Itinerary

Day 1: Arrival Cairo \ first day of your Egypt 7 Day Itinerary

Once your flight arrives at Cairo international airport, you will be met by <u>Cairo Top Tours</u> tour leader, who will be holding a signboard bearing your name to begin your <u>tours to Egypt</u>. He will review your Egypt 7 Day Itinerary itinerary with you.

Start your wonderful Cairo day tours directly as you will be transferred to the Step Pyramid of King Djoser in Saqqara which is the ancient known building in the world completely made out of stone mastabas or steps above each other, the step pyramid was built by the famous Architect and vizier of the Pharaoh called Imhotep, Saqqara is approximately 27 km to the southwestern part of Cairo. it is one of the wealthiest archeological places in Egypt where you can see the Mastaba tombs of the Nobles and follow the development of the burial tombs in ancient Egypt's history.

Have your nice lunch in a beautiful restaurant, then you will transfer to the ancient capital of Egypt's <u>old kingdom</u> which is known as <u>Memphis City</u>, where you are going to see the huge statue of <u>Ramses II</u> and the great <u>Alabaster Sphinx</u> which is the second biggest sphinx after the Great Sphinx in Giza, this city was established by <u>King Menes</u> who united the two kingdoms of the north and the south and generated the dynastic history of the Pharaohs nearby 5100 years ago.

At the end of your Saggara and Memphis day trip, you will be transferred to your hotel for check-in.

Overnight in Cairo hotel.

Day 02: Cairo Sightseeing Tour

Have your breakfast in the morning which is included and you will be accompanied to see the ancient Roman fortress of Babylon that was built by emperor Trajan 2000 years ago and the Hanging Church, which is built during the third century, and the church of St Sergius, where the holy family stayed before. Towards the end of the Coptic Cairo Tour, you will visit Ben Ezra Synagogue, which is the oldest one in the whole area.

Passing by the Coptic district of Cairo visit the Egyptian Museum, which has the largest collection of Egyptian antiquities all over the world including all the gold and silver items of the boy-King Tutankhamen.

Enjoy your delicious lunch then we will move to visit the Citadel of Saladin, and we will visit the mosque of Mohamed Ali inside and enjoy a panorama of Islamic Cairo as well as a modern buildings like the Cairo tower and the television building.

At the end of our <u>Cairo Day Tours</u>, we will take you to Islamic Cairo to spend the time shopping in the old and unique market of Khan El Khalili.

Lastly, you will be transferred back to the hotel and overnight in Cairo.

Day 03: Cairo to Luxor

Check-out from Cairo hotel then your <u>Egypt Travel Packages</u> continue. Today your personal driver and guide will escort you to Cairo airport to take your flight to Luxor, after arrival to Luxor, you will start your day tour to visit the West Bank of Luxor and enjoy the ancient colorful tombs in the Valley of the Kings, then your tour guide and driver will take you to visit the Temple of Queen Hatshepsut known as the temple of Deir El Bahari. The last stop during your Luxor day tours to the west bank of Luxor will be at the Colossi of Memnon.

Enjoy your lunch in a Nile view restaurant and continue your tour to the East Bank of Luxor where you visit the Karnak and Luxor Temple.

Spend your night in Luxor.

Day 04: Edfu and Kom Ombo Tour

A tasty breakfast will be served for you in the main hotel restaurant, then you will enjoy the tour to Edfu Temple. which is back to the cult of the ancient Egyptian god Horus and is regarded as one of the most protected cult temples in this part of the country.

then your driver will head north to another fabulous town while you enjoy the sight of the magnificent river and its 2 green banks twisting through the desert until you stop to see the historical Temple of Kom Ombo standing on a high ground overlooking the Nile, the temple has a double entrance and it is shared by the crocodile-headed Sobek, the god of fertility and creator of the world, and Haroeris or the ancient falconheaded Horus.

Our representative will accompany you to your hotel in Aswan.

Day 05: Aswan Tour

Cairo Top Tours certified tour guide will take you after finishing your lovely breakfast to begin your <u>Aswan sightseeing tours</u>. First, you will visit the unbelievable building which is a High Dam, constructed to control the flow of the river. The Dam keeps the water during the time of flood to maximize its advantage on irrigated land and is also used to produce electric power. and the Philae temple, where you can see the Temple of Isis which is considered one of the greatest Temples in Egypt and it occupies about a quarter of the island.

You will be transferred back to the hotel after the trip.

Overnight in Aswan

Day 06: Back to Cairo

After having your breakfast served at the hotel, your tour leader will accompany you to Aswan Airport to take your flight back to Cairo.

Meet your personal tour leader at Cairo Airport to start your Cairo Day Trips by the tour to Giza pyramids of Cheops (the Greatest Pyramid 4500 years old), Chephren (the second pyramid built 20 years later), and the third pyramid of Mycerinus, as the Pharaohs believe, there was life after death, they built the Pyramids to spiritually escort the dead pharaohs into the afterlife and they also built the sphinx to protect the deceased kings. So we will take you towards the end of your Giza pyramids tour to visit The amazing Sphinx and the Valley Temple built out of a mixture of limestone, granite, and alabaster.

After the tour, you will be transferred to your hotel in Cairo and we will help you to check-in.
