<u>Itinerary</u>

Day 1: Arrive Cairo / Check-in

Your tour guide from <u>Cairo Top Tours</u> will be waiting for you at <u>Cairo International Airport</u> to assist with the immigration procedure and drive you in a private vehicle to the start of your fantastic <u>Egypt Luxury tours</u>. Upon your arrival at the hotel in Giza, our tour manager will help you quickly and easily check-in. In order to make sure that all pick-up times are convenient for you and your travelling companion, he or she will also go through your schedule for <u>Egypt Safari tours</u> with you.

Cairo overnight

Day 2: Cairo day tour

The Great Giza Pyramid of King Cheops and the Middle Pyramid of his son Chephren, two of the world's oldest wonders that are still intact today, may be seen at <u>Giza Pyramids</u>. Your English-speaking tour guide will meet you at the hotel to begin your <u>Cairo day tours</u> after breakfast. You will also go to the <u>Valley Temple</u> of King Chephren and the <u>Great Sphinx</u>.

You will be escorted to <u>Egyptian Museum</u>, a two-story structure that has the world's biggest collection of Egyptian artifacts in addition to the one-of-a-kind golden treasure that the young king Tutankhamun supposedly found in the Valley of the Kings.

finally, be transferred to your hotel for the night.

Day 3: cairo to sinai

Our representative will greet you at your Cairo hotel to begin your fantastic Sinai Trekking Tours. After an early-morning journey of roughly 5 hours to Sinai, we'll check into the eco loge el karm Bedouin camp before beginning the Sinai trekking tour. After an hour of relaxation, check your luggage before beginning your walk.

Wadi Al Fara will be our first stop. The centerpiece of this trek is a steep mountain ascent and precipitous descent. There is a 3-kilometer off-road drive.

The next destination is Jabal Shayeb Al Banat, one of the Red Sea mountains in eastern Egypt's desert. Large volcanic rock slabs make up the mountain, and its sides are home to several deep valleys. Many tourist activities, such as camping, hiking trails, and rock climbing, are available on this mountain. then take you to Wadi el Nogra for a tour.

finally, deliver you back to your eco-camp el karm

Day 4: sinai day treks

prepare for breakfast in camp while enjoying bedouin tea, then be transferred to Wadi Tala. You will make your way back to St. Katherine on the route that lays before you. Instead, use the lower route that enters Wadi Itlah straight via a small gap in the side of a retaining wall made of stone. The thin

water curtains that, after a shower, drip off the rock face and colour it white and leave a V-shaped depression may be seen clearly from this vantage point.

afterward, we transfer you to see A sheik's tomb and a Bedouin village located in this area amid the Sinai's high mountains. The routes that connect St. Katherine and here provide a variety of mountain landscapes, making it a popular hiking destination.

then take you back to your camp so you can relax and have lunch there.

Day 5: Sinai to Cairo

After breakfast at the camp, we'll return to Cairo, take you to your hotel there so you can check in and spend the night.

Day 6; Old Coptic Cairo

Following breakfast, your tour guide will transport you to <u>Citadel of Salah El-Din</u> so you can view the Mohamed Ali Alabaster Mosque, one of Islamic Cairo's most popular landmarks.

After selecting from among the most delicious Egyptian food specialties for lunch, go on one of the half-day church tours in <u>Old Cairo</u> while learning about the former Roman defences of Babylon. The Hanging Chapel is among the attractions of these <u>Cairo day tours</u>.

You can see the <u>St. Sergius Church</u>, which was built over the crypt where Jesus Christ, his mother, and St. Joseph the Carpenter spent around three months. The last structure you will notice is the <u>Ben Ezra Synagogue</u>. Prior to the ninth century, it was built as a Coptic church and afterward converted to a Jewish synagogue.

As we begin our day excursions to Cairo, see the city's Islamic district. You may see old defenses together with mosques like Egypt's Al-Hakim mosque. The Islamic era left behind the city's historic stone-paved streets, medieval madrasas, sails, and city gates. Cap off your explorations of Islamic Cairo with a mint tea at Fishawy, one of the oldest and most renowned traditional Egyptian coffeeshops, Cairo's oldest coffee shop, as you take in the minarets of Al Hussein Mosque and Al Azhar Mosque in the oldest section of the Islamic quarter, Khan El Khalili, Egypt's oldest souk.

Our tour guide will then deliver you back to your hotel so you can unwind there.

Day 7: Final Departure

Enjoy your breakfast before being transferred to Cairo International Airport for your final flight.
