<u>Itinerary</u>

Day 1: welcome Cairo

Find our representative who will be holding a sign with your name on it and waiting for you before the luggage belt at <u>Cairo International Airport</u>. You will then be transported to your hotel in Cairo, where personnel will assist you with a quick check-in before tomorrow's <u>Cairo Day Tours</u>.

Day 2: Cairo tour to Giza Pyramids - Egyptian Museum

The <u>Great Pyramid</u> of King Cheops, which took more than 20 years to build and is a fantastic spot to start your trip before going on to the pyramids of the kings Chephren and Mycerinus, is where our tour guide picks you up after breakfast. The <u>valley temple</u> of King Chephren, which is made of Aswan granite and coated in alabaster and is devoted to the mummification of the Pharaoh, will be the final stop on your tour of the Giza Pyramids. The well-known <u>Sphinx</u>, the lion-headed figure who guards the Necropolis, will then be your next stop.

Enjoy the Treasures of the Golden Pharaoh Tutankhamen, the world's largest and most precious collection of Egyptian antiquities, at the <u>Egyptian Museum</u> in Cairo, which holds the only intact royal treasure ever uncovered. Cairo hotel stays for the night.

Visit the Giza Plateau music and light show, which is optional.

Day 3: Old Cairo

After breakfast is served, you will start your tour of <u>Coptic Cairo</u>. Along the way, you will stop at the ancient Roman fortress of Babylon, The Hanging Church, which was built above the Roman fortress's towers by early Christians, and The Church of St. Sergius, also known as The Cavern Church or The Holy Family Church because it was built above the crypt where the holy family spent nearly three months.

Pay a visit to the water stream where the holy family filled their water jugs. When visiting Coptic Cairo, pay a visit to the Ben Ezra Synagogue, which is where Moses' basket is said to have been scooped up from the Nile by the daughter of the Pharaoh.

Then, begin your <u>Islamic Cairo</u> excursions by strolling around the old city's walls, gates, and mediaeval passageways. After a jam-packed day of learning and exploration, you may relax with a cup of tea at Fishawy, the Khan El Khalili Bazaar's oldest cafe. Cairo hotel overnight stay.

Day 4: Fly to luxor \ Nile Cruise Tours

You will be picked up by a <u>Cairo Top Tours</u> representative on one of our day tours from Cairo and driven to the Cairo International Airport where you may board a flight to Luxor, where you will be greeted and transported to the five-star, opulent Nile cruise. While you enjoy your excellent <u>Luxor East Bank</u> Tours in the afternoon, your tour guide will be at your side. You can see the huge complex of the Luxor and <u>Karnak temples</u>, which are artefacts from Egypt's glorious past. We'll return to the ship for a delectable supper and afternoon tea after our excursions of Luxor. I spent the night on the cruise ship.

Day 5: Luxor Sightseeing

Following breakfast, you'll be driven to the start of your amazing <u>Luxor West Bank</u> Tours, which will take you to the rock-carved tombs of well-known New Kingdom kings like King Tutankhamun and Ramses the Great, the <u>Valley of the Kings</u>, the <u>Temple of Hatshepsut</u>, also known as El Deir EL Bahari, which is one of the most stunning examples of world architecture, and the <u>Colossi of Memnon</u>. We will make our way back to the ship for lunch and afternoon tea after sailing to Edfu and across the Esna lock. A delicious supper will be served on board. a seaside night in Edfu.

Day6: Edfu Temple and Kom Ombo Temple

After you have breakfast on board, we will visit the interesting Horus <u>Temple in Edfu</u>. It was constructed in the Ptolemaic era. Re-board the ship after lunch, and travel to <u>Kom Ombo</u>. When you arrive, head to the shared temple that houses the gods Sobek and Haroeris. Return to the boat and continue sailing until you reach Aswan. Dinner is offered on the Steigenberger MS Minerva Nile cruise.

In Aswan, spend the night on board.

Day 7: Aswan sightseeing

Before embarking on an Aswan day tour to the <u>High Dam</u>, the Unfinished Obelisk, and the majestic Philae Temple, which functioned as Egypt's first temple devoted to the goddess Isis, enjoy a superb breakfast on board the Nile Cruise. Lunch and dinner can be had on board. You will then spend the night on board at Aswan.

Day 8: Aswan to Cairo

This day, you'll be returned to Cairo! After breakfast, join the Steigenberger Nile cruise and spend some time at Aswan on your own. After that, a car will take you to Aswan Airport so you may fly to Cairo.

Cairo hotel overnight stay.

Day9: Fayoum day tour

To begin your tour, arrange a morning pick-up from your accommodation in Cairo. You will travel to the Fayoum Oasis with your personal guide in a comfortable, air-conditioned car. Explore the dry lagoons and ruins of the Fayoum Oasis's temples. Enjoy the waterfalls at <u>Wadi Al Rayan</u>.

At your hotel in Cairo, board a private van. Travel 105 kilometres southwest of Cairo in comfort to reach Fayoum. Arrive in the dry oasis of Fayoum Oasis, then visit Quaroun Lake to observe the birds. Discover more about the historic city of Karanis by perusing the Fayoum Museum's collection of sculptures and Roman portraits.

Take a break for lunch after your tour. Discover the wildlife, lakes, and springs that make the Wadi Al Rayan environmental region so popular. Take some photos of the largest waterfall in Egypt. Take a sail in a traditional wooden sailboat called a felucca. Finish your journey as your driver takes you back to your Cairo hotel.

Day 10: Final Departure

Before being driven to <u>Cairo International Airport</u> for your last departure by a Cairo Top Tours representative in the hotel lobby, take pleasure in one last breakfast with <u>Egypt Honeymoon Tours</u>.
