Itinerary

Day 1: Embarkation to MS Nile Radamis - East Bank sightseeing

Start your first day with Tours in Egypt, the Cairo Top Tours tour manager will accompany you from Luxor Airport, railway station, or any hotel located in Luxor to be transferred by an air-conditioned vehicle to board your MS Nile Radamis Nile cruise.

Your tasty buffet lunch will be served aboard the vessel then start the <u>East Bank of Luxor tour</u> when your tour guide takes you to the magnificent <u>Karnak Temple</u> which is dedicated to the king of gods in ancient Egypt, the sun-God <u>Amun-Ra</u>, Goddess Mut, and their son the moon god Khonso, then you will visit the splendid <u>Luxor Temple</u>, one of the most famous temples that were built during the new kingdom era on the East Bank of the timeless river.

Take your delightful dinner for the first night aboard your Nile cruise ship with the wondrous view, while watching a very entertaining folkloric show,

Overnight in Luxor city.

Day 2: West Bank Tours (Valley of the kings and queen Hatshepsut temple)

If you like to try an exciting adventure you can join our optional <u>Hot Air Balloon Ride in Luxor</u>, in the early morning.

Enjoy your open buffet breakfast in the early morning aboard your MS Nile Radamis Egypt Nile River Cruise. Then resume your <u>Luxor day tours</u> as your Egyptologist guide and private driver will pick up you to start the <u>West bank of Luxor tour</u> to the Valley of the Kings. When you reach the valley of kings you will get a full explanation of the progress of the royal tomb in ancient Egypt, visit the Temple of Hatshepsut, well-known as the <u>temple of El Dier El Bahari</u>, in addition to the gigantic colossal statues of King Amenhotep III known as the <u>Colossi of Memnon</u>.

When you finish the tour, your Egyptologist guide will take you back to the Nile Cruise and your tasty lunch will be served on board, then the boat will sail to Edfu.

After enjoying your dinner, you will spend the night in Edfu.

Day 3: Visit Edfu & Kom Ombo temples

This morning, you will continue your <u>Egypt luxury Packages</u>, Start with your breakfast which is made out of fresh ingredients and will be served aboard the Nile river cruise ship. After that, Cairo Top Tours representative will accompany you to enjoy the sightseeing today at <u>Edfu Temple</u> of God Horus who was the protector of kingship and usually depicted as a falcon-headed man with two great wings, then the boat will sail towards Aswan.

Before you reach Aswan, a delicious lunch will be served aboard the cruise ship, and we will stop at the small town of Kom Ombo known from ancient times. Upon arrival, you will be taken by your accredited Egyptologist guide to explore the Ptolemaic Temple of Kom Ombo which is built to honor Sobek and <u>Haroeris</u>, the crocodile Gods of ancient Egypt, and then sailing down the Nile to Aswan.

Dinner will be served on board in the evening then you will enjoy the Nubian show.

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner.

Day 4: Sightseeing Tour in Aswan

Your delicious open-buffet breakfast will be served aboard the boat and you will be transferred to enjoy <u>Aswan day tours</u> starting with a visit to the great <u>High Dam</u> in Aswan, which has been built to control the Nile water during the agricultural year, saving water and generating electric power is now easy. Continue to <u>The Unfinished Obelisk</u> in the granite quarries, which probably was made for <u>Queen Hatshepsut</u> but was never finished, Now you will see one of the most interesting temples built in the same style of architecture as in the Greco-Roman era, <u>Philae Temple</u> which was dedicated to the worship of <u>Goddess Isis</u>.

In the evening, you will enjoy your savory lunch while sailing with your MS Nile Radamis Nile Cruise. Your dinner will also be served aboard your Nile Cruise and overnight in the amazing city and things to do in Aswan.

Day 5: Disembarkation from The Nile cruise
