In Egypt, there's a special museum called <u>Al-Aqmar Mosque</u> | <u>Gray Mosque</u>. It's a cool place that can make you feel like you traveled back in time. Inside, you can learn about how people used to live a long time ago. It's like finding hidden treasures from the past! <u>Itinerary</u>

Day 01 :arrival in Cairo

You will be welcomed in a private air-conditioned car by a professional tour guide speaking English at <u>Cairo International Airport</u>, When you arrive at the Cairo pyramids hotel or similar, the Cairo Top Tours guide will assist with a quick check-in and he will review your Honeymoon tour Package itinerary with you to confirm pick-up times for each tour. At the hotel, you will be served a welcome drink.

Overnight in Cairo

Day 02: Visiting the Giza pyramids and Memphis

after your breakfast,

Start with your tour to Giza Pyramids to see the huge structures that were built by the great pharaohs of Egypt during the 4th dynasty, Cheops, Chephren, and Mycerinus. The three pyramids are believed to be built according to a group of stars with the main entrance locates to the north to serve as burial tombs for the semi-god kings. The biggest one belongs to King Cheops and your tour guide will get into details about why and how the great pyramids were built.

Proceed to the high spot to enjoy camel riding in Giza Pyramids (optional) and your Bedouin guide will capture impressive tricky photos for you.

Now we will see the Great Sphinx, the man-headed lion figure which is 73 meters tall and we will also enter the Valley Temple which is another interesting part of the funerary complex of King Chephren.

Have your delightful lunch meal in one of the good quality restaurants and transfer to <u>Memphis</u>, now known as Mit Rahina to see the open-air museum with its amazing artifacts, especially <u>the alabaster sphinx</u> of Memphis, and the colossal statue of Ramses II, the new kingdom pharaoh who is the owner of the impressive Abu Simbel Temples in Aswan.

Day 03: The National Museum of Egyptian Civilization and Suez Canal

Have your breakfast in the main restaurant of your hotel in Cairo, and get prepared for your amazing <u>Cairo Day Tours</u>. You will meet your Egyptologist guide to start your tour of The National

Museum of Egyptian Civilization is the first museum in the Arab world to focus on ancient Egyptian civilization, The museum has a vast collection of artifacts including 20 royal mummies and treasures from the Greco-Roman, Coptic.

after that, you will be transferred to the Ismalia government to enjoy the most important site in Egypt, The Suez Canal is a sea-level waterway that connects the Mediterranean Sea to the Red Sea. It is located in Egypt and is an important international trade route, you can take a cruise down the canal or observe the ships passing through the canal from one of the observation decks. Additionally, you can explore nearby historical sites (additional option) such as the city of Suez, the Port Said Museum, and the Ismailia Museum.

Day 04: Alexandria

Our licensed guide and personal driver will meet you after enjoying breakfast at the hotel to continue your Egypt Travel Packages. You will start the tour to Alexandria from Cairo. Alexandria is built in 332 B.C. by the famous leader Alexander the Great who was a great king of the ancient Greek Kingdom. He established one of the largest empires in the ancient world, and it had become the Capital city of Egypt for almost 1000 years until the Arab conquest in the 7th century, and it remained the second biggest and most important city after Cairo.

When you arrive we will start our <u>day tour in Alexandria</u> by visiting <u>the Catacombs of Kom El Shoqafa</u>, which was a private tomb of a rich Romanized Egyptian family that has been expanded in later centuries to become a burial for the common people of Alexandria. From there you will have a short drive to the great <u>Pompey's Pillar</u>, which is the highest-standing pillar in Egypt built by the people of Alexandria in gratuity for the Roman Emperor Diocletian who diverted a portion of the annual tribute of corn and grain that Egypt used to send to Rome to the relief of the citizens.

also, you will visit the Library of Alexandria It was one of the largest and most significant libraries of the ancient world, containing a vast collection of manuscripts, books, and other materials. The library was known for its impressive architecture, which included a massive reading room with space for hundreds of scholars. Then you will be driven to the seaside to enjoy the views of the Mediterranean Sea until you reach the Citadel of Qaitbay, which is established in 1477 A.D. on the ruins where the legendary lighthouse Pharos used to be standing. after that you will visit The Abu Al-Abbas Al-Mursi Mosque, the mosque is considered to be one of the most important Islamic landmarks in Alexandria and attracts many visitors and worshippers every year. Its distinctive features include a large dome.

you will have a special experience trying traditional Egyptian food before Spending another night at the hotel in <u>Paradise Inn.</u>
