<u>Itinerary</u>

Day1- Aswan City Tour

When you arrive in Aswan, you will be greeted by an Englishspeaking agent who will transport you to your beautiful Nile cruise ship in a private A/C vehicle.

Check in by 12:00 p.m.

Your lunch will be served on board at the start.

Following lunch, you will be taken to <u>The High Dam</u>, which was built in 1960 AD by Egyptian President Gamal Abdel Nasser to defend Egypt from the Nile flood.

Following that, you will have a motor boat ride down the Nile to the Temple of Philae, which was built during the Graeco-Roman period and was devoted to the goddess Isis.

Finally, you will be taken to <u>The Unfinished Obelisk</u>, which was built of red granite and dedicated to the deity Amun Ra. After your excursion, you will return to your ship. At night, you are on your own in Aswan.

Day2- Kom ombo/ Edfu - Sail to luxor

Breakfast will be given aboard the ship. Following that, you will accompany your Egyptologist tour guide to one of Egypt's most beautiful temples, the Temple of Kom Ombo, where the two gods Sobek and Haroeris were worshipped for a while. Return to your ship and enjoy your lunch on the sun deck while seeing the wonderful environment of the Nile. At the afternoon, ride a chariot to the Temple of Horus in Edfu, which is one of Egypt's best preserved temples. You will be taken back to your ship after your trip has concluded. You'll spend the day resting on board your cruise. Dinner will be provided aboard the ship. Staff will run the Egyptian Folkloric Show party at night.

Day3- Luxor West Bank

On the Nile cruise, breakfast is served. Following that, you will begin your spectacular trip in Thebes, the sacred region, by touring the west bank of Luxor, including the Valley of the Monarchs, which is considered the royal cemetery of the Theban kings and rulers of ancient Egypt, as well as the location where our Pharaohs were buried. Following that, you will go to Deir El Bahari to see the Temple of Queen Hatshepsut. Because it was completely cut within the mountain, this temple is regarded as one of the most magnificent specimens of ancient Egyptian architecture. The journey concludes with a visit to the Colossi of Memnon, which belonged to King Amenhotep III. After that, you'll return to your cruise for lunch.

Afternoon at your leisure. The trip includes dinner and an overnight stay.

Day4- ckeck out - Luxor East Bank

After breakfast, check out (at 08:00 AM). Following that, you will have a tour of Luxor's East Bank,

including the magnificent <u>Karnak Temples</u> Complex, which is regarded the world's most complex construction, occupying an area of a hundred acres. Finish your magnificent journey at <u>the Temple of Luxor</u>, which was created by one of the 12th dynasty's monarchs and completed by the well-known king Ramses II. After your day tour, you will be driven by private A/C van to your Luxor location (where our services will be ended).
