Itinerary

Day 1: Arrival to Cairo and check in

The tour guide from Cairo Top Tours will be waiting to welcome you as soon as your plane touches down at Cairo International Airport and will have a signboard with your name on it. He will take you in a plush, air-conditioned private car to your Giza lodging. Before arriving at the hotel, be sure to check the itinerary for your Egypt Classic Tours from Cairo to Alexandria holiday for all pick-up times so that our representative can assist you with a speedy check-in.

Overnight in Cairo

Day 2: Pyramids Sightseeing Tour

After breakfast at the hotel, you will meet your private tour guide and travel to the Pyramids of Giza (Cheops, Chephren, Mycerinus). There, you will see all the magic of the entire world that the Egyptian pharaohs did in this monumental collection. You will also have the opportunity to ride camels in the Giza pyramids.

The massive Giza Sphinx

It was created from a single stone that was 73 metres long and shaped to resemble a lion with a human head that was both clever and strong. It acted as the necropolis's overall protector.

The valley temple

The temple, one of the earliest in Egypt, was principally built to perform the procedure known as the opening of the mouth for King Chephren so that his Mummy might eat, drink, and talk normally in the afterlife. It is located just in front of the Sphinx.

Memphis City:

The journey to Memphis, the first capital of the Egyptian monarchy, will take you around 35 minutes. There, you may explore the treasures and works of art that have remained from that time since King Menes unified the two lands 5000 years ago.

Saqqara:

See Saqqara Necropolis, one of the most important and historic archaeological sites in the world, which has a number of Mastaba tombs for important leaders, nobility, and aristocrats, as well as the ancestors of the Pharaohs of ancient Egypt. There are 11 royal pyramids in the Saqqara Necropolis. You will see the Step Pyramid, which was built for King Djoser by the famed architect Imhotep. It is the first pyramid. We will drive you back to your Giza hotel for the night after you've finished your fascinating excursions of the city.

Before we travel to Memphis, which served as Egypt's capital during the Old Kingdom and a significant metropolis during the Middle Kingdom and the New Kingdom, you can unwind and enjoy lunch in a local restaurant in the village of Saqqara.

We will drive you back to your Giza hotel for the night after you've finished your fascinating excursions of the city.

Day 3: Alexandria sightseeing tour

Prepare to meet your knowledgeable English-speaking Egyptologist guide after breakfast to start your <u>Egypt Classic Tours</u> day tour from Cairo to Alexandria. From Cairo to Alexandria, we will carry you in air conditioning. During the about 2.5-hour trek, you will pause along the way for a break.

Finally, you will reach Alexandria, Egypt's second capital and the shining jewel of the Mediterranean. Alexandria received its name from Alexander the Great, who established the city and ruled Egypt in 332 B.C. You will start your viewing tour at the well-known Pompey's Pillar, which was constructed in 297 BC to mark the Roman emperor Diocletian's triumph over an uprising in Alexandria. Diocletian controlled Rome from 284 to 305 BC and also established control over Egypt. The Catacombs of Kom El Shokkafa will thereafter be your destination. They were found at the turn of the 20th century and are regarded to be one of the largest Roman burial sites. They are situated in a prime spot at the end of a small peninsula that extends into the Eastern Port.

See the earliest scientific research facility's historical location. The Alexandrian Bibliotheca, formerly the largest in the world. It was built by Ptolemy I at the beginning of the third century BC, and it is located in the city that bears its name, looking out over the Mediterranean.

You must eat seafood if you visit Alexandria. Enjoy your delicious, freshly made lunch.

You'll then be transported back to your accommodation in Cairo.

Day 4: Egyptian Museum and Cairo Tour

Be ready to continue your Egypt Tours after eating breakfast at the hotel. The Egyptian Museum, one of the most popular museums in the world, features a sizable collection of Egyptian artefacts on its two floors. The royal treasure of the golden monarch Tutankhamun is on exhibit separately and is the most intriguing of these artefacts.

See the Saladin Citadel, which for a long time housed Egypt's governmental centre. With its countless mosques, sky-piercing spires, and stunning, colourful domes, some of which are hundreds of years old and some even older than a thousand, you will adore seeing Islamic Cairo. Upon arrival, you will go to the Mohamed Ali Alabaster Mosque, which is regarded to be a unique example of Ottoman architecture in Egypt.

Our tour to Coptic Cairo includes a stop at the Hanging Church of the Blessed Virgin Mary, sometimes referred to as Al Mualaka or the hanging church because it was built above the fortress's towers.

You will also see the Ben Ezra Synagogue as part of our Cairo Day Tours, which was allegedly built on the spot where baby Moses' basket was found. The holy family lived in the crypt above this synagogue for three months, as well as above the spring from which they drew their water.

Before continuing our Islamic Cairo excursions to the Khan El Khalili market in the heart of Cairo's Islamic Middle Ages, we will break for a delicious lunch. In this area, we'll see the 10th-century-old passageways as well as the mediaeval Cairo walls and gates.

After you return to Cairo, our agent will transport you to your hotel for the night.

Day 5: The White Desert and Bahariya Oasis Overnight from Cairo

Your private tour guide and driver will pick you up from your hotel in Cairo at around 7:00 am and bring you to the Bahariya Oasis, which is roughly 360 kilometres to the east of Cairo.

Your <u>Bahariya Oasis</u> and the White Desert will be there when you arrive. Beginning in Cairo, your overnight journey will begin with a relaxing lunch at the Bahariya Oasis. Then, we'll visit the Golden Mummies Museum's exhibition area, the Alexander the Great Temple's ruins in Bahariya Oasis, the nobles' tombs in Bahariya Oasis, which are significant burial sites dating to the 26th dynasty of Egyptian history and include the tomb of Bannantiu in the Western Desert of Egypt, and we'll go on tours of the Temple.

You will go to the White Desert to explore the Valley of El Haize to the south of the oasis after a great lunch at a restaurant designed to resemble an oasis. You can pause here and have a brief dip in the warm spring. The Black Desert, where the mountains have been progressively eroded away by natural forces to cover the desert with a layer of black rocks dust, is accessible from the settlement, a paradise in the heart of the desert. Make a pit stop to see the shapes of the gorgeous Crystal Mountain and the breathtaking Valley of Agabat on the road between the oasis of Bahariya and Farafra, near to the Crystal Mountain and the White Desert.

We will enjoy camping in the White Desert, where there is a great chance to see an amazing sunset, while your local guides are preparing your meal.

Enjoy the breathtaking stars while sleeping at the camp.

Day 6: White Desert Back to Bahariya Oasis

You will enjoy an organic local breakfast in the White Desert while on your Cairo Excursions today while you take in the stunning surroundings. As you continue your Cairo day excursions, you will witness the breathtaking white limestone stones that gave the white desert its name. You'll then be transported back to Cairo across the Black Desert.

We stop in Bahariya Oasis to enjoy the salt lake, see the fruit fields, and take in the breathtaking sand dunes. The two days to the White Desert and Bahariya Oasis, which was one of many travels from Cairo, will come to an end. We will need about four hours to travel back to the hotel in Cairo.

Day 7: The end of your Egypt tours packages from Cairo
