Itinerary

Day 1: Monday - Luxor East Bank Tours

Cairo Top Tours tour leader will pick up you at Luxor Airport or railway station holding a signboard that shows your booking's name. After that, you will transfer with a private nonsmoking airconditioned vehicle to embark on your Amwaj Living Stone Nile Cruise ship. Stay in your cabin and relax then you will enjoy your lunch on board.

Start your Egypt Day Tours through a visit to the gigantic <u>Karnak Temple</u>, considered to be the throne of <u>Amun-Re</u> the Lord of Gods in ancient Egyptian mythology. then your <u>Luxor day tours</u> continue to see the overwhelming <u>Luxor Temple</u>, built unusually very close to the river Nile before having afternoon tea, then enjoy an oriental Belly Dance Show for 2 hours by the local professional dancer. Your gourmet dinner will be served aboard your lovely Egypt Nile River Cruise and overnight in <u>Luxor</u>.

Day 2: Tuesday - Luxor West Bank Tours

After <u>Luxor excursions</u> are over, your Egypt Nile River Cruise will Sail to Edfu and a tasty lunch buffet will be prepared aboard the boat, and later in the afternoon Tea will be served on the sun deck and

Day 3: Wednesday - Edfu & Kom Ombo Temples

On the third day of your MS Amwaj Living Stone Egypt Nile River Cruise, enjoy your tasty breakfast then we will start the interesting Kom Ombo and Edfu tour by visiting Edfu Temple, one of the greatest monuments of ancient Egypt dates back to the Ptolemaic Era. We will sail to Kom Ombo to discover Kom Ombo Temple.

The construction is exceptional because it consists of two parallel temples. the northern part was devoted to Horus and the southern part was dedicated to the crocodile god Sobek. This temple was built for the worship of the two gods. Lunch will be aboard the ship and afternoon Tea before visiting and then sailing to Aswan. Dinner will be served aboard the ship and overnight in Aswan.

Day 4: Thursday - Aswan Nile Cruise Tours

After having your delicious breakfast aboard the Nile Cruise in Aswan, you will enjoy <u>Aswan day tours</u> to visit the most important achievement in the modern <u>history of Egypt</u> which is the <u>High Dam</u>, located to the south of Aswan on the way to the airport. Then your private tour guide will accompany you to discover the area known as the <u>Granite Quarries</u> to see the biggest <u>Unfinished Obelisk</u> which is most probably constructed by the famous <u>Queen Hatshepsut</u> who ruled Egypt during the new kingdom.

At last, we will take you by the traditional motorboat to continue your <u>Aswan excursions</u> and see the <u>Temple of Philae</u>, which was built during the <u>Ptolemaic era</u> and it has been relocated to the island of Agilica during a salvage campaign that took place in the 60s of the previous century to save the temple from being flooded by the Nile River water, the temple was built to honor the goddess of Magic, Isis who was the mother of the falcon God Horus. Enjoy your lunch on board and afternoon tea.

In the evening you will have a delicious dinner while enjoying the Nubian Folkloric Show operated by local Nubian artists from Aswan aboard your Amwaj Living Stone Nile Cruise ship.
