Day 1: Reaching Cairo Airport

Our tour guide will take you from Cairo Airport in comfortable air-conditional vehicles to the hotel after helping you with any paper documents at the airport. Day 2: The Great Pyramids of Giza and The Egyptian Museum

After having your breakfast, the personal tour guide will take you to visit the great <u>pyramids of Giza</u> and there you will have so much fun

The Giza pyramid complex The pyramids of Giza, Cairo, are one of the most important tourist attractions in Cairo. They are located on the Giza Plateau in Giza Governorate, on the west bank of the Nile River. It includes three pyramids of Khufu, Khafra, and Menkaure, which were built around 25 centuries BC. They are royal tombs, each bearing the name of the king who built it and who was buried in it. The hierarchical construction here is the stage of the development of tomb architecture in ancient Egypt. The pyramids are among the most important places of tourism in Egypt. The three pyramids of Egypt are characterized as one of the most important seven wonders of the world and one of the largest gases of ancient and modern history, and the most important tourism in Cairo.

and you can go to a souvenir shopping place where you can buy any present you want and after that, you will have your lunch looking at the magnificent view of the pyramids and the Nile then we will take you to Visit the Egyptian Museum where most of ancient Egypt's statuses are there.

Eventually, we will drive you back to the hotel to have dinner and get some sleep to prepare for the exciting next day.

Day 3: The Ancient Cairo Attractions

The tour guide will accompany you to see the most peaceful ancient Cairo attractions we will start with Mohamed Ali Mosque he was born in the city of Tula in Macedonia in the year 1182 AH / 1769 AD, and his father, "Ibrahim Agha" died while he was still young, then his mother died soon after, and he became an orphan of his parents, so his uncle "Tosun Agha" sponsored him. Ismail »who included him in the soldier's corps, and the signs of manhood appeared on him from courage, daring, and good eyesight, which qualified him for promotion to the rank of block Bashi. And when he finished the jihadi period, he engaged in commerce in the year 1215 AH / 1801 CE.

and it is lunch time now you will have a rest in one of our best Egyptian Restaurants

and the journey will be continued to visit <u>Salah El Din Citadel</u> he started the construction of this castle on the Mokattam Mountain in the year 572 AH / 1176 AD in a place known as the Dome of the Air, but he did not complete it during his life. To rule Egypt until the era of Khedive Ismail, who moved the seat of government to Abdeen Palace in Khedive Cairo.

Then you will go to the market of <u>Khan El Khalil</u>The clothing stores in this market lead the majority of visits, especially the popular clothing stores, as they reflect images of the heritage and culture of this city and are characterized by beautiful colors and embroideries. Women's and men's clothing stores. and it is not the only thing you can do there.

Then you go back to the hotel.

Day 4: Visit The City of Luxor and The East Bank

After completing your breakfast you will make your bags to catch a flight to Luxor from Cairo airport and after a while, you will start a new <u>Egypt Luxury Tours</u> adventure in a new country

which will start with <u>The Temple of Karnk</u> The Egyptians celebrate the phenomenon of the sun perpendicular to the Karnak Temple in Luxor on December 21 of each year, from six to eight in the morning, a phenomenon that reflects an aspect of the greatness of the ancient Egyptian, who was familiar with astronomy and the movement of the sun accurately.

Then you will visit <u>The Temple of Luxor</u> The Luxor Temple was not built by one king. The oldest building in it was a cabin dating back to the reign of Queen Hatshepsut (about 1473-1458 BC), while the heart of the temple was built during the reign of Amenhotep III (about 1390-1353 BC). One of the inner chambers contains a group of scenes known as scenes of divine birth, as it tells us the story of the king's lineage to the god Amun-Ra himself. The heart of the temple is preceded by a colonnaded hall, in front of which is a courtyard surrounded by columns.

return to your Luxor Nile cruise.at the night to see the great view of the Nile.

Day 5: The West Bank of Luxor

then your Egypt luxury tour in Luxor will finish with a great tour to the west bank which contain Valley of the Kings The tomb of King Khoper Khoprore I No. 23 in 1816 AD and the tomb of King Seti I No. 17 in 1817 AD were discovered by the archaeologist Belzoni. The tomb of Queen Hatshepsut No. 42 and the tomb of King Thutmose I No. 20 were discovered in 1908 AD by the English archaeologist Howard Carter. The tomb of King Thutmose IV No. 43, the tomb of King Yuya and Toyo No. 46, and the tomb of King Hob Moheb No. 57 were discovered by American lawyer Theodore Davis and the English archaeologist Edward Russell Ayrton mission.

this is the lunchtime to have some rest.

The next destination is <u>The Hatshepsut Temple</u> The temple was built during the 15 years of Queen Hatshepsut's reign, between the seventh year of her reign and the 22nd year of her reign. Senenmut, the head of the court during her reign, is the one who designed it and supervised its construction. Senenmut has some sites on the temple that indicate this, and its tomb is located under the first floor of the temple, and it extends about 97 meters in the mountain and ends with the coffin room at a depth of 43 meters. The tomb of Senenmut was found and the tomb was named TT353. He also participated in the construction of the temple «Habuseb» and «Nahi» head of the treasury, and «Zihuti» overseer of the House of Jewelry. This is evidenced by their names mentioned on the walls of the temple.

Then we will move to <u>Colossi of Memnon</u> From the moment when the building began until this time, the building has undergone many developments in terms of use, and the shape of the building has also changed so that it is estimated that the courtyard was originally covered by a large planetarium.

And after this long tour, you will go back to the cruise to have a rest.

Day 6: Edfu and Kom Ombo Temples

After finishing breakfast on board the cruise you will start the day with the <u>Edfu temple</u> visiting which is an Egyptian temple located on the west bank of the Nile in Edfu, Upper Egypt. The city was known in the Hellenistic and Latin periods as "Apollonopolis Magna", after the chief deity Horus, who was identified as Apollo under [[Interpretation of] Graeca]] It is one of the best-preserved shrines in Egypt. There are also "important scenes and inscriptions of sacred dramas that relate to the ancient conflict between Horus and Seth and have been translated by the German Edfu Project.

Then <u>Komombo Temple</u>, The small town of Kom Ombo is located on the eastern side of the Nile River, 45 km north of the city of Aswan and 800 km south of the Egyptian capital, Cairo. And that small city is surrounded by fields of sugar cane and corn, but at the same time there are many temples of the pharaohs and ancient Pharaonic monuments, among them the Temple of Kom Ombo, and the Greco-Roman temple in Kom Ombo that overlooks directly the Nile, which makes any Nile cruise approaching area, you visit the temple.

the ship will sail to reach Aswan, after having lunch.

Day 7: Aswan Day Tours

After having breakfast on the cruise and then get ready to start the day

you will start the day with the historical <u>The High Dam</u> The High Dam is considered the greatest and largest engineering project of the twentieth century in terms of architecture and engineering, outperforming other giant global projects.

After that, <u>The incomplete obelisk</u>, The time of excavation of this obelisk is not known precisely. It is believed that the start of work on it was during the reign of Queen Hatshepsut, with the aim of placing it, "transferring it" and installing it in the Karnak Temple in Luxor.

The tour concluded with lunch, dinner, and afternoon tea.

Day 8: Abu Simble and Back to Cairo

After getting your luggage from the cruise and having breakfast you will start visiting

First, <u>Abu Simble Temple</u>, During his reign, Ramesses II embarked on an extensive building program throughout Egypt and Nubia, which Egypt controlled. Nubia was important to the Egyptians because it was a source of gold and many other valuable trade goods. Therefore, Ramesses built many great temples there in order to dazzle the Nubians with the power of Egypt and their destiny.

After all the time you will spend, we will transfer you to the airport to get a flight to Cairo, And after reaching <u>Cairo Airport</u> we will take you to the hotel for breakfast only.

Day 9: A Day Tour in Fayum

Starting with some Egyptian breakfast you will get ready for the exciting day in Egypt, and the tour guide will accompany you during the tour.

In Cairo, get in a private van at your hotel. Drive leisurely 105 kilometers southwest of Cairo to Fayoum. An Egyptian city, the capital of Fayoum Governorate. It is divided into two residential neighborhoods separated by the Bahr Youssef Canal, which is in the middle of Fayoum. and when you reach you will start by visiting <u>Lake of Qarun</u> or the pond of Qarun is a lake in the city of Fayoum, Upper Egypt, located northwest of the city of Beni Suef, west of the Nile River, about 50 km away from it. Lake Qarun is located in Fayoum Governorate and is one of the largest natural lakes in Egypt.

and you will know some of its histories.

Then the tour guide will take you to Wadi El Rayan Reserve is located in the southwestern part of Fayoum Governorate. Wadi El Rayan consists of the upper lake, the lower lake, the waterfalls area that connects the two lakes, the Uyun al Rayyan area south of the lower lake, the Jabal al Rayan area, which is the area surrounding the eyes, and the Mudawara mountain area, which is located near the Lower lake. Wadi El Rayan is characterized by its integrated desert environment, including sand dunes, natural springs, different plant life, various animals, as well as marine excavations. The waterfalls area is also considered one of the various marine sports areas. and there are several types of hawks.

As your driver returns you to your hotel in Cairo, complete your trip.

Day 10: Flight to Sharm El Sheikh
