<u>Itinerary</u>

Day 1: Friday - Embarkation - Aswan Nile Cruise Tours

Our accredited tour leader will pick up you upon arrival at Aswan Airport, then he will transfer you to the cruise ship before lunch at approximately 11:00 in the morning. Enjoy your buffet lunch aboard the boat, then begin <u>Aswan excursions</u>, you will visit the High Dam which is the largest in Egypt, Aswan High Dam was built during the time of the former president of Egypt (Nasser), transfer to visit the beautiful Temple of Philae, the pearl of Egypt, it is located on the Agilika Island in Aswan and was flooded before the construction of the high dam in Egypt, the temple was transferred stone by stone to a new island in Aswan. Visit the Unfinished Obelisk that was cut during the reign of the female pharaoh <u>Hatshepsut</u>, The Obelisk is inside the granite quarries that used to provide Egypt with the required stones from the dawn of history. Have your dinner and spend the night aboard the Nile cruise in Aswan.

Meals: Lunch, Dinner

Day 2: Saturday - Optional Abu Simbel - Kom Ombo Temple

Breakfast on board your Egypt Nile River cruise ship. Optional tour to Abu Simbel temples from Aswan, the best two temples in Egypt that were built by the greatest pharaoh of the new kingdom, for himself as the Semi-God Ramses II, and his beloved wife, the most beautiful queen in ancient Egypt Nefertari. Sail to Kom Ombo while having lunch aboard the ship. Visit the Kom Ombo temple that is dedicated to the two gods of ancient Egypt, the crocodile God Sobek and Haroeris who was one of the figures of Horus according to the ancient Egyptian religion. Sail to Edfu. Have dinner and spend the night aboard the Nile cruise ship in Edfu.

Day 3: Sunday - Edfu Temple

After having breakfast, visit the Temple in Edfu dedicated to the great god of the sky in ancient Egypt, Horus the falcon, the Edfu Temple is the most preserved of all the Egyptian temples, and the work was completed in almost 200 years. Sail to Luxor while having your tasty lunch aboard the boat with

afternoon tea. dinner and overnight aboard the Nile cruise in Luxor.

Day 4: Monday - Disembarkation - Luxor East and West Bank Tours

Breakfast aboard the Nile Cruise and start <u>Luxor sightseeing tours</u>. Begin with the <u>West Bank of Luxor tours</u>, the Valley of the Kings, so far 64 tombs of the greatest pharaohs of Egypt have been discovered, especially the intact tomb of Tutankhamen the only one found without being stolen in Egypt in the ancient city of Thebes, Luxor city. Now we will visit the Temple of <u>Queen Hatshepsut</u> or also known as El Deir El Bahari Temple, the female pharaoh of ancient Egypt, the temple is a series of steps in limestone, a really extraordinary monument in Egypt that was built by the famous architect Senmout.

Continue Luxor tours to see the Colossi of Memnon which are two great Colossi of Memnon built for the pharaoh Amenophis III, the only monuments that remain from his funeral temple near the valley of the kings in Luxor. Then start Luxor east bank tours to the two great temples of Luxor, the largest Temple in Egypt, Karnak Temple, inside the temple you can enter the great hypostyle hall, an incredible forest of huge pillars, covering such a large area, built during the reign of King Ramses II and Seti I, continue to visit the Temple of Luxor that was connected to the Karnak Temple by the avenue of sphinxes on both sides, dedicated to the famous ancient Egyptian god Amun Ra, enjoying the great figures of the famous Pharaoh Ramses the second then transfer to Luxor Airport or the train terminal for your departure after disembarkation from the Nile cruise boat.
