<u>Itinerary</u>

Day 1: Welcome to Cairo:

A representative from Cairo Top Tours will meet you at <u>Cairo International Airport</u> and drive you to your hotel for the night. We'll review your itinerary to make sure all of our <u>Egypt day tours</u> are booked properly for your nine days of travel to Cairo, Luxor, Aswan, and <u>Abu Simbel</u>.

Day 2: Giza Pyramids / Saqqara / Memphis

After breakfast at the hotel, you will meet your private tour guide and travel to The <u>Great Sphinx</u> and the Pyramids of Giza are two of the most amazing places on earth. There, you will see all the magic of the entire world that the Egyptian pharaohs did in this monumental collection, have the chance to ride camels in The <u>Giza pyramids</u>, and visit the <u>Valley Temple</u> of Khafra.

Visit <u>Memphis</u>, another breathtaking destination, which served as the Old Kingdom capital of ancient Egypt, after lunch.

It is located south of the Nile Delta. You can see the enormous statue of Ramses II here as well as other intriguing artifacts like the <u>Alabaster Sphinx</u> of Memphis before moving on to the <u>Step Pyramid</u> of King Dozer in Saqqara, which is a great monument and contains some magnificent tombs of the nobles like the one facing the Pyramid of King Teti of the 6th dynasty, the tomb of Kagemni to see some impressive scenes of ancient Egyptian art. You will return to the hotel for the evening following your tour of the Giza Pyramids.

Day 3: Egyptian Museum , copitic and islamic Cairo :

In the morning have your breakfast then Our English-speaking Egyptologist guide will welcome you and take you in a private vehicle to The <u>Egyptian Museum</u>. A historical location with a plethora of magnificent monuments and historical treasures is the Egyptian Museum. Lunch at a local eatery is enjoyable.

You may find out more about Islamic Cairo Trips by visiting The <u>Saladin Citadel</u>, which Salah El Din Al-Ayoubi built, and the <u>Mohamed Ali Mosque</u>, which was built in 1805 AD in the Turkish style of design and is remarkably comparable to the Blue Mosque of Turkey. On your tour of Old Cairo, which also covers the Coptic neighborhood, the Holy Virgin Mary Church, popularly known as the <u>Hanging Church</u>, the Ben Ezra Synagogue, and the cave church of St. Sergius are the next stops. After your <u>Cairo day tours</u>, you will be driven to your accommodation in Cairo.

Day 4: Arrive Luxor (The East Bank Tours)

After breakfast, check out of your Cairo hotel. One of our staff will meet you there, and you'll be driven to the airport to catch your flight to Luxor. Our guide will accompany you to your hotel and assist with check-in when you arrive in Luxor. A sphinx avenue connects the Karnak Temple and the Luxor Temple, which are located on the Luxor East Bank of the Nile. Afternoon Luxor day tours of this area will start. Lunch at a nearby dining establishment. You will stay the night in Luxor after going back to the hotel.

Day 5: Luxor West bank Sightseeing Tour:

Following breakfast, our tour guide will pick you up from your hotel in Luxor, where you will meet our representative. The <u>West Bank of Luxor tour</u>, which includes wonderful sites like The <u>Colossi of Memnon</u> and the <u>Temple of Hatshepsut</u>, will then be transferred to you. One of the female pharaohs to ascend to power in ancient Egypt was Hatshepsut, who lived during the 18th dynasty of the new kingdom. Lunch at a nearby dining establishment. You will stay the night in Luxor after going back to the hotel.

Day 6: Aswan Excursions (The High Dam - Unfinished Obelisk)

In the morning, after breakfast, we will drive to Aswan in an air-conditioned car, where our guide will take you to your lodging. The <u>Unfinished Obelisk</u> and the <u>High Dam</u>, an important project for Egypt to control floods on the banks of the Nile, will be seen in the afternoon after lunch at a local restaurant. After that, you'll head back to your Aswan hotel room.

Day 7: Aswan Excursions (Philae Temple Sound and Light Show)

Continue your <u>day tours in Aswan</u> after breakfast by seeing the <u>Philae Temple</u>, one of the four sites where the tale of Isis, Osiris, and Horus took place. Isis worship is the purpose for which this temple was built and consecrated.

A lunchtime meal at a local eatery. Then. You'll return to your Aswan hotel room. To get to the island where the sound and light show in Philae temple is located, a speedboat on the River Nile will be waiting for you at the dock. You'll learn more about the history of ancient Egypt as you embark on a thorough journey through time with the help of the program. One of the most incredible things to do at night in Aswan is this.

The Philae Temple location, which was frequently under water for six months out of the year, was in danger due to the Nile's constant flooding. After a large and vital campaign to try to keep it from disappearing due to the heavy flooding water that took place in the middle of the 20th century, the temple was transported to the higher ground level <u>Agilika Island</u>, where it is presently.

After the show, you'll go on a boat to head back to the harbor, where a shuttle will take you to your hotel in Aswan.

Day 8: Tour to Abu Simbel Temples - Back to Cairo

Hotel breakfast is available. Visit Abu Simbel in a private, air-conditioned vehicle with one of our representatives. At Abu Simbel, you'll go to the Temples of Ramses IV. You'll travel back to Aswan, check into your hotel in Cairo, and spend the night there before taking a flight back to Cairo.

Day 9: Final Departure

You will meet our representative at the hotel after a delicious breakfast, and they will drive you to Cairo International Airport to catch your last journey back home. We hope your nine- day tour to Cairo, Luxor, Aswan, and Abu Simbel were enjoyable.
