Itinerary

Day 1: the arrival day

Your tour will begin with 4 Days MS Reinassance Nile Cruise when you arrive at <u>Aswan</u> <u>International Airport</u> and meet your tour leader who will take you on board the MS Reinassance Nile Cruise to start visiting <u>Aswan attractions</u> and your first site will be:

Aswan <u>High Dam</u>: it is the world's largest embankment dam, which was built across the Nile in Aswan, Egypt, between 1960 and 1970.

then you will continue on board to visit the <u>Unfinished Obelisk</u>: which is the largest known ancient obelisk and is located in the northern region of the stone quarries of ancient Egypt in Aswan.

after that, you will complete your day with a visit to the <u>Philae temple</u>: whose walls contain scenes from Egyptian mythology of <u>Isis</u> bringing <u>Osiris</u> back to life, giving birth to <u>Horus</u>, and mummifying Osiris after his death.

Then get back to MS Reinassance Nile Cruise to have lunch and sleep to get ready for your 2nd Day.

Day 2: Kom Ombo & Edfu Temples

On your 2nd Day, you will start by having breakfast on 4 Days MS Reinassance Nile Cruise then our Cairo Top Tours Professional tour leader will take you to visit Kom Ombo temple: The Temple of Kom Ombo is an unusual double temple in the town of Kom Ombo in Aswan which was constructed during the Ptolemaic dynasty, 180–47 BC.

After that, you will sail to reach Edfu city to stop, have lunch, and your overnight on board MS Reinassance Nile Cruise.

Day 3: Edfu Temple

on the 3rd Day of your trip 4 Days MS Reinassance Nile Cruise, you will start with breakfast in the morning then you will visit Edfu temple:

The temple was built in the Ptolemaic Kingdom between 237 and 57 BC. The inscriptions on its walls provide important information on language, myth, and religion during the Hellenistic period in Egypt.

then you will have your lunch on the very charming view of the Nile on MS Reinassance Nile Cruise.

Our tour leader will offer you an optional tour which is a <u>sound and light show at Karnak temple</u> if you would like to try it.

Day 4: Sail to Luxor

On the 4th and last Day of 4 Days MS Reinassance Nile Cruise, you will have your delicious breakfast then sail to Luxor to enjoy the magnificent sightseeing on the west bank of the Nile river and you will start with the valley of the kings: that has been famous for the discovery of the tomb of Tutankhamun, and is one of the most famous archaeological sites in the world.

then you will continue to visit the Colossi of Memnon: which are two enormous statues of 18th Dynasty Pharaoh Amenhotep III originally designed to guard his mortuary temple, located on the western bank of the Nile, opposite Luxor.

After that, it will be your chance to discover the east bank of the Nile river in Luxor and start by visiting the Karnak temple: which is considered the largest and most important religious complex in ancient Egypt and The most significant structure, and the largest religious building ever built, is the Temple of Amun-Ra.

then it will be time to see the great Luxor temple: Different than other temples in Luxor as was not built in adoration to a god or to a god figure of the kings and pharaohs it was built in dedication to the rejuvenation of kingship.

then you will have the time for another optional tour which is a hot air balloon tour.

then your tour leader will take you to Luxor international airport where you will be reached at the end of 4 Days MS Reinassance Nile Cruise.
