Itinerary

Day 1: Welcome to Cairo:

When you arrive at <u>Cairo International Airport</u>, a representative from <u>Cairo Top Tours</u> will greet you and take you to your hotel for the night. We'll go through your itinerary for your 9 days of travel to Cairo, Luxor, Aswan, and Abu Simbel to make sure all of the excursions in Egypt are scheduled correctly.

Day 2: Giza Pyramids / Saqqara / Memphis

After breakfast at the hotel, you will meet your private tour guide and travel to <u>The Pyramids of Giza</u> (Cheops, Chephren, and Mycerinus) and <u>Great Sphinx</u> are two of the most amazing places on earth, There, you will see all the magic of the entire world that the Egyptian pharaohs did in this monumental collection, have the opportunity to ride camels in the Giza pyramids, and visit <u>Valley Temple</u> of Khafra.

After lunch, visit another spectacular location called Memphis, which served as the capital of Egypt's ancient empire during the Old Kingdom. South of the delta of the Nile, it is situated. Before moving on to the Step Pyramid of King Djoser in Saqqara, which is a great monument and contains some magnificent tombs of the nobles like the one facing the Pyramid of King Teti of the 6th dynasty, the tomb of Kagemni to see some impressive scenes of ancient Egyptian art, you will see the enormous statue of Ramses II here as well as other interesting artifacts like the Alabaster Sphinx of Memphis. After your tour of the Giza Pyramids is over, you will return to the hotel for the night.

Day 3: Egyptian Museum , copitic and islamic Cairo :

Hotel breakfast is available. You will be greeted by our English-speaking Egyptologist guide, who will then drive you to the Egyptian Museum in a private vehicle. The Egyptian Museum is a historic site with a wealth of stunning monuments and historical artifacts. Enjoy your lunch at a neighborhood restaurant. When you visit the Saladin Citadel, which Salah El Din Al-Ayoubi erected, and the Mohamed Ali Mosque, which was constructed in 1805 AD in the Turkish style of architecture and is quite similar to the Blue Mosque of Turkey, you will learn about Islamic Cairo Trips. The Holy Virgin Mary Church, also known as the Hanging Church, the Ben Ezra Synagogue, and the cave church of St. Sergius are the next stops on your day tour of Old Cairo, which also includes the Coptic area. You will be transferred to your Cairo hotel at the conclusion of your Cairo day tours.

Day 4: Arrive Luxor (The East Bank Tours)

After breakfast, check out of your hotel in Cairo, where you'll be met by one of our representatives, and be taken to the airport in Cairo to catch your flight to Luxor. When you arrive in Luxor, our guide will take you to your hotel and help you check in. Afternoon tours of the Luxor East Bank of the Nile will begin, taking you to the Karnak Temple and Luxor Temple, which are connected by a sphinx avenue. Lunch at a neighborhood restaurant. After returning to the hotel, you will spend the night in Luxor.

Day 5: Luxor West bank Sightseeing Tour:

After breakfast, you will be picked up from your Luxor hotel by our tour guide, where you will meet our representative. You will then be transferred to the Wes Bank of Luxor tours, which include some amazing locations like The <u>Colossi of Memnon</u> and the <u>Temple of Hatshepsut</u>. Hatshepsut was one of the female pharaohs who rose to power in ancient Egypt during the 18th dynasty of the new kingdom. Lunch at a neighborhood restaurant. After returning to the hotel, you will spend the night in Luxor.

Day 6: Aswan Excursions (The High Dam - Unfinished Obelisk)

After breakfast, in the morning, we will travel by air-conditioned car to Aswan, where our guide will take you to your accommodation. The High Dam, an essential project for Egypt to regulate floods on the banks of the Nile, will be seen in the afternoon, and you will also view The Unfinished Obelisk. a meal at a nearby restaurant for lunch. You will then return to your hotel room in Aswan.

Day 7: Aswan Excursions (Philae Temple Sound and Light Show)

After breakfast, continue your Aswan sightseeing and go to Philae Temple, one of the four locations where the myth of Isis, Osiris, and Horus occurred. This temple was constructed and dedicated to the worship of the goddess Isis.

A meal at a nearby restaurant for lunch. Then. You will go back to your hotel room in Aswan. You will be taken to the dock to board a motorboat on the River Nile to travel to the island where the Sound and Light show in Philae temple is located. The show will take you on a thorough journey through time as you discover more about the history of ancient Egypt. This is one of the most amazing things to do in Aswan at night.

The regular flooding of the Nile endangered the Philae Temple location, which was nearly flooded for six months every year. The temple was moved to the higher ground level <u>Agilika Island</u>, where it is now, after a significant and crucial campaign to try to save it from disappearing due to the heavy flooding water that took place in the middle of the 20th century.

Following the performance, you'll board a boat to return to the harbor, where a transfer will take you

Day 8: Tour to Abu Simbel Temples - Back to Cairo

Breakfast at the hotel. Travel to <u>Abu Simbel</u> with our representative in a private air-conditioned vehicle. You will visit the Temples of Ramses II at Abu Simbel. You will return to Aswan and transfer to the <u>Aswan airport</u> to catch your flight to return back to Cairo., check-in and overnight in your Cairo hotel.

Day 9: Final Departure
