Itinerary

Day 1: Cairo Arrival

Our tour guide will meet you at <u>Cairo international airport</u> and take you in a private car to your hotel where you can have a rest and get a delicious meal to start your next day with full energy.

Day 2: Day Tour to Pyramids and Dahshur

After a nice warm meal you will start your journey by visiting <u>the great pyramids of Giza</u> where The pyramids constitute the largest facts of antiquity and the most informative witness to the present day on the ability of the pharaohs who built them, especially the Great Pyramid, that is, the pyramid of Khufu, which is considered one of the seven wonders of the ancient world. It was built by King Khufu, who ruled Egypt for 23 years from 2790 to 2767 BC.

After that you have a lunch in the view of great ancient pyramids

Then we will move to Dahshur which is near to the Giza pyramids and there you will see pyramids too <u>The village of Dahshur</u> is located about 40 kilometers southwest of Cairo, and it represents the southern end of the pyramid complex that begins in Giza. Excavations in Dahshur revealed the remains of seven pyramids, in addition to extensive tomb complexes that were built for queens and nobles from Memphis until the Thirteenth Dynasty in the Kingdom. Central.

Then you will be back in a private car to have your dinner and spend the night there.

Day 3: Tour to The National Museum of Civilization and El Refaai Mosque

After getting up and having your breakfast you will get ready for our next adventure

First, we will go and visit <u>The National Museum of Civilization</u> It is a large museum (23,235 square meters of exhibition space) in the ancient city of Fustat, now part of Cairo, Egypt. The museum was partially opened in February 2017 and will display a collection of 50,000 artifacts, showcasing Egyptian civilization from prehistoric times to the present day.

Then you will have lunch in a traditional restaurant nearby the area.

And our tour will be continued to visit <u>Sultan Hassan El Refaai Mosque</u> One of the famous ancient mosques in Cairo. I ordered its construction by Khushiar Hanim, the mother of Khedive Ismail in the year 1286 AH / 1869 AD, and entrusted Hussein Pasha Fahmy with the implementation of the project. In the year 1298 AH / 1880 AD, the building of the mosque was stopped, then Khoshyar Hanim died in the year 1303 AH / 1885 AD.

Then you will back to the hotel to have your dinner and stay there.

Day 4: Flight to Luxor

After having breakfast you will get ready to reach Luxor you will have some rest and check in at a hotel

Then we will go on a visit to <u>The Karnak Temple</u> The Karnak temple complex, known worldwide as Karnak, is a massive assemblage of ruins of temples, chapel spaces, massive columns, and other buildings. It is located 3 km from Luxor in Egypt.

And After this, you will move to <u>the Great Temple of Luxor</u> it is a large complex of ancient Egyptian temples located on the eastern bank of the Nile River in the city of Luxor today known as. It was founded in 1400 BC. The Luxor Temple was built for the worship of Amun-Ra, his wife Mut, and their son Khonsu. They are the deities that are also called the Theban Trinity

and at the end, you will back to the hotel to have your lunch and enjoy the nighttime in the charming City of Luxor.

Day 5: Visit to Luxor Attractions

Today you will visit the most famous attractions in Luxor at the beginning you will go to the valleys of Kings and Queens firsts you will see <u>the Valley of Kings</u> The secluded nature of this valley was another reason for choosing it as the last resting place of the kings, as the tombs were stolen in ancient times and to avoid that fate, they chose hidden underground tombs in a secluded desert valley .then you pass by <u>the Valley of Queens</u> Although the valley was in the eras of the 18th and 19th dynasties major place for the burial of queens, princes and some nobles, it was no longer a royal burial site after the conclusion of the 20th dynasty. Many of the tombs have been extensively reused, and many have been modified to accommodate multiple burials.

After that, you will get a break and have lunch surrounded by historical places.

Then you visit <u>el-Deir el-Bahari</u> It is a group of pharaonic temples and tombs located on the west bank of the Nile opposite Luxor, Egypt The monastery was built by Queen Hatshepsut to perform the rituals that would benefit her in the other world.

and we will continue to reach <u>the Colossi of Memnon</u> The two statues were in front of the entrance to an ancient funerary temple in memory of King Amenhotep III of the Eighteenth Dynasty, who ruled between 1417 and 1379 BC.

Eventually, you will back to the hotel to have some rest after this long day.

Day 6: Visit to Edfu and Kom Ombo Temples

On this day we will end our tour in Luxor by Visiting <u>The great temple of Edfu</u> Her ancient religious name was Hadat or Bahdatti, and he was the local god, and he is one of the many deities, one of which is called Horus, and he is called Hor Bahdatti or Horus Edfu, to distinguish between him and Horus, the son of Isis. then you will Visit <u>the temple of Komombo</u> The name Kom Ombo is divided into two parts: The first part: "Kum," which means "hill." The second part: "embo", which is a transliteration of "anbu" or "nebo", meaning "gold". This is because this city controlled the roads that lead to the gold mines, and the temple was known in Egyptian texts as Pasobek. That is, the headquarters of Sobek, that place in which he was worshiped since pre-dynastic times, and this temple is located on a very high hill, overlooking the Nile River.

And all the meals breakfast, lunch and dinner are included.

Day 7: Aswan Attractions

After breakfast, get ready to travel to Aswan in our private air-conditioned cars, where you'll see the High Dam. The first attempt to build a dam near Aswan dates back to the 11th century AD. The engineer Ibn al-Haytham (known as "Ibn al-Haytham" in the West) was summoned to Egypt by the Fatimid caliph, al-Hakim bi-Amrallah, to regulate the flooding of the Nile. The obelisk, carved from pink granite, is considered to be the longest Egyptian obelisk, reaching a length of 42 metres and a weight of around 1,000 tonnes, and features large cracks in its surface.

We end our tour of Aswan with a visit to the Nubian village. The roots of the village go back some 100 years, when construction of the ancient Aswan reservoir began in 1902 and was raised in 1912. It was necessary to establish a village on a sandy slope on the west bank of the river, west of Suhail Island, so that the inhabitants could live there, safe from the dangers of the annual floods.

Return to hotel in Luxor.

Breakfast, lunch and dinner are included in our program.

Day 8: Travel Back To Cairo

After Checking out from the hotel you will ride our prepared cars to catch your flight to Cairo International Airport again to have some relief and rest there to start our next adventure tomorrow.

Day 9: Fayum Day Tour

Starting with some Egyptian breakfast you will get ready for the exciting day in Egypt, and the tour guide will accompany you during the tour.

In Cairo, get in a private van at your hotel. Drive leisurely 105 kilometers southwest of Cairo to Fayoum. An Egyptian city, the capital of Fayoum Governorate. It is divided into two residential neighborhoods separated by the Bahr Youssef Canal, which is in the middle of Fayoum. and when you reach you will start by visiting Lake of Qarun or the pond of Qarun is a lake in the city of Fayoum, Upper Egypt, located northwest of the city of Beni Suef, west of the Nile River, about 50 km away from it. Lake Qarun is located in Fayoum Governorate and is one of the largest natural lakes in Egypt. and you will know some of its histories.

You have a rest to get your lunch and continue the journey

Then the tour guide will take you to Wadi El Rayan Reserve is located in the southwestern part of Fayoum Governorate. Wadi El Rayan consists of the upper lake, the lower lake, the waterfalls area that connects the two lakes, the Uyun al Rayyan area south of the lower lake, and the Jabal al Rayan area, which is the area surrounding the eyes.

As your driver returns you to your hotel in Cairo, you completed your tour.

Day 10: Visit To Bahariya Oasis and The White Desert

After having your Breakfast in the hotel you will ride our private air conditional car to <u>Bahariya Oasis</u> It is one of the oases of the Western Desert in Egypt, belongs to the Giza Governorate, and is located 365 km southwest of Giza. It is linked to Giza and Greater Cairo by the Cairo-Wahat Desert Road. It is located on a depression of more than 2,000 square kilometers. There are about 400 springs for warm and cold mineral and sulfur water. Its center is the city of Bawiti. and we will continue to reach <u>The White Desert</u> It has a white color that covers most of its parts, and its total area is 3010 square kilometers. The White Desert is a protected desert and natural landscape, as it represents a model of the karst Kama phenomenon. It is considered an open museum for the study of the desert environment. and we will Camp there all night.

Breakfast, Lunch, and Dinner all are prepared during the program.

Day 11: Back to Cairo

After this long enjoyable night, we will back to Cairo to have a nice warm shower and spend the day in the hotel or in your room as you wish.

Day 12: Travel To El-Ain El-Sokhna

After breakfast, get ready for El-Ain El-Sokhna in our comfortable private car and after several hours, we will check in at the Sea Star hotel and have free time to do whatever you want.

Day 13: Snorkeling in El-Ain El-Sokhna

After finishing your meal in the grand hotel of Stella di mare you will get ready to have Snorkeling on a boat in <u>the Red Sea</u> and after having a great time in the warm water you will be back to have Lunch and spend the night at the hotel.

Day 14: Back Again to Cairo
