Itinerary

Day 1 - Cairo Arrival

Meet our tour leader at Cairo airport, welcome, and assist at <u>Cairo International Airport</u>. Transfer to the hotel and check-in

Relax and overnight.

Day 2- Tour Giza Pyramids, Sphinx, Memphis, and Saqqara

Our <u>Egypt Holidays offers</u> at 8:00 a.m. Pickup from your Cairo or Giza hotel Your tour guide will direct you to begin your full-day excursion to <u>Giza Pyramids</u>, where you will see the Great Pyramids of Cheops, Chephren, and Mykerinos. Next, you will go to the <u>Valley Temple</u>, where the priests mummified King Chephren's lifeless body. You may also get a close-up view of The Sphinx, a fabled protector with a lion's body and king Chephren's head that stands near a sizable funerary complex.

Then go to <u>Sakkara</u>, which is only 27 kilometers southwest of Cairo. Visit the <u>Step Pyramid</u> (built for King Zoser), which is regarded as a crucial stage in the evolution of the pyramids from the straightforward mastaba to its well-known shape.

Next, go to the <u>Dahshur Pyramids</u> (Bent and <u>Red Pyramid</u>) About 40 kilometers (25 miles) south of Cairo, on the West Bank of the Nile, lies a royal necropolis called Dahshur region. It is well renowned for its several pyramids, two of which were constructed between 2613 and 2589 BCE and are among the oldest, biggest, and best preserved in all of Egypt.

Visit Memphis that is included in our <u>Cairo day tours</u>, the former capital of Egypt, to see the enormous statue of Ramses II and the magnificent Sphinx made of alabaster. this City has been around since 3100 B.C. (1 hr time Spent) There is the option to ride a camel around the Giza pyramids, visit King Cheops' solar boat, ride a quad bike in the wide desert, or take a Felucca ride sailing on the Nile after the tour is over. However, all of these activities can be added on at any time during the booking process and will incur additional costs.

Day 3 - Egyptian Museum, Khan El Khalili, and Old Cairo Tour

Our representative will pick you up from your accommodation in the morning, after breakfast. To enjoy a tour of the most fascinating museum, the Egyptian Museum, which houses items from the Pharaonic period, The collection, which spans 5000 years and is said to be the world's greatest and most valuable collection of Egyptian art, is on exhibit in the museum. The exhibition features more than 250,000 astounding objects, including a section devoted to Tutankhamun's hoard of gold, jewels, and treasures, which was kept in his tomb for more than 3,500 years before it was uncovered in the 1920s.

You will then go on to lunch, after that. Continue your drive to the Islamic part of Cairo, where you may visit Khan El Khalili, the city's historic market. The shops in this neighborhood are renowned for their beautiful brassware, copper, fragrances, leather, silver, gold, antiquities, and other items. You'll afterward be driven back to your hotel.

Day 4 - Cairo Tower & Cairo Citadel Tour

In order to understand more about Egypt, our representative will pick you up from your hotel after breakfast and take you to The <u>Cairo Tower</u>, a free-standing concrete tower in Cairo. It is currently Cairo's highest point. At 187 m, it held the title of the tallest structure in Egypt and North Africa for about 50 years. From up there, one can see the <u>Saladin Citadel</u>, the Nile, and all of Cairo. From 1910 to 1971, it held the record for the highest structure in Africa. It is a lovely viewpoint and a wonderful experience.

Then have lunch at a local restaurant and Visit the <u>Mohamed Ali Mosque</u> within the Salah El Din Citadel, atop the Mokattam Hills, which Salah al-Din constructed in 1183 AD as a defense against Crusader forces. A restored medieval location with mosques and museums is what it is now.

then return you back to your Cairo hotel

Day 5 - Tour to Manial Mohamed Ali Palace, Abdeen Palace and Baron Palace.

Our tour guide will greet you in the lobby of your hotel in the morning, and he will take you in an air-conditioned car to the magnificent Manial Palace of Prince Mohamed, well known as "King Farouk's uncle." He had it built in a manner that combined several traditional Islamic architectural elements with European Art Nouveau and Rococo.

Then you'll go there. The ancient <u>Abdeen Palace</u> in Cairo was constructed as one of the official homes for Egypt's erstwhile governing dynasty and royal family. It is now one of the President of Egypt's official houses and is situated above Qasr el-Nil Street in eastern Downtown Cairo.

After that, you'll visit the <u>Baron Palace</u>, which was founded by Belgian businessman Baron Edward Empain and is situated on Al-Oruba Street in Heliopolis, Cairo. The palace is constructed in the style of Indian architecture.

A variety of images, historical records, artwork, maps, and letters pertaining to the history of Heliopolis' area (Heliopolis and Al-Mataria) from various historical periods are on display in the palace.

You will be taken back to the hotel when the trip is over after having lunch at a local restaurant.

Day6- Aswan - Nile Cruise

Hotel breakfast served in the morning. Your flight to Aswan will be picked up and transported to Cairo International Airport. We begin our <u>Aswan day tours</u> at the <u>Philae Temple</u> and the <u>Unfinished Obelisk</u> as soon as we arrive in Aswan. Check-in, lunch, and transportation to the Nile cruise. Take a Felucca boat trip around Elephantine Island after lunch. A meal served on the cruise liner.

Day 7 - Sailing - Kom Ombo Temple Tour

Kom Ombo navigation in the morning. Start our guided tour of the <u>Kom Ombo temple</u> after breakfast. It was constructed by the Ptolemies and curiously devoted to two separate gods. Dinner and lunch are served on the cruise ship.

Day 8- Edfu Temple Visit – Sailing to Luxor

We began our visit to the <u>Edfu temple</u> after breakfast on the cruise ship, Using a horse-drawn carriage. The temple is one of the best preserved and the second biggest in all of Egypt. Keep sailing so you may subsequently observe the Nile's Esna lock crossing operation. Dinner and lunch are served on the cruise ship.

Day 9: Luxor Sightseeing Tours

Following breakfast on board your Nile cruise ship.our tour guide transfer you to Begin a personal day excursion to the Valley of the Kings, Queen <u>Hatshepsut's Temple</u>, the Temple of Medinet Habu, and the Memnon Colossi. transfer to the cruise ship and sail back to Luxor.

Day 10 - Disembark- fly to Cairo

After your final open buffet breakfast on the cruise ship, disembark from your <u>Egypt Nile cruise</u>. We will then transport you to the Luxor airport so you can get a flight to Cairo. Once in Cairo, check into your hotel, unwind, and spend the night.

Day 11- Desert and Bahariya Oasis Day Trip

In the morning at 6:00, our tour guide and driver will pick you up from your hotel in Cairo and drive you in a private, air-conditioned vehicle to the <u>Bahariya Oasis</u>, which is 350 kilometers west of Giza. The trip takes about 4 hours. Once you arrive in Bahariya, switch to a 44 and travel 40 kilometers through the desert to see the <u>Black Desert</u>.

After that, lunch will be given at a well-known, local restaurant named El Hez, where you may swim and relax before or after.

Then, go 90 km to the Agbata and Crystal deserts, as well as various mountains and sand dunes, before continuing on to the <u>White Desert</u>, one of the nicest deserts in the entire world. Its white, magnificent rocks have many diverse shapes, including mushrooms, chickens, and rabbits. Return to Cairo by car

Day 12 - Departure

Enjoy your breakfast on the final day of your <u>Egypt trips</u> before being driven to the airport in Cairo to catch your flight home.
