Day 1: Check-in - Luxor Temple - Karnak Temple

Meet our representative at <u>Luxor Airport</u> or railway station, then transfer to embark on the most exciting Luxor Aswan Nile cruise, the Alexander the Great Nile Cruise Luxor to Aswan before your open-buffet lunch is served.
