**Itinerary option 1: (The Dynastic 5 Days Luxor to Aswan) -
Day 1: Embarkation - Luxor East Bank Tours**

Our representative will meet you anywhere in [Luxor](#) to transfer you by an air-conditioned vehicle to your Steamship Sudan Nile Cruise for embarkation and an open-buffet lunch onboard. Afternoon visit to the magnificent [Karnak Temple](#) complex which was built by many [Kings and rulers of ancient Egypt](#), you will see the temple of Amun inside, who was the father of gods in [ancient Egyptian religion](#), you will be amazed by how gigantic the temple is, no wonder! its building and development lasted for centuries from the [Middle Kingdom](#) to the Ptolemaic era. Then you will continue to visit the [Luxor temple](#), which was built by Amenophis III but most of the credits go back to [Ramses II](#). Enjoy your dinner and overnight aboard the steamship [Nile cruise in Luxor](#).

Itinerary option 1: (The Dynastic 5 Days Luxor to Aswan) - Day 2: Valley of the Kings - Sail to Esna / Edfu

Today, after you have your breakfast you will visit the [Valley of the Kings](#), the Theban necropolis of the New Kingdom where the Pharaohs decorated their tombs to be masterpieces of art. You will explore tombs like the one that belongs to Ramses VI which is one of the biggest and most well-preserved tombs in the area. Take a look at the legendary valley of the workers who were in charge of decorating the tombs, known as Deir el-Madina before enjoying lunch and sailing to Esna towards Edfu and overnight onboard.

Itinerary option 1: (The Dynastic 5 Days Luxor to Aswan) - Day 3: Edfu and Kom Ombo Temples

A morning visit to the Temple of Edfu which was devoted to the gods [Horus](#) and the Goddess of motherhood, [Hathor](#), the building began throughout the 3rd century B.C Ptolemaic Dynasty. and was finished after 170 years, it is considered one of the best-preserved buildings in the [history of Egypt](#). You will be back on board to continue sailing to Kom Ombo for a breathtaking sunset. Visit Kom Ombo Temple, which is a unique complex that nothing can compete with its glory as it was devoted to the two great divinities [Sobek](#) and Haroeris.

Overnight on board.

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

Itinerary option 1: (The Dynastic 5 Days Luxor to Aswan) - Day 4: Sail to Aswan - Philae Temple

Resume sailing the Nile River to [Aswan](#) after breakfast to witness the beautiful islands alongside the Nile, the [Elephantine Island](#) which was a trading center in the Nubian civilization and was characterized by fertile land. You will visit the Temple of Philae which is the home for the worship of the wife of God Osiris, Goddess Isis, Goddess of Magic, and the hero in the famous myth against the evil God Seth according to ancient Egyptian religion, enjoy your lunch and have the chance to see the beautiful [Sound and Light Show in Philae Temple](#) (optional excursion) before dinner and overnight.

Itinerary option 1: (The Dynastic 5 Days Luxor to Aswan) - Day 5: Disembarkation

After you have your gourmet breakfast you will be transferred to any location in Aswan after you disembark your Steamship Sudan Egypt Luxury Nile Cruise.

Itinerary option 2: (Eternal River 5 Days Aswan to Luxor) - Day 1: Embarkation - Philae Temple

[Cairo Top Tours](#) tour leader will meet you and transfer you by a private vehicle till you enter your [Sudan Nile Cruise](#), after embarkation, you will have your open-buffet lunch on board then you will examine the magical [Temple of Philae](#) dedicated to the worship of Goddess Isis. Discover the area and browse the gift shops before getting back to the vessel for a tasty dinner and overnight aboard the boat.

Itinerary option 2: (Eternal River 5 Days Aswan to Luxor) - Day 2: Edfu and Kom Ombo Temples

Sail to Kom Ombo while you have your English morning Tea after the delicious breakfast onboard, when you arrive, you will have an exceptional time wandering in the [Temple of Kom Ombo](#) on the Nile bank, dedicated to two deities, Haroeris and Sobek but mostly known as the Sobek temple. Enjoy your lunch in the magical atmosphere while sailing to Edfu where you will visit the [Temple of Edfu](#) and admire its huge architectural view. Sail to Esna with the relaxing music in the background and dinner aboard your steamship.

Itinerary option 2: (Eternal River 5 Days Aswan to Luxor) - Day 3: Luxor East Bank Tours

After having breakfast, you will visit the grand [Karnak Temple](#) located on the East Bank of the Nile in Luxor (ancient name Thebes), which is a complex of three main temples and ruins. Lunch is served on board then you will have an evening visit to [Luxor temple](#) where the production of three great Pharaohs resulted in such a gigantic worship place from the ancient ages, Amenhotep III, Ramses II, and [Queen Hatshepsut](#). Dinner and overnight stay in Luxor aboard your Nile cruise.

Itinerary option 2: (Eternal River 5 Days Aswan to Luxor) - Day 4: Valley of the Kings

After having breakfast, you will start your [West bank tour of Luxor](#) to visit the magnificent rock cut-tombs of the New Kingdom Pharaohs, known as [the Valley of the Kings](#), where they built their tombs far away from the tomb robbers, it is also thought that the valley where the workers and craftsmen who built the necropolis lived in the valley known as [Deir el-Madina](#), to keep the place as a secret, they lived there, and they were also buried there. Lunch and dinner will be your way to daydream while feeling the warm breeze of the Nile and overnight in Luxor.

Itinerary option 2: (Eternal River 5 Days Aswan to Luxor) - Day 5: LUXOR
