<u>Itinerary</u>

Day1- arrive cairo, pyramids, old cairo and papyrus institute

Our tour leader will pick you up from the Cairo airport, where our licenced tour guide will be waiting for you in an air-conditioned car.

To transport you right away to the Necropolis of <u>Giza Pyramids</u>, where you may go to the Khufu, Khafr a, and Mankaura Great Pyramids and ride a camel to learn more about the intriguing Giza Plateau.

The Papyrus Institute is where we will head next to learn more about the ancient Egyptian craft of cre ating papyrus. After learning about the production of papyrus, we'll have the chance to create our own papyrus scrolls.

After that, it will be time for lunch at a nearby neighborhood restaurant in the heart of Cairo. After a brief break, we'll visit the historic district of Cairo to admire its stunning buildings, including those of <u>Coptic Cairo</u>, Islamic Cairo, and Al-Azhar, before concluding our day tour at <u>Khan El Khalili</u>.

After that, we'll return you to your hotel in Cairo so you may check in and stay the night.

Day 2 - fly to luxor- Luxor Museum & Mummification Museum Tour

After breakfast, our tour guide will pick you up from your accommodation, assist with check-out, and drive you to the Cairo airport where your flight to Luxor will depart from. As soon as we get here, your tour guide will take you to your hotel in Luxor so you can relax before we set off for our first stop. You will go there. The Luxor Museum is a lot of fun. The Brooklyn Museum in New York designed displays

of ceramics, jewellery, furniture, sculptures, and stelae. They contain a carefully chosen mix of artefacts from the Necropolis and Theban temples. A cow-goddess head and other treasures from Tutankhamun's tomb are on display.

The Mummification Museum is then the greatest location to learn the mysteries of the most elusive pharaohs. A remarkable assortment of mummified animals may be discovered. Numerous human and animal mummies, as well as the instruments and canopic jars used in the procedure, are kept at the museum.

Following that, we'll make a lunch break at a neighbouring eatery before returning you to your accommodation in Luxor for the evening.

Day 3- Day Tour to East bank of luxor

After breakfast, our tour guide will pick you up from your lodging to visit The architectural marvel known as the Valley of the kings, which served as a place of burial, is home to numerous kings' graves. The tombs of King Tutmosis I, King Tutmosis III, Tut-Ankh-Amon, King Ramses VI, King Mrenptah, and Amonhotep II are the most well-known.

then proceed to observe The only female pharaoh to rule ancient Egypt, Queen Hatshepsut, the daughter of Thutmosis I, constructed the <u>Temple of Queen Hatshepsut</u>, also known as El Dir El Bahari. She ruled Egypt for approximately 20 years during the 18th Dynasty (around 1490–1469 B.C.), during which time the temple was constructed.

Our next trip will be to the Colossi of Memnon, which are the remains of Amenhotep III's funerary temple.

We'll have lunch at a local restaurant after that, and then we'll drop you off at your hotel for the evening.

Day4- Day Trip to Edfu and Kom Ombo from Luxor

The Temple of Horus is the most significant structure in Edfu and one of Egypt's most stunning and well-preserved Temples. After breakfast, check out of your accommodation, and our tour guide will pick you up to visit it.

then proceed to observe There used to be two entrances to the <u>Kom Ombo</u> Pylon, but the left side has totally vanished, leaving only the centre pillar and the lowest portions of the right wing standing. On the front wall to the right as you enter, you might notice a relief of the Roman Emperor Domitian wearing the crowns of Upper Egypt, the gods Sobek, Hathor, and Khons, 52-line hieroglyphic text, and more. After that, we'll have lunch at a neighbouring restaurant before transporting you to your Aswan lodging for the evening.

Day5- Aswan high dam and the Abu simbel temble

After being picked up at your hotel or by our tour guide, the first destination on your day tour of

Aswan is the High Dam of Aswan, an engineering marvel constructed in the 1960s. You can see over Lake Nasser to the Kalabsha temple in the south and the enormous power plant in the north from the top of the High Dam.

Take a 3-hour trip from Aswan to the south in an air-conditioned car to experience an Abu Simbel day tour. The two temples of <u>Abu Simbel</u> are said to represent the pinnacle of prehistoric Egypt because of their extraordinary architecture. They depict the grandeur and majesty of the upcoming Kingdom. The Egyptian government and UNESCO made the decision to work together to safeguard these sites from inundation. Ptah, Re-Her-Akhtey, Amun-Re, and Ramesses II were honored at the temple bearing their names. Ramses II's Sun Temple is another name for the enormous Abu Simbel temple.

Ramesses II, Hathor, and the Sun God are symbolically united at the Temple of Queen Nefertari, also referred to as the Temple of Hathor because she was the Sun God's wife. Spend about three hours there before leaving for Aswan.

take you back to your hotel, where you will have lunch and stay the night.

Day6- Visit Philae Temple and fly to cairo

After breakfast, check out of your lodging, and our tour guide will take you up to visit You will view the third and biggest of the famous Aswan sights last.

As the surrounding Nile levels rose as a result of the construction of the High Dam, the Philae Temple was carefully relocated to its current location (about 500 meters from the original site).

Your tour guide will give you a walking tour of the temple after you arrive at the island by motorboat, then give you some free time to finish your independent study.

The Philae Temple, which honors the goddess, Isis, can be found in a stunning location on an island in the river that has been meticulously maintained to reflect its original layout.

When your excursion is over, you will be dropped off at the Aswan airport so you can catch your flight to Cairo. Receive transportation to your hotel in Cairo after your arrival, where you will spend the night.

Day7- White Desert and Bahariya Oasis Tour

At 6:00 in the morning, our tour guide and driver will pick you up from your hotel in Cairo and bring you 350 kilometres west of Giza to the Bahariya Oasis in a private, air-conditioned vehicle.

The trip takes around four hours.

Once you get in Baharaia, change to a 44 and go 40 kilometres into the desert to see the Black Desert.

The well-known neighbourhood restaurant will thereafter offer lunch, where you may swim and relax before or after.

Turn left to enter the White Desert, one of the most picturesque deserts in the entire world, and continue for another 90 km to reach the Agbatat and Crystal deserts as well as a variety of mountains and sand dunes. There are many different shapes of its gorgeous white stones, including mushrooms,

chickens, and bunnies. Return by car to your lodging in Cairo.

Day8- arrive Alexandria

When you check out in the morning after breakfast, your tour guide will transport you in a modern, air-conditioned vehicle to Alexandria. The catacombs at <u>Kom el Shoqafa</u>, which are regarded as one of the wonders of the Middle Ages, will be the first stop on this day trip. With three stories of tombs that could hold as many as 300 bodies, it is the largest Roman burial site in Egypt that is now known to exist. The area had originally been developed as a private burial ground for a single family before becoming a public cemetery. The tombs' architecture is reminiscent of Greco-Roman designs. This can be observed in the creative fusion of Egyptian, Greek, and Roman artistic traditions in the wall artwork.

You will then proceed to <u>Qaitbey's Citadel</u>, which is thought to be one of the most significant defensive strongholds not only in Egypt but also along the Mediterranean Sea coast, after stopping for pictures. In the 15th century A.D., the Citadel played a significant role in Alexandria's defence system. It is located not far from the entrance to the eastern harbour at the easternmost point of Pharos Island. On the identical spot where the renowned Lighthouse of Alexandria, one of the Seven Wonders of the Ancient World, formerly stood, it was built.

Next, a visit to the Montazah Royal Palaces and Gardens will be made, which belonged to Mohamed Ali Pasha's royal dynasty from Khedive Abbas Helmy II to King Farouk I. The Modern Alexandria Library, which replaced the Old Library and was famed for its extensive collection of books on various disciplines and literary genres, is where our incredible journey will come to a conclusion. You will be picked up and driven back to your Alexandria accommodation following this excellent city tour.

Day 9 - Alexandria tour - back cairo

The temple of Serapis, which was built in the first century BC and was referred to as "the supreme god of Alexandria during the Ptolemaic era," is where <u>Pompei's Pillar</u> is located. After checking out of the hotel and being picked up by our tour guide in an air-conditioned car, we will go there.

<u>Abu Al-Abbas Al-Mursi</u> is the largest mosque in Alexandria. It has a cream-colored facade, four enormous domes, carvings in the form of arabesques, and a soaring minaret.

<u>The Roman Amphitheatre</u>, also known as Kom el-Dikka, serves as the last stop on our tour of Alexandria. A sizable Roman theatre and residential complex may be found right in the middle of Alexandria.

Before being driven to your accommodation in Cairo by one of our tour guides, enjoy a stroll through Alexandria's historic district.

Unwind and stay up all night.

Day 10- Final Departure

At the conclusion of your 10-day Egypt vacation, which we hope you enjoyed and was encouraged to undertake more tours in Egypt, a representative from our company will drive you to <u>Cairo</u>
