#### Day 01 :arrival in Cairo

Despite its state of disrepair, the Sphinx remains one of the most popular attractions in Memphis. The Sphinx is a large statue that serves as a guardian at the entrance to the pyramid. Additionally, visitors can observe the remains of the burial chambers and other discovered artifacts at the site. after this, we will take you to enjoy a Luxury lunch in Cairo, but if you want to take lunch on the Nile with a panoramic view, it will be a wonderful experience (optional activity).

# Day 03: The National Museum of Egyptian Civilization and Suez Canal

After a delectable breakfast at your Cairo hotel, your accredited Egyptologist will take you to the National Museum of Egyptian Civilization. The rich history and culture of Egypt are on display at <a href="https://docume.civilization">The National Museum of Egyptian Civilization</a> (NMEC). and is Egypt's biggest museum devoted to ancient Egyptian culture.

The NMEC features a significant exhibition called the "Royal Mummies Hall," which exhibits the mummies of 22 ancient Egyptian kings and queens, providing a close view of the mummies and their intricate burial customs.

Following that, you will be transported to the <u>Ismalia government</u> in a comfortable, air-conditioned car to observe the Suez Canal, a crucial trade route for transporting goods between Europe and Asia. The canal enables ships to avoid longer and more dangerous trips around Africa's southern tip.

During your visit to the Suez Canal, you will witness ships passing through it from panoramic viewpoints along the canal's banks and enjoy a delectable seafood lunch.

#### Day 04: Alexandria

He established one of the largest empires in the ancient world, and it had become the Capital city of Egypt for almost 1000 years until the Arab conquest in the 7th century, and it remained the second biggest and most important city after Cairo.

When you arrive we will start our <u>day tour in Alexandria</u> by visiting <u>the Catacombs of Kom El Shoqafa</u>, which was a private tomb of a rich Romanized Egyptian family that has been expanded in later centuries to become a burial for the common people of Alexandria. From there you will have a short drive to the great <u>Pompey's Pillar</u>, which is the highest-standing pillar in Egypt built by the people of Alexandria in gratuity for the Roman Emperor Diocletian who diverted a portion of the annual tribute of corn and grain that Egypt used to send to Rome to the relief of the citizens.

also, you will visit the Library of Alexandria It was one of the largest and most significant libraries of the ancient world, containing a vast collection of manuscripts, books, and other materials. The library was known for its impressive architecture, which included a massive reading room with space for hundreds of scholars. Then you will be driven to the seaside to enjoy the views of the Mediterranean Sea until you reach the Citadel of Qaitbay, which is established in 1477 A.D. on the ruins where the legendary lighthouse Pharos used to be standing. after that you will visit The Abu Al-Abbas Al-Mursi Mosque, the mosque is considered to be one of the most important Islamic landmarks in Alexandria and attracts many visitors and worshippers every year. Its distinctive features include a large dome.

you will have a special experience trying traditional Egyptian food before Spending another night at the hotel in Paradise Inn.
