Visit Hatshepsut Temple or El Deir El Bahari Temple who was the fifth Pharaoh of the 18th Dynasty and the second female Pharaoh to rule Egypt, at the end of your Luxor excursions, you will tour the Colossi of Memnon, those two gigantic seated stone statues representing the pharaoh Amenhotep III are not very well-preserved.
