<u>Itinerary</u>

Day 1 : Cairo - Siwa

The traveller will first meet his tour guide before setting off on his journey to <u>Siwa</u>. The most comfortable air-conditioned minivan will then take you on your journey to Siwa, which is around 600 kilometres northwest of Cairo, the Egyptian capital. We travel past Marsa Matruoh, which features one of Egypt's most picturesque beaches, on the way to our lunch stop at a nearby restaurant.

Arrive at Siwa, check in, and spend the night there to prepare for the jaw-dropping views you want to see the following day.

Day 2: Siwa tour

After breakfast, we begin our tour of Siwa by traveling to the <u>Cleopatra Bath</u>, the area's most well-known natural spring of water. We may take a bath in the breathtaking natural bath right here. There is no relationship between the two and no explanation as to why this water spring was given the moniker Queen Cleopatra. The most well-known and significant structure in Siwa, the <u>temple of the Oracle of Amun</u>, will be the second destination of the day. One of the most well-known oracles in ancient times was located in this temple. In order to be recognized as the King of Egypt, Alexander the Great traveled to this temple in 331 BC.

We travel to the "mountain of the dead," or <u>Gabal Mawta</u> as the locals refer to it in Arabic, where many rock-cut tombs dating from the Greco-Roman to the 26th Pharaonic dynasty have been found. The third-century BC tomb of Si-Amun and the priest's tomb of Mesu-Isis from the 26th dynasty are only two of the notable tombs seen there.

Spend the evening at Siwa's hotel relaxing.

Day 3: Siwa tour

We left for a journey to the Great Sand Sea in Egypt's Western Desert, which is located in the largest desert on the continent, after a full breakfast. Enjoy the magnificence of one of Egypt's most distinctive locales, the majesty of the Sahara, and the unending sand dunes.

We will now indulge in sandboarding, which gives us the joy of sliding down sand dunes instead of snow, after passing Dakrour Mountain. The <u>Bir Wahid</u> hot spring is the perfect place to unwind after a

day of skiing.

Day 4: Siwa - Cairo

Following a delectable breakfast, we check out of the hotel and travel to Cairo in a private, airconditioned minivan. Check into your hotel in Cairo, relax, and spend the night there.

Day 5: Giza Pyramids Tour, Egyption museum

Your trip will start with a simple hotel pickup, and your guide will be there to greet you when you arrive. The real fun can now start.

To view the fabled pyramids of Cheops, Chephren, and Mykerinus, go back through time to the era of the Ancient Egyptians. Visit the Valley Temple and the Great Sphinx up close while touring the tombs of the ancient pharaohs.

Ride a camel through the desert to experience what it was like to be an ancient Egyptian. This is undoubtedly a once-in-a-lifetime experience!

Take a historical tour of Cairo to visit all the lesser-known but important local attractions. Enjoy the expansive vistas of the <u>Pyramids</u> and the Sphinx, stop for some optional Cairo cuisine, and see the <u>Egyptian Museum</u> to witness the country's priceless artifacts.
