Day 1: Friday - Embarkation - Aswan Nile Cruise Tours

Start <u>Egypt Day Tours</u> and specially <u>Aswan Excursions</u> by visiting the majestic <u>High Dam</u> that was built in the 1960s to save the country from the Nile floods and produce electricity for Egypt.

Your Excursions in Aswan continue to visit the beautiful <u>Temple of Philae</u> that was built for the cult of <u>Osiris's</u> wife, Goddess <u>Isis</u>, goddess of Magic in <u>ancient Egyptian religion</u>, and sail on the Nile by motorboat.

Have your lunch aboard the <u>Aswan to Luxor Nile Cruise</u> boat and have a blissful afternoon tea while watching the scenery of Aswan <u>Nile River</u> water, have your dinner served aboard, and overnight after the entertainment show.

Day 2: Saturday - Kom Ombo and Edfu Temples

Sail to Edfu and enjoy your open-buffet lunch aboard the boat before visiting <u>Edfu Temple</u>, one of the biggest temples in Upper Egypt that was built for the God of the sky, God <u>Horus</u> who was recognized as a falcon. Dinner is served aboard the cruise boat while sailing to Esna and enjoying the Egyptian Galabeya Party. Overnight in Esna

Day 3: Sunday - Luxor East Bank Tours

Have your breakfast aboard the vessel while sailing To Luxor via Esna lock and enjoying the beautiful views of the Nile River, lunch will be served proceeded by the afternoon tea. You will now start Luxor day tours by visiting the Luxor Temple, which was built between 1400 and 1000 BC. by the pharaohs Amenhotep III and Ramses II.

Continue your <u>Luxor East Bank Tours</u> to the great <u>Karnak Temple</u>, the temple contains the great temple of Amun, other minor temples, chapels, and the great sacred lake. The most well-known pharaohs involved in its construction were <u>Queen Hatshepsut</u>, Seti I, <u>Ramses II</u>, and Ramses III. Dinner aboard the Nile cruise in Luxor and the entertainment belly dance show. Overnight in Luxor

Day 4: Monday - Disembarkation - Luxor West Bank Tours

Continue <u>Luxor excursions</u> to see the Temple of Queen Hatshepsut, excavated on the steep limestone cliffs that rise above the desert in the valley of Deir el-Bahari, the Hatshepsut Temple is an extraordinary monument capable of dazzling its visitors throughout the usual <u>Luxor Sightseeing tours</u>. Transfer to Luxor Airport or railway station.
