### **Itinerary**

### Day 1: Cairo to El-Fayoum

their tour guide Pick you up from your hotel in Cairo.

The Petrified Forest, the oldest commercial road in human history, the colorful mountain, and Qasr Al-Sagha are the first stops on our journey from Cairo to <u>Fayoum</u> in our 4WD. picnic meal After lunch in <u>Qarun lake</u>, It is regarded as the oldest natural lake in the entire world and is also the largest saltwater lake in Egypt.

Around the lake, you could come across various fruits and vegetables as well as an amazing variety of birds that are migrating south for the winter. we continue our trips to the Watermelon Valley, the ancient Greek-Roman city of Dima Al-Sebaa,

After that, you will be taken to the <u>Wadi El-Rayan Waterfalls</u>, where the scenery and sound of the waterfalls will make you feel pleased and calm, and then you will be taken to the Madinet Madi Ancient City, which was started by Amenemhet III and finished by Amenemhet IV.

then We will go to the Kom Aushim Museum, which is a good place to get maps of all of Fayoum. The museum was first built in 1974. It displays items from the Prehistoric to Roman Epochs and also features a portrait of Fayoum.

at the end of your day transfer you to spend the night and relax in fayoum hotel

## Day 2: fayoum tour- back cairo

Start your visits to the two museums of <u>Wadi El-Hitan</u> to witness the petrified whales and the museum of climate change after breakfast at your accommodation in Fayoum. on with your journey to A magnificent area known as Al Mudawara, The Lookout, with three mountains lining the shoreline, is located seven kilometres south of the waterfall along the left eastern side of the road.

after that, proceed to the miraculous lake. Beautiful Lake "The Magic Lake" is situated in Fayoum's Wadi El Rayan. It was given the nickname "Magic Lake" because, depending on the season and the quantity of sunshine it gets, it changes colours multiple times throughout the day.

It is surrounded by desert and is quite lovely. People spend their time swimming at Magic Lake or hiking and sandboarding next to it.

The lake is reported to include minerals that might relieve rheumatism patients.

Following that, we'll go to Tunis village to see Madam Eveline's ceramic studio. (Optional) Lunch in Tunis village is an option.
