Itinerary

Day 1: Welcome to Cairo:

Your tour leader will meet you at <u>Cairo International Airport</u> and assist you with the check-in procedure. He will then take you to your hotel in a classy, air-conditioned vehicle. In addition to assisting you with a comfortable hotel check-in, the tour leader will go over your travel itinerary with you in order to identify and confirm the pick-up times for each tour. Overnight in Cairo.

Day 2: Giza Pyramids / Saqqara / Memphis

Your professional tour guide will pick you up from your accommodation to start the exciting <u>Egypt day tours</u>. At the agreed-upon pick-up time, you will travel to The Great Pyramid of Cheops, which was constructed by the fabled King Snefru of the Old Kingdom in prehistoric Egypt. You will have ample time to walk inside or stand on the pyramid and take pictures. Then you'll head up the hill to see the Pyramid of King Khafra Chephren and the Pyramid of Mycerinus, the smallest of <u>Pyramids of Giza</u>. You can take close-up photos of <u>Great Sphinx</u>, one of the most well-known sphinxes, as you are taken to <u>Valley Temple</u>.

As part of your Cairo Tours to Saqqara, visit the <u>Step Pyramid</u>, which was built for King Djoser, the first king to have a step pyramid built for him. Imhotep, an astute architect, created the Step Pyramid, which was built in Egypt's third dynasty. Visitors can explore King Teti's pyramid, which was built during the old kingdom, as well as the pyramids of the first monarch of the sixth dynasty. The group also visits King Unas' pyramid, which has the most spectacular burial chambers of any pyramid (no extra ticket is required). You'll visit the <u>Mastaba Tombs</u> of the Nobles in Saqqara to see scenes from daily life in ancient Egypt.

After lunch at a neighborhood restaurant in <u>Saqqara</u>, you will be taken to the Memphis Museum to see the enormous limestone statue of King Ramses II of the nineteenth dynasty, the greatest builder and ruler of the New Kingdom, as well as the <u>Sphinx</u>, which is the second-largest sphinx statue from ancient Egypt and is made from an 80-ton block of marble.

Last but not least, you will be escorted to <u>Dahshur</u>, one of the most intriguing ancient Egyptian archaeological sites, where you will see King Senfru's pyramids and hear about the history of the pyramids (the old kingdom). The <u>Red Pyramid</u> is the tallest and third-largest ancient building in the Dahshur Necropolis, After this breathtaking trip, which you may take as part of your Cairo or Giza excursions, you'll be taken back to your lodging in those cities.

Day 3: Egyptian Museum, copitic and islamic Cairo:

Hotel breakfast is available. You will be met and driven to the Egyptian Museum in a private vehicle by one of our English-speaking Egyptologists. <u>Egyptian Museum</u> is a historical site with many stunning monuments and historical artifacts.

Lunch at a neighborhood restaurant is nice. Then <u>Saladin Citadel</u>, which is located in Salah El Din, and the Mohamed Ali Mosque, which was constructed in 1805 AD in the Turkish style of design and is startlingly similar to the Blue Mosque of Turkey. Visit the Holy Virgin Mary Church, also known as the <u>Hanging Church</u>, the Ben Ezra Synagogue, and the cave church of St. Sergius while taking a tour of Old Cairo, which also covers the Coptic district.

You'll be driven back to your accommodation at the conclusion of your Cairo day tours.

Day 4: Luxor East bank Sightseeing Tour:

After breakfast, meet with our guide at the hotel. He or she will help you load your private vehicle and drive to Cairo airport, where your flight to Luxor will be waiting for you. When you get there, Luxor will transport you to your hotel so you can relax. Visit the magnificent Karnak Temple and Luxor Temple on the city's east bank, and then be taken to your hotel.

Day 5: Luxor West bank Sightseeing Tour:

Meet and assist our guide after breakfast at your hotel. As part of your <u>Luxor day tours</u>, you may stop at <u>Valley of the Kings</u> in the West Bank before moving on to The <u>Colossi of Memnon</u> and Queen Hatshepsut Temple at El Deir El Bahari We'll eat lunch at a nearby restaurant before the trip. After that, you'll be driven to your hotel in Luxor to spend the night.

Day 6: Aswan Excursions (The High Dam - Unfinished Obelisk)

After breakfast the following morning, one of our agents will pick you up from the hotel and take you to Aswan. When you arrive in Aswan, a new agent will be present to transport you to your accommodation. Visit the <u>High Dam</u>, which has had a big impact on Egypt's economy and culture, after you check in and relax. After finishing your <u>Aswan day tours</u> with a visit to the famed <u>Unfinished Obelisk</u>, which depicts the obelisk's carving history, you will be driven to your hotel in Aswan for the night.

Day 7: Aswan Excursions (Philae Temple Sound and Light

Show)

Our tour guide transfers you to the Philae temple after breakfast. After breakfast, your tour of Aswan continues to the <u>Philae Temple</u>, one of the four locations where the story of Isis, Osiris, and Horus occurred. Here was the temple that the goddess Isis used to visit.

Lunch at a neighborhood restaurant. Then. You'll head back to your hotel room in Aswan. The Philae Temple Sound and Light Show are among Aswan's most beautiful evening events. We'll delve deeply into the mythology surrounding the goddess Isis and the god Osiris, as well as the history of ancient Egypt.

The Philae Temple's location was in jeopardy for six months out of the year because it was frequently underwater. The temple was relocated to the higher ground level of <u>Agilika Island</u>, where it is currently, following a significant and crucial battle to try to save it from disappearing due to the tremendous flooding of water that occurred in the middle of the 20th century. As you tour the island's most important landmarks and learn about its history, take in the breathtaking laser shows that highlight the majesty and splendor of the historical environment.

Following the performance, you'll board a boat to return to the harbor, where a shuttle will transport you to your Aswan lodging.

Day 8: Tour to Abu Simbel Temples - Back to Cairo

Breakfast is offered in your hotel. our tour guide will offer you a personal, air-conditioned tour of <u>Abu Simbel</u>. You'll visit the Ramses IV Temples at Abu Simbel. When your excursion is done, a vehicle will take you to Aswan's airport so you may catch a flight back to Cairo. Spend the night in Cairo by checking into your hotel.

Day 9: Final Departure

Enjoy your breakfast on the final day of your vacation package before being driven to the airport in Cairo to catch your flight home.
