<u>Itinerary</u>

Day 1 Itinerary: Arrival to Luxor - Embarkation - Luxor East Bank

Our representative will meet and assist you at Luxor Airport or the railway station, and then transfer you to your Egypt Nile River Cruise for check-in and lunch. Start your Luxor day tours by traversing Karnak Temples built by several Pharaohs between 2200 and 360 B.C and dedicated to the father of gods in ancient Egypt, Amun Re, and continue Luxor East Bank Tours to the famous Luxor Temple dedicated to the Theban trinity and built during the New Kingdom. The obelisk that stands in Concorde Square in Paris, is a gift from Mohamed Ali in 1836 and comes from this temple as there were 2 of them flanking the entrance to the temple.

After that, your personal tour guide will transfer you back to the cruise ship after <u>Luxor excursions</u> to enjoy your lunch and the afternoon Tea then watch the belly, Dancing Show. Dinner aboard your Luxor to Aswan Nile Cruise and overnight in <u>Luxor</u>.

Day 2 Itinerary: Luxor West Bank Tours

After a good night's sleep, you will have breakfast aboard the cruise boat then your guide will accompany you on the West Bank tours in Luxor to see the colorful tombs of the Pharaohs inside the Valley of the Kings, The first pharaoh that was buried in the royal necropolis was King Thutmose I, pharaoh of the 18th dynasty. the massive statues are known as Colossi of Memnon and built for King Amenhotep III who was the father of one of the most important Monarchs of ancient Egypt, King Amenhotep IV who was famous by the name Akhenaten, his rebellion against the traditional cult of Amun angered the priests. Finally, you will continue Luxor Sightseeing tours to Deir Al-Madina and the Temple of Madinet Habu built by the Pharaohs of the New Kingdom. Sail southwards to the town of Esna and lunch will be served aboard the Nile cruise ship before enjoying the afternoon tea and Captain's Welcome Cocktail Party. Dinner will be served aboard the Nile cruise ship and overnight in Esna.

Day 3 Itinerary: Edfu and Kom Ombo Temples

Today your certified Egyptologist will take you to explore the famous temple built for the worship of God Horus, Edfu Temple after breakfast then sail to Kom Ombo. Lunch will be served aboard the

cruise boat and afternoon tea before your <u>tour to Kom Ombo</u> to visit the Ptolemaic architectural style temple in <u>Kom Ombo</u>, the visit to this temple is one of the most beautiful since you will see some very well-preserved crocodile mummies in the chapel of Goddess Hator, and then have your open-buffet dinner served aboard the cruise vessel and spend the night in Kom Ombo.

Day 4 Itinerary: Aswan Nile Cruise Tours

After breakfast aboard the cruise boat in Aswan, you will be accompanied during your <u>Aswan Day Tours</u> by our guide to see <u>the High Dam</u>, Before the High Dam was built, the annual flooding of the Nile during summer had continued to drown largely many areas in Egypt, and the <u>Unfished Obelisk</u> of Queen Hatshepsut within the Granite Quarries and continue <u>Aswan excursions</u> to the Temple of Philae which was formerly established near the open first Cataract of the Nile River in Upper Egypt, then you will enjoy lunch aboard the cruise ship and afternoon tea. Have a delicious dinner aboard the cruise boat while enjoying the Nubian Folkloric Show. Overnight in Aswan

Day 5 Itinerary: Friday - Disembarkation in Aswan
