<u>Itinerary</u>

Day 1- Welcome onboard/Visit Top Highlights of Aswan

It's the time to experience the legendary Nile River in luxury by picking you up from your location in Aswan by a modern private air-conditioned vehicle to join your personal tour guide to visit Aswan High Dam, it's one of the most significant achievements in Egypt in recent times which is completed in 1970 and its importance extended to be the controller of the Nile floods and the main generator of 50% of electricity then you will go to the Unfinished Obelisk, it's an ancient Egyptian ruin dates back to the reign of Queen Hatshepsut but the site was abandoned due to some cracks. We will take you to discover Philae Temple, it's a cult temple whose construction was based on the worship of the god Isis. At this point, you will be taken to check-in 5* luxury Merit Dahabiya Nile Cruise where your lunch will be proceeded and overnight in Aswan.

Day 2- Nile cruise trip to Kom Ombo & Edfu Temples

Your Nile cruise starts sailing in the very early morning to Kom Ombo while having breakfast on board and upon arrival, you will join your private tour guide to discover Kom Ombo Temple which is listed to be one of the most significant Ptolemaic monuments in Egypt as a dual dedication temple for the gods Sobek and Horus.

Then, Have an open buffet lunch before you'll continue cruising to Edfu to witness <u>Edfu Temple</u> where the annual festival of coronation was held to honor the pharaoh and the divine birth of Horus. You will sail to Luxor and arrive late at night and spend the rest of the day over the deck of the cruise.

Day 3- Nile cruise trip to the best of Luxor Highlights

On the third day onboard Alexander the Great Nile cruise, you will join your tour guide to visit the magnificent monuments of Luxor including the <u>Temple of Queen Hatshepsut</u>, it's a magnificent Theban religious and funerary temple situated on the west bank of the Nile River and the site comprises tombs and buildings date from the Middle Kingdom to the Ptolemaic time. Then, you will head to the <u>Valley of the Kings</u>, it's the site of the royal burials of the pharaohs of the New Kingdom which were constructed in 2100 BC before you will proceed to <u>Colossi of Memnon</u>, the site contains two faceless sculptures representing Amenhotep III and rising around 18 meters on the west bank of the Nile. And let's have a marvelous trip to <u>Karnak temple</u>, and lunch and dinner will be served onboard merit dahabiya Nile cruise and overnight in Luxor.
