara Mastaba Tombs of the Nobles to experience everyday life scenes from ancient Egypt, complete with all of its activities and even the many tomb hallways.

You will be taken to the <u>Memphis</u> Museum after lunch at a local restaurant in Saqqara to see the alabaster sphinx, which is the second-largest sphinx statue from ancient Egypt and is made from an 80-ton block of marble, as well as the enormous limestone statue of King Ramses II of the nineteenth dynasty, the greatest builder and ruler of the New Kingdom.

Finally, you will be taken to <u>Dahshur</u>, one of the most fascinating ancient Egyptian archaeological sites, where you will visit the pyramids of King Senfru, the founder of the 4th dynasty, and learn about the history of the pyramids (the old kingdom). The Great Pyramid and Khafra's pyramid are the two largest ancient Egyptian pyramids, while the Red Pyramid is the tallest structure in the Dahshur Necropolis. You will also go to the Bent Pyramid, which was Snefru's second pyramid. The name given to this pyramid by the ancient Egyptians was "Sneferu is Shining in the South" or "The Southern Shining Pyramid," not the "Bent Pyramid."

You'll be returned to your accommodation in Cairo or Giza following this breathtaking trip, which you may experience as part of your Cairo or Giza day excursions.

Day3-Sultan Hassan Mosque and Madrassa

After breakfast, our tour guide will transport you to the <u>Khan el-Khalili</u> and Sultan Hassan Bazaars, as well as the <u>Salah el Din Citadel</u>.

You will gain a greater understanding of Egypt's lengthy history thanks to this personalised trip. The most significant mosque in the city is the Alabaster Mosque in the Citadel of Salah el-Din, which is located on a limestone hill overlooking Cairo. The architectural marvel welcomes guests of all religions and is still utilised as a place of prayer by Cairo's Muslims.

Alabaster covers the lowest portion of the mosque both inside and out, while limestone siding from the Giza Pyramids was used to build the upper portion.

Your tour guide will explain the fundamental principles of Islam to you within the mosque, along with a translation of the most popular prayers.

Your guide will introduce you to the famed markets that are said to have inspired Christopher Columbus to find the United States as you continue to the Khan el Khalili bazaar. Enjoy your free time exploring the confusing streets and try your luck haggling with shopkeepers to purchase a memento of your vacation to Egypt.

Continue on to Sultan Hassan's mosque and madrassa (school). One of the best examples of Mamluk architecture in Cairo is thought to have been built between 1356 and 1363.

In addition, the mosque is regarded as one of the biggest in all of Islam, not just in Cairo. The mosque, which is around 492 feet (150 metres) long and 118 feet (36 metres) high, is also one of the biggest in all of Islam, not just in Cairo. 223 feet (68 metres) is the height of the tallest minaret. Since this is a personalised trip, you may choose how long you want to spend at each location.

at end, we will return you back to your hotel and overnight.

Day 4: Bahariya Oasis Tour from Cairo

After breakfast at the hotel, you'll meet your certified tour guide and driver to begin your <u>Bahariya Oasis</u> trip from Cairo. It will take you 4 hours to get there, during which time you'll view the salt lakes and the ancient site. a private tour of the English House, where guests will be able to take in the sunset and enjoy a magnificent panorama. The Bahariya Oasis area and local market will thereafter be visited, then stop at the wondrous Crystal Mountain which has crystals that shine like the stars in the sky and the volcanic rocks of the Valley of Agabat Dine out and stay the night at the Bahariya hotel.

Day 5: White Desert tour

You will visit the hot spring to enjoy swimming after a delectable home-cooked breakfast at the camp, and you'll then see the white limestone formations that are shaped like a rabbit, mushrooms, and the Sphinx.

then we will transfer to visit Gara Cave, also known as Djara Cave, is a fascinating cave that was created by rain corrosion into the limestone around 55 million years ago. It is close to the caravan trail that connects Farafra Oasis and Assiut. It has rocks that sparkle. The beautiful stalactites and stalagmites that were created when water melted the limestone, as well as artifacts and rock art, have all been discovered here, clearly demonstrating human presence within the cave during prehistoric times, most likely around the late Neolithic period.

As one of the most significant sites on any itinerary for explorers and adventure enthusiasts, Gara Cave draws a lot of people. Egyptians frequently visit because they value places with such pristine natural environments.

then Spend the night camping in the <u>White Desert</u> and take in the exquisite Bedouin music while eating a meal made by the native guides.

Day 6: Back to Cairo

Take the Bahariya Oasis on your way back to Cairo. When you arrive at the hotel in Cairo, you will be able to reserve any of our nighttime excursions before returning to the hotel to get some rest in preparation for your departure the following day.
