<u>Itinerary</u>

Day 1: Arrive Cairo / Check-in

Your tour guide from Cairo Top Tours will be waiting for you at <u>Cairo International Airport</u> to assist with the immigration process and drive you in a private vehicle to the start of your fantastic Egypt tours. When you get to the hotel in Giza, our tour manager will help you check in quickly and easily and go through your schedule for <u>Egypt Travel Packages</u> with you to make sure that all pick-up times are convenient for you both.

Overnight in a hotel in Cairo

Day 2: Cairo day tour

After breakfast, your English-speaking tour guide will meet you in the hotel to begin your tour to the Giza Pyramids, where you will see the Great Pyramid of King Cheops and the Middle Pyramid of his son Chephren, two of the world's oldest wonders that are still standing today. You will also see the Great Sphinx and the Valley Temple of King Chephren in addition to the pyramid of King Mycerinus.

You will be taken to the <u>Egyptian Museum</u>, which has two storeys and has the world's largest collection of Egyptian artefacts, in addition to the one-of-a-kind golden treasure that the kid king Tutankhamen discovered unharmed in the Valley of the Kings.

The Hanging Church, which is perched above the fort's two towers, will be our first stop on our <u>Coptic Cairo tour</u> after that. The Ben Ezra Jewish Synagogue and the Abu Serga Church will thereafter be visible to you.

Enjoy your lunch at a reputable restaurant serving Egyptian food. We will then finish our Islamic Cairo Tours by seeing the most well-known mosques constructed during the Islamic era, <u>Khan El Khalili</u>, Cairo's historic bazaar, and returning to the hotel.

Day 3: East Bank of Luxor Tour

Prepare to check out of your hotel in Giza so that you may be transported to Cairo International Airport to board a domestic flight to <u>Luxor</u>, Egypt's tourism hub, where you will be greeted and assisted by a representative of our company. Set sail on a 5-star Egypt Nile cruise that departs from Luxor and ends in Aswan. Start the <u>East Bank excursions</u> in Luxor after lunch on the cruise ship to view the magnificent <u>Temple of Luxor</u>, which was begun during the time of King Amenhotep III and finished by several rulers.

Onboard your Egypt Nile River Cruises, a sumptuous meal will be provided.

Day 4: West Bank of Luxor

Our tour guide will accompany you to begin the west bank sightseeing in Luxor after breakfast on the Nile river cruise, starting with the enormous <u>Colossi of Memnon</u> and continuing to the <u>Valley of the Kings</u>, Queen Hatshepsut, or the purported temple of El Deir El Bahari.

Day 6: Aswan sightseeing

Day8:Cairo to Fayoum

<u>Tunis Village</u>, which is located across from the picturesque <u>Lake Qarun</u>, is the ideal starting place for your rural tour. You will be picked up by our tour guide from your hotel in Cairo and transported to Fayuom in a modern, air-conditioned car. The hamlet's acclaimed pottery workshops and schools, as well as a few enterprises that provide desert safari trips to the region's beautiful surroundings, may all be found on a tour that provides a glimpse of Egyptian agricultural life.

A must-see in Fayoum is the stunning Lake Qarun, which stretches for kilometers along the main road close to Tunis Village. You can count on getting a ride every time you see a boat. You can count on the peaceful waves to provide you a peaceful experience as they gently move you up and down.

Next, ask to be brought to Magic Lake at one of the few safari stores scattered around Tunis Village.It's just wonderful to witness this lovely lake, which is shrouded in a wall of sand dunes and changes hues throughout the day and year.

The off-roading activity is indeed thrilling; but, the tour guide will cram you into a whiny 44 and drive you 45 minutes into the desert to get there.

As soon as you get at the lake, they will cook a beautiful supper for you, set out some blankets and Bedouin tea, and then strap you onto the sandboard and assist you in sliding down the dune to the breathtaking natural beauty.

Then, board a Felucca and travel to Wadi Al Rayan, the biggest natural oasis in Egypt, where you may explore and snap breathtaking pictures.

In order for you to relax and spend the night in Fayoum hotel, we will then transport you there.

Day9: fayoum to cairo

After breakfast, you'll be picked up by our tour guide to go to <u>Wadi El Hitan</u>, sometimes referred to as the "Valley of the Whales," a fascinating UNESCO World Heritage site that was once a lake and is now the home to coastal marine animals that have persisted for millions of years. Here, it is possible to discover fossilised whale remains that have been preserved, showing how the mammal evolved from a terrestrial to a marine species. Visits to this wonderful place are unquestionably rewarding. then we'll stop for lunch at a neighbouring eatery.

then, we'll travel there. Next, we head to the Kom Aushim Museum, which is an excellent place to pick up maps of the entire city of Fayoum. The Museum's first construction began in 1974. The exhibit includes artefacts dating from the Prehistoric through the Roman times as well as a picture of Fayoum.

the subsequent halt Karanis (The Lord's Town) is one of the biggest Greco-Roman towns in the Fayoum. initially occupied by mercenaries from Ptolemy the Second's army in the third century B.C. In the city, there are two temples.

Day 10: Final Departure

You will check out of the hotel and get ready to be taken to <u>Cairo International Airport</u> for your last departure after breakfast at the hotel. If you have any free time, you can book any of our Cairo tours during this time.
