<u>Itinerary</u>

Day 1: Luxor

When you arrive, we'll pick you up from the Luxor airport, however we can also pick you up from the train station, your hotel, or any other location. Your full lodging and board will

You'll visit Luxor's East Bank. we will disembark to see the magnificent city of Luxor, also known as Thebes in ancient times. The Luxor Temple and the Karnak Temple, which are separated from one another by the Boulevard of Sphynxes, a 3 km long avenue dotted with the aforementioned sphynxes, are two of Egypt's most impressive temples..

then start when we transfer you to the cruise ship that we'll be using to sail the Nile.

Day 2: Luxor - Esna - Edfu

After breakfast, we'll travel to the enormous cemeteries close to Luxor. Visits to the Valley of the Kings, the Temple of Hatshepsut, the Colossi of Memnon, and the interior of three tombs in the Valley of the Kings will all be included (two giant stone statues that represent the Pharoah Amenhotep III).

Thereafter, when we go back to the boat, we'll head for Edfu. overnight

Day 3: Edfu - Kom Ombo - Aswan

We'll visit the Edfu temple, which is devoted to the deity Horus, after we've had a meal and our batteries are fully charged. The voyage then proceeds in the direction of <u>Kom Ombo</u>, where we will explore its magnificent temple honouring the gods Sobek and Hareoris.

We will travel up the Nile to Aswan, where we will spend the night, after the day's excursion.

Day 4: Aswan

After breakfast, Start with touring the beautiful Aswan <u>High Dam</u>, one of the most significant construction projects in contemporary Egypt's history, which was constructed between 1960 and 1970.

then , You will next be taken to view the largest <u>unfinished obelisk</u> in Egypt, which is located in Aswan's granite quarries. This obelisk was built to be the biggest in all of Ancient Egypt and the only one in Aswan, making it a unique attraction among Aswan's things to do.

after that transfer, you to see the Philae Temple, which is a temple devoted to the goddess Isis and one of the most stunning in the nation.

Later, in the evening, we'll go down the Nile in a traditional felucca boat while admiring its natural

beauty, wildlife, and volcanic islands. After that, we'll stay another night in Aswan.

Day 5: Aswan- check out

After breakfast and check-out, you can visit Abu Simple Temple on an optional tour traveling in the morning

you'll have some free time before we transport you to the Aswan airport, railway station, or somewhere else you'd like to go in the city. You can even have lunch on the plane if your transfer is in the evening.
