# Day 1: Arrive Cairo, Optional Sound and Light Show in Giza Pyramids

Welcome to Cairo, our representative will pick up you from the <u>Cairo International Airport</u> and transfer you to your hotel to begin the check-in procedures with his assistance, your 18 Days Egypt Tour Package itinerary will be revised with you to confirm the final pick-up times and flight schedules.

Enjoy your night discovering the hotel or try an amazing experience by attending the Sound and Light show in Giza Pyramids!

### Day 2: Giza Pyramids / Saqqara / Memphis

A new day full of passion for history and culture!

You will meet your private tour guide after breakfast, then transfer to the Giza Pyramids area where you will witness the oldest gigantic structures built 4500 years ago by the famous kings of ancient Egypt during the old kingdom, see the great pyramid of King Cheops, the middle pyramid of his son Chephren, and the third pyramid of Mycerinus his grandson.

By the end of your <u>tour to Giza Pyramids</u>, we will move to the high plateau to enjoy the scenery and have the chance to try camel riding in Giza Pyramids, take awesome photos, and move by vehicle to visit the Valley Temple of Chephren and the Great Sphinx, that massive block of stone carved in the shape of a mythological

creature with a head of a king that is believed to be King Chephren.

Now we will drive to another impressive necropolis called Saqqara to see the Step Pyramid of King Djoser from the 3rd dynasty, the complex was built by the famous architect <u>Imhotep</u> who was granted to be worshipped due to his intelligence, and see the ruins of the hep-sed court, King Teti's pyramid, and the tomb of Kagemni, one of the famous viziers during the reign of Teti.

Moving now to the site where the 1st capital of Egypt was, the site of ancient Memphis to see the open-air museum with multiple artifacts that date back to the old kingdom, the middle kingdom, and the new kingdom, and see the 2nd largest sphinx among all the sphinxes in Egypt, the alabaster sphinx of Memphis, along with the colossal statue of Ramses II.

Have your lunch in a good quality restaurant after or during your tours in Giza!

### Day 5: Luxor West Bank Tours

red rock, but is hidden between the mountain, numerous tombs of nearly 70 pharaohs who ruled Egypt during the new kingdom and among them are the famous kings who are well-known as the golden pharaoh Tutankhamen and Ramses II. Continue Luxor sightseeing tours to the Temple of El Deir El Bahari, built by the famous powerful Queen Hatshepsut, the Temple represents the conflict between Queen Hatshepsut and her son-in-law, Tuthmosis III for we can see that several statues for her were damaged by King Tuthmosis III followers after her death. Now you will get to see the enormous statues of Amenhotep III known as the Colossi of Memnon then you will be back to the ship and navigate towards Edfu. Enjoy your lunch and the afternoon tea before dinner is being served aboard the Nile cruise ship with the entertaining Galabeya party. Overnight in Luxor.

Back to the cruise ship and enjoy your dinner and the night show before overnight in Aswan.

Then back to your hotel in Sharm El Sheikh after you enjoyed your epic Sharm El Sheikh to St. Catherine Monastery.
