Day 01 :arrival in Cairo

Greetings from Egypt. You will be welcomed by one of our representatives when you arrive at <u>Cairo</u> <u>International Airport</u>, you will be driven in a private A/C vehicle to your first ancient site in this tour. On your way to the hotel in the car, you will see some of the historical places such as Saladin Citadel, our tour leader will let you know some information about this place.

at Giza Necropolis, you will discover The Great Sphinx of Giza, which was erected during Chephren's rule, as well as the pyramids of Cheops, Chephren, and Mycerinus, three of the former Seven Wonders of the World (2620BC), will be the first stop on your full-day excursion. You will be able to take some breathtaking panorama pictures of the legendary Pyramids of Giza.

After that, you'll love exploring the Egyptian Museum, also known as the Museum of Egyptian Antiquities.

The museum's collection includes more than 120,000 items, ranging from ancient artwork and jewelry to mummies and other preserved human remains. and Some of the most famous exhibits include the treasures of King Tutankhamun.

After the tour, you will go back to your hotel in Cairo to spend the night.

Day 02: Fly to Luxor

After a delectable breakfast at the hotel, you will ride in a private A/C Car to Cairo's airport to catch your internal flight to Luxor.

We'll transport you in a private A/C car to start our journey on the east bank of the Nile River in southern Egypt; Luxor temple, The temple was initially built by Amenhotep III but was later expanded by several pharaohs including Tutankhamun, Horemheb, and Ramesses II.

after that, you will visit The Valley of the Kings is a burial ground located on the west bank of the Nile River. The valley contains the tombs of many famous pharaohs, including Tutankhamun, Ramses II, and Seti I. The tombs were designed to protect the pharaohs' bodies and their possessions, as it was believed that they would need them in the afterlife.

continue our tour in The Colossi of Memnon are two massive stone statues located on the west bank of the Nile River, The statues are made of quartzite sandstone and are over 18 meters (60 feet) tall. They are situated at the entrance of Amenhotep III's mortuary temple, which was once one of the largest and most opulent temples in ancient Egypt.

at the end of our tour, we will deliver you to Steigenberger Nile Palace Luxor to stay one night before heading to Hurghada.
