### Day 1 - Aswan City Tour

Upon your arrival to Aswan, our tour guide will meet and greet you to transfer you by an air-conditioned vehicle into Steam Ship Sudan Nile Cruise .to relax and enjoy the sun while having your open buffet lunch on the deck. In the afternoon, you will visit <u>Aswan High Dam</u> which was rebuilt again on <u>Agilika Island</u> after the building of the High Dam irrigational system, passing by the <u>Unfinished Obelisk of Queen Hatshepsut</u> . then, you will explore the magnificent temple of <u>Philae</u>, which was built during the Greco-Roman period. You have the chance to have a Felucca Trip around <u>Kitchener</u> and to walk through the Nubian colorful

markets of Aswan, Before dining on board.

## Day 2- Kom Ombo & Edfu Temples
