### <u>Itinerary</u>

### Day 1: Cairo - Alamein WWII Cemetery and Museum - Siwa

Cairo Top Tours will meet you at your hotel to begin your <u>Egypt Desert Safari Tours</u> at 6:00 in the morning, you will be transported to Alamein on the North Coast of <u>Egypt</u> for approximately 3 hours of driving including coffee breaks to enjoy your informative El Alamein tour from Cairo by visiting the Museum of World War II, learn about the 2 main battles that happened at Al-Alamein and the results by details and numbers of each army participated in the chaos which resulted in a such big number of dead, wounded and lost soldiers at their youth.

Visit also the Commonwealth Cemetery and appreciate those who lost their lives and deserved all the respect and esteem. You will have the chance to see the Australian, Italian and German memorial Cemeteries during your Al Alamein tours before having an oriental lunch in a good quality restaurant in Marsa Matrouh after another 2 hours drive, then we will start moving to Siwa Oasis where you will check-in at your eco-lodge, have some rest and if we have enough time you can take a dip in one of the natural hot springs to relax your muscles after a long day drive.

### **Day 2: Siwa Sightseeing Tours**

Enjoy your Egyptian breakfast at your hotel, then start your Egypt Travel Packages to visit the old town of Shali at the center of the city, the <u>Shali Fortress</u> which is built from the kerchief method of building, by mixing salt, mud, and clay altogether, these local materials used by ancient Siwan people until now to make it cooler inside the buildings and houses, but unfortunately, the fortress of Shali which was built in the 13th Century had some parts melt-down after the heavy rains in the early 1930s.

Transfer to visit the most important site in Siwa, the Temple of <u>Alexander the Great</u> or also known as the <u>Temple of the Oracle</u> of Amun, it got its popularity after Alexander the Great visited the temple and asked the oracle to get a confirmation that he was the son of Zeus of the Greeks (Amun Re in ancient Egyptian Religion). The temple was built in the <u>twenty-sixth Dynasty</u> B.C. in the ancient village known as Aghurmi Village.

Continue to see the ruins of the <u>Temple of Amun at Um Ubayda</u> dedicated to the triad of <u>Amun</u>, Mut, and Khonso. The temple is ruined as a reason for the governor of Siwa to blow.

up the temple in 1869 to build a big palace and a presidential resthouse. Now it's time to learn more

about the culture of the Siwan people, their traditions, and daily-life tools and accessories by visiting the <u>Siwan House</u>, which was built by the Siwan people as participation to keep their heritage from being forgotten. Enjoy your lunch in a good quality restaurant then have a relaxing afternoon at <u>Cleopatra Spring</u> known as Ein Guba, to dip in its warm natural water that is rich with sulfur and minerals before being transferred to the hotel and overnight.

# Day 3: Great Siwa Mountain - Great Sand Sea Safari - Bir Wahed Hot Spring

Enjoy your breakfast at the Eco-lodge then start your <u>Siwa Oasis Desert Safari</u>, first at Maraki Village to visit the unique archaeological site at the Great Siwa Mountain, the first-ever human footprint found that dates back to the prehistoric era. Continue our tour between the dunes till we arrive at the fossils area and see the rocky coral reefs which date back to the Cambrian era.

Drive to one of the captivating sites in the <u>Great Sand Sea</u>, the third-largest sand accumulation in the world, to have an extremely adventuresome Jeep Safari, stop at a beautiful lake in the middle of the desert and it is a good chance to swim with the friendly Tilapia fish. Then get thrilled by the Sand Boarding experience, which is not as fast as snowboarding but by adding wax to the bottom of the board, you can shoot down some of the bulky dunes and have fun. After Sand Boarding in Siwa.

Now it is time to wash up in the hot spring known as <u>Bir Wahid</u> (well number 1) which is one of the principal <u>things to do in Siwa</u> for relaxation. Enjoy another mesmerizing Sun Set at the Great Sand Sea in the middle of the dunes while having a lemon-leaf Bedouin tea.

### **Day 4: Siwa Oasis**

Have your breakfast served at the Eco-lodge, then start the tour to the rock-cut tombs at the Mountain of the Dead (Gabal El Mauta ) visit the impressive tombs of the rulers of Siwa Oasis during the 26th dynasty like the tomb of SI Amon and another tomb known as the Crocodile Tomb., there is no evidence about to whom this tomb had been cut, but it had been famous of the well-preserved crocodile painting inside the tomb.

After that, tour the Bedouin Village of Abu Ali to enjoy the Bedouin lifestyle and see the canyon-like mountains to try the voice echo through the silence of the place. Back to Siwa to visit the famous <a href="Dakrour Mountain">Dakrour Mountain</a>, where the Siwan people celebrate the annual festival of Tourism in Siwa Oasis (El Syaha) at the first full moon of October. Enjoy another sunset captivating view at the magical Fitnas Island while having a hot local drink and make your own timelapse photos before being transferred back to the city center for overnight in your Eco-lodge.

### Day 5: Siwa - Cairo

Transfer from Siwa to Cairo after breakfast and check in to your hotel in Cairo for overnight and an early morning trip to Bahariya Oasis tour from Cairo.

### Day 6: Cairo to Bahariya Oasis and White Desert

Transfer to <u>Bahariya Oasis</u> From Cairo in the morning. You will have your lunch on the trip to Bahariya. At the time of sunset, you will climb Black Mountain by the 4WD Jeep to visit the ruins of the English House and get a scenic view of the whole Oasis and Salt Lake surrounded by the green date palm forests. Visit the <u>Museum of the Golden Mummies</u>, and from its name, we notice that the mummies inside are covered in gold, created during the Greco-Roman era in Egypt, and have a composition of mummies of the ancient Egyptian rulers.

Next, you will take a visit to <u>The Tombs of Nobles</u> at Qasr Sleem like the rock-cut tombs of Zed-Amun-Ef-Ankh and Bannentiu, and the <u>Temple of Ain El Muftella</u> which are devoted to the ancient Egyptian God Bis, the god of joy and entertainment according to the ancient Egyptian religion, the Temple of Alexander the Great, which was imperiled to many natural factors that led to the destruction of most of the inscriptions and sculptures, then we will travel to the <u>White Desert</u>, passing through the Black Desert, a region of volcano-shaped mountains with large quantities of small black stones, and the Valley of El Haize the southernmost village of Bahriya Oasis with its delightful spring.

Stop to see the quartz crystal at <u>Crystal Mountain</u> and the magnificent Valley of Agabat, one of the wonderful attractions that we can find on our trips to Egypt. <u>Camping in the white desert</u> with a chance to enjoy an astonishing sunset view while your guides cook your dinner, overnight camping in the White Desert.

### Day 07: Back to Cairo

The following day in the early morning, you will have breakfast at the campsite then visit the hot spring where you can bathe, relax, and enjoy its beautiful calm water. Then drive back to Bahariya and then from Bahariya to Cairo.
